SOUTH BAY broke a bit awkwardly and inwardly, settled into stride, advanced inside a foe late up the backstretch into the turn, shifted out coming past the quarter pole three wide advancing on the leader, struck the fore at the top of the stretch while leaning in a bit, moved clear under urging and held sway. HYPERGAMY settled stalking off the pace into the turn three to four wide, shifted in past the five-sixteenths cutting the corner racing near the rail past the quarter pole, came out then continued to drift out a bit in the stretch, was second best. SALTY SISS was outsprinted in the early going racing outside a foe off the pace and in behind runners two to three wide, came out several paths in the stretch, failed to rally.

BENEFICIAL tracked pace early from the inside, advanced along the rail, found clear path inside VERACRUZ and grabbed brief lead, continued along the inside but could not match the winner through the lane. SMILING TIZZY stumbled leaving the gate then trailed down the backstretch, saved ground into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. KID DYNASTY chased three wide then two wide on the turn, shifted out five wide exiting the bend, remained on the far outside thru the stretch and did not threaten. MONDEGO (GB) was a bit keen between runners early racing off the pace, shifted nearer the rail and settled down heading toward the second turn, saved ground there and the third bend, rallied inside in deep stretch to just get up. BRITISH ISLES stalked then pressed the pace close up and outside two to three wide, bid coming to the top of the stretch taking a narrow lead, was nailed late. DICEY MO CHARA (GB) tracked up close inside saving ground throughout racing willingly and in hand, was asked for more past the quarter pole, came out four wide in upper stretch for room, loomed a threat but lacked the needed late kick. PHOSPHORESCENCE (FR) was shaken up at the start moving straight to the front, set the pace from off the rail then put to rating tactics to dictate a measured tempo, was shadowed by an outside rival throughout, was put to urging outside the quarter pole, overtaken at the top of the stretch, yielded late. LAMMAS (GB) settled outside off the pace racing mostly three wide through all three turns, swung out leaving the final bend coming into upper stretch four wide, tipped out further, ran on mildly outside to improve. PACKS A WAHLOP was rank early fighting the rider's restraint while caught about four wide around the first turn, settled down later on that bend and tucked in behind slightly nearer the rail stalking outside foes two to three deep and just off the leaders, advanced four wide on the third turn, was forced out a bit in the stretch and ran on evenly late. IRISH PROPHET settled mid-division near the inside but mostly in the two to three path, came into upper stretch four wide, failed to rally. LAHAINA FLAVOR was in tight soon after the break and

taken up slightly, settled at the rear inside switching out heading past the wire for the first time, settled at the rear outside, trailed coming to the top of the stretch, swung out four wide, failed to produce a bid.

CANANI broke inward and bumped rival, reserved along the fence, made steady progress from the rail into and around the last turn, tipped out in the drive, responded from strong handling and wore down pacesetter in final yards. PRINCE OF DEL MAR quickly stepped to the front, carved out the fractions while under pressure from MINING DISTRICT, edged away from that rival into the lane, dug in from the inside in the drive but could not hold off the winner. SOGNO DI VINO settled inside, remained glued to the rail chasing the pace, responded to urging in the stretch, rallied strongly inside late and got up on the wire for third. MINING DISTRICT angled over early and forced early pace, remained close up and outside pacesetter to the final turn, came three wide into the stretch, dropped back a bit then was collared in final jump for third. CARDIFF CRACK was bumped by outside foe leaving the gate, angled over, found the fence, saved ground to last turn, shifted out three, four and five wide around that turn and into the stretch and found his best stride late. PRINCE DOLCE between rivals early, chased along the rail or two wide, shifted out some exiting the last turn and finished with interest from between rivals. WINNING PATRIOT false broke then hopped when the gate opened to be off well behind the field, trailed from the inside, later angled out three then four wide into the lane and improved placing. IT'S A FACTOR chased three deep into the backstretch, continued well off the rail, came in slightly on the last turn, and lacked late response. MILES FINCH caught four deep into first turn, pulled his way from the outside around that bend and into backstretch, later chased from between foes and weakened in the final eighth. UNCLE CHILLY caught three deep early, remained well off the rail then on same path around the last turn and weakened. CHROMEFLASH angled over early, tracked pace while three wide, continued on same path into and around last turn and faded. THREE GEORGES between foes early then chased while outside event
