GIGGLE GIGGLE took a bump in the beginning, got put in tight along the fence trailing early on the first turn, drew closer in the middle stages, waited while easing off the rail around the far turn, tipped three wide into the lane, fought three deep into the final sixteenth, dueled with TIME TO SHINE late and won the bob. TIME TO SHINE bumped GIGGLE GIGGLE leaving the gate, stalked the top pair from the fence, waited behind the leader around the far turn, tipped out and launched a bid between rivals in upper stretch, put a head in front past the eighth pole, fought with GIGGLE GIGGLE late and lost the bob. MARCOS PERFORMANCE broke in and bumped inner rival then got bumped from outside immediately after, advanced five deep up the backstretch, angled to the three path briefly early on the turn, chased four deep past the five-sixteenths pole, challenged three deep midstretch and proved best in deep stretch. MR. PIPPINS chased three deep then moved inside, moved off the rail and took aim three wide coming into the stretch, bid between rivals midstretch and got outkicked by the winner. JIMMY DELIVERS got bumped leaving the gate and once more shortly after, sped clear and angled to the inside, led from the rail then two wide into the lane, showed the way into the final furlong, challenged by a pair of rivals midstretch and weakened once overtaken. ONE STEP BEYOND coaxed along chasing between rivals, got put in tight and checked nearing the half-mile pole, had to pause when running on heels early on the turn, angled to the inside, moved out in the lane and kept on for a minor award. MR. CARDENAS broke well, got put in tight along the fence early, saved ground through the turn and flattened out in the furlong grounds. REBEL NATION tracked the pace from off the rail, went three wide into the turn, moved to the two path then traveled three wide again turning for home and weakened. BLAZING HEAT chased between rivals then got bothered

by REBEL NATION moving inward and steadied early, continued between rivals from off the pace and was forced to check hard into the turn, trailed four wide into the lane and passed tired rivals. DADDY BIGBUCKS got brushed by outer rival shortly after the start, chased off the rail then three deep, ran into brief traffic at the quarter pole, moved into the two path and came up empty in the drive. SURF RANGER came in and bumped the winner hard shortly after the start, almost losing the rider in the process, started to climb and was guided out wide into the clear, advanced through the turn, spun four wide into the lane and failed to menace. PROLETARIAT broke in and bumped B G BULLET, got floated in by SENDIT MO early, chassed for a bit then challenged between rivals exiting the backstretch, dueled outside ARKADELPHIA around the turn, put a head in front in upper stretch and maintained a short lead to the wire. ARKADELPHIA avoided trouble at the start to clear early, angled to the inside, took pressure from a pair of rivals leaving the backstretch, dueled inside PROLETARIAT around the bend, lost command in upper stretch, fought on from inside and finished a game second. B G BULLET got knocked into inner rival leaving the gate, drifted in and put RICH NIGHT and IN THE MIX not too long after, chased outside RICH NIGHT into the turn from off the pace, tipped three wide at the quarter pole and was along for the show honors. RICH NIGHT bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, got knocked into IN THE MIX and put in tight by B G BULLET shortly after, saved ground from off the pace and could not rally in the lane. IN THE MIX got bumped leaving the gate, had to take up when put in tight by outer rivals early, trailed from inside, moved out in the lane and could not overcome early trouble. VODKA VODKA controlled the pace from inside, roused with a quarter mile remaining, kicked away in upper stretch and widened through the final furlong under right-handed encouragement. BIG BILL was closest in pursuit through the early stages, loomed at the quarter pole, saw the winner draw away in upper stretch and stayed on to secure second. KEEP DANCIN NICK tracked between rivals in the early going, moved to the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, asked left-handed late on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and churned on for third. MAV MAN bumped with outer rival at the start, raced off the pace in the two path then along the inside, shifted to the two path again on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten while earning a minor award. BONNEVILLE JIM got crowded between rivals early, trailed on the inside then in the two path on the first turn, had one rival beat entering the far turn and passed tired rivals down the lane. HIGH KING bumped inner rival at the start, stalked off the rail then three deep and faded in the drive. CURLIN COMMAND got bumped on both sides at the start, tracked three deep to the far turn, came four wide into the lane and had little left for the drive. DANZING CAT bobbled, broke in and bumped, went up to challenge for command between rivals, fought between to upper stretch, dueled inside a rival past the eighth pole, could not match strides with the winner in deep stretch and held second. VEGAS LOVE bumped leaving the gate, chased three wide into the turn, driven four wide into the stretch, finished willingly down the lane and gained third. RYTHEM GIRL vied four deep up the backstretch and around the turn, fought three deep in upper stretch, dueled with DANZING CAT midstretch and weakened late. STELLAR CAP fought three deep between rivals up the backstretch and around the turn, yielded to the top trio entering the lane, churned on down the stretch and missed a minor award. I'M A RISQUE GIRL chased well off the rail in the early going, traveled four deep or four wide on the turn and lacked a bid in the furlong grounds. FUN TO RUN tracked three deep early, lost ground leaving the backstretch, angled from the four path to the rail on the turn, moved out midstretch and lacked room in the final sixteenth. RYAN'S GIRL challenged for the lead inside rivals, battled around the turn and into the final furlong, then weakened in the late stages.
