STUFFY MIST broke on top, quickly sped clear, set uncontested pace from two path around the bend and into the stretch, and was never challenged while under hand urging to the wire. CAMILA CATALINA reserved from the inside, awaited room passing quarter marker, tipped out for room in upper stretch then closed strongly to clearly prove next best. TIZ GRACE stalked from between foes and on two path, continued two wide on the turn, was three wide exiting the bend and was along in final strides for the show. JEWLZ broke slightly inward, tracked pacesetter from the inside, steadied slightly behind that rival at the three-eighths pole, remained hugging the rail around the bend, also shifted out slightly into the lane and was out finished for the show. DARLIN' DUCHESS stalked while three abreast, remained in same path on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened some. CHASING NUMBERS settled outside, was four deep early and into the turn, remained on same path on the bend then caught five wide entering the lane and never threatened late.

ARROWTHEGREAT stepped to the front, set pressured pace from the inside or two path, maintained cushion into the stretch, drifted out in at eighth from home under left-handed asking, was straightened then drifted out again under one left-handed tap, bumped with ULTIMATE GAMBLE and narrowly held. ULTIMATE GAMBLE bumped at the start by inside rival, forced the pace while outside leader for six furlongs, drifted out bit entering the lane, forced out bit and bumped past sixteenth by ARROWTHEGREAT and could not get past that rival late. LURE HIM IN broke out and bumped rival, tracked top pair from three path, continued three wide to the stretch, also drifted out some in upper stretch then whittled gap on top pair in deep stretch. KATONAH unhurried early, trailed from the inside, saved ground throughout and weakened through the stretch. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF ULTIMATE GAMBLE AGAINST ARROWTHEGREAT INVOLVING THE INCIDENT IN THE STRETCH, ARROWTHEGREAT WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND FOR DRIFTING OUT AND COSTING ULTIMATE GAMBLE A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.

INVINCIBLE MOLLY (GB) away quickly then allowed DIAL A FRIEND to take the early lead, took aim two wide around the bend, drew alongside the leader in upper stretch, took over past the eighth pole and drew away. SEPTEMBER MAGIC chased three deep out of range early, moved into the two path on the turn, steered out in the lane and outkicked CORALGABLESKAYLIN for second. CORALGABLESKAYLIN chased two wide then along the rail, angled out in upper stretch and got edged for second. DIAL A FRIEND hustled clear from INVINCIBLE MOLLY (GB) early, led a bit off the rail then along the inside, challenged by the winner in upper stretch, lost command past the eighth pole and weakened in the last sixteenth. READY JET GO chased from inside, drifted slightly to bother outer rival early on the turn, raced a bit off the rail into the lane and failed to rally. TAM'S LITTLE ANGEL tracked between, got put in a bit tight early on the turn, angled to the rail and lacked a rally. OUTRAGEOUS coaxed from the gate, got put in a bit tight between early, chased three wide through the turn and could not make an impact.

BORN TO ROCK settled two wide then along the rail on the first turn, coaxed along leaving the backstretch, ridden between runners on the far turn, finished determinedly down the lane but could only whittle the gap on the winner. TENNESSEEHONEYBEE stalked three deep, challenged four then three wide on the turn, took over past the five-sixteenths pole, cleared entering the lane and held comfortable under urging to the wire. PETITE ANGE stalked between rivals, bid between at the five-sixteenths pole, fought inside the leader to the quarter pole, could not kick on with that rival into the stretch, stayed on well through the lane and proved second best. C HER BEAUTY tracked off the inside, ridden along into the turn, chased four to five wide around the bend, finished willingly down the lane and held third. MANIAE stalked along the inside, got shuffled behind the leader backing up a bit at the five-sixteenths pole, tipped two then three wide on the turn, churned on through the final furlong and

rounded out the superfecta. BE A GOLDFISH sat off the pace three deep then outside a rival, traveled two wide into the turn, paused briefly past the five-sixteenths pole, tipped five wide leaving the bend and lacked a rally. MRAZEK'S OLD DREAM was off a bit slow to begin, ridden along the rail off the pace into the turn, swung out past the quarter pole and failed to menace. FAITHFUL TRUTH was off slow to begin, lagged behind early, went four wide into the turn, came six wide into the stretch and passed tired rivals. HELLO KID O KID O raced in range three deep, chased three then two wide on the far turn, tipped out into the lane, rallied to the front with a sixteenth remaining and won going away. WARM RECEPTION was rated along the inside in the early going, stayed on the fence through the far turn, roused leaving the bend, finished willingly down the lane and gained second. SPARTA F. C. duelled from inside, inched ahead on the backstretch, led clear around the far

turn, showed the way into the final furlong, lost command at the sixteenth pole and weakened late. TIS SUNRISE traveled in the two path around the first turn, went between rivals into the backstretch, moved to the inside, lacked room at the quarter pole, angled out in the lane, closed well and missed third. GOATSKI dueled from outside around the first turn, pressed between in the middle stages, could not keep up with the leader and chased two wide on the far turn, followed closely into the final furlong and could not summon the needed late kick. SALLY'S WISH was off slow to begin, settled next to the fence, coaxed along the rail on the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane and failed to rally. MPERFECTION traveled in the three path then outside a pair of rivals into the backstretch, asked two then three wide on the far turn, steered out at the top of the lane and failed to threaten. TURKEY BIRD tracked four then five wide on the clubhouse turn, rushed up four deep up on the backstretch, chased three deep approaching the far turn, drifted a bit into the lane and flattened. ROYAL DUSTY bumped with Z'S WARDROBE at the start, pulled early traveling four wide on the first turn, continued to pull four deep on the backstretch, remained wide to the stretch and weakened. GRETA'S GHOST stalked the pace from the two to three path, between rivals in the middle stages, lost ground around the far turn and faded. Z'S WARDROBE bumped leaving the gate, lagged behind on the inside, saved ground to the stretch and never got involved.
