DIRTY RICH showed the way under pressure from BELLA'S BRO to the inside up the backstretch, cleared that rival midway around the bend, led from the three path turning for home feeling MR. A. P. bearing down from outside, turned that rival away in upper stretch and drew off under right handed urging. MR. A. P. came out leaving the gate, followed in range well off the rail, closed in and loomed four wide coming into the stretch but got turned away by the winner in upper stretch and stayed on to secure second. FORTY SEVEN chased in the two path leaving the backstretch, angled to the rail for a bit before going between rivals past the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response in the drive but churned on to earn the show honors. BELLA'S BRO prompted the pacesetter from inside, could not keep up past the five-sixteenths pole, remained inside to the stretch and retreated. VERY QUIET lagged behind early, saved ground through the turn, moved out in the drive and was never a factor. MY MORONI bobbled outward shortly after the start, raced up close off the rail, chased in the three path then three deep at the quarter pole and tired down the lane.

DRUIDIC got bumped and put in tight prior to the first turn, tracked from inside then moved into the two path, went between rivals on the backstretch and far turn, angled out in upper stretch, rallied from outside and got up late. MCCLUSKY sat off the pace on the inside, crept closer around the far turn, cut the corner into the lane, rallied from the fence to get up for second but got outclosed by the winner. SO I'M TOLD took control early in the two path then moved inside, took light pressure on the backstretch, inched away on the far turn, led clear into deep stretch but got run down by the top pair. SUPER ELLIE brushed with outer rival at the start, chased two then three wide around the first turn, between rivals in the middle stages, went two wide into the second bend, angled five wide for the drive, finished well in the final furlong but lacked the needed late kick. UNCHARTED raced near the back along the fence early, continued on the inside into the far turn, shifted to the two path around the bend, tipped out into the lane and showed late effort to improve position. OOBUBBAKAKAYO brushed with inner rival in the beginning, raced under a tight hold in the two path at the back on the first turn, continued two wide into the second bend, moved over to the three path, angled out in the stretch and produced a mild rally. MONGOLIAN APPLE stalked two then three wide on the first turn, three deep up the backstretch, rounded the far turn three then four wide and lacked a bid. LAW ABIDING bumped and put the winner in tight prior to the first turn, raced up close keenly in hand along the inside after, was closest in pursuit turning for home, tipped out at the top of the lane and flattened out. LADY RIDER dueled for command from outside, battled to the top of the lane, inched ahead in upper stretch and gamely prevailed. EASTWICK dueled inside LADY RIDER to the top of the stretch, battled gamely to the wire but had to settle for second best. BIG WHOOSH well placed along the inside behind the top pair early, came under a ride when losing some ground on the far turn, went two wide into the lane, could not summon the needed rally but was able to hold third. READY TO DARE vied three deep between rivals into the first turn then moved into the two path stalking the leaders, spun three wide into the lane and got outkicked for third. BALTIC FIRE tracked from inside, between rivals at the half-mile pole, lacked room behind a rival into the lane, angled out into the clear, drifted out while rallying and got up. VIBEZ traveled outside a rival or two wide off the pace, moved into range three deep on the backstretch, bid three deep with a quarter mile remaining, fought into deep stretch, got bumped on both sides nearing the wire. PARADISE LAKE sat off the pace on the inside, followed in range on the far turn, ran into brief traffic at the three-sixteenths pole, tipped out into the clear, rallied between, got bumped on both sides nearing the wire and missed second. CANDY BAR rated in the two path, bid two wide on the far turn, took over in upper stretch, drifted out in the final furlong and was outfinished by the top trio. JOHANNY trailed on the inside, moved into the two path on the far turn, roused and angled out in upper stretch, closed in between runners late but got bumped around and checked near the wire. HOPEFUL (GB) settled inside then began to pull and moved into the two path around the clubhouse turn,

chased three deep at the quarter pole, got floated out midstretch and finished willingly to the wire. RUGELACH took control early and steered to the fence, took pressure around the far turn, led inside a pair of rivals turning for home, lost command in upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. RUNAMILEINMYSHOES stalked from inside, saved ground to the stretch and lacked the needed response. CIRCLE OF TRUST stalked two then three wide around the clubhouse turn, remained three deep to the stretch and weakened. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE TOP FIVE FINISHERS LATE IN THE RACE. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED THAT ALTHOUGH THERE WAS CONTACT BETWEEN SEVERAL RUNNERS IT DID NOT AFFECT THE OUTCOME OF THE RACE.
