BUETANE coaxed along early then had to pause when CACTUS CHARLIE crossed in front, raced up close to the outside of that rival up the backstretch, applied pressure leaving the backstretch, dueled around the bend, kicked clear from CACTUS CHALIE into the stretch, asked left handed at the eighth pole and was ridden to to the wire. FORMULA ROSSA got bumped on both sides at the start, stepped to the front and controlled the pace from a bit off the rail up the backstretch, challenged by JENSCO into the turn, disposed of that rival nearing the quarter pole, opened up under hand urging in upper stretch and coasted in late. WISHTHEYALLCOULDBE broke a step slow, angled inward trailing the field, angled off the fence around the bend, came three wide into the drive, brushed with outer rival in upper stretch and finished willingly for a clear second. JENSCO raced up close three deep, bid two wide leaving the backstretch, could not keep up past the five-sixteenths pole, chased two then three wide into the lane, then weakened but managed to save third. GRIDLOCK bumped inner rival at the start, chased between runners to the turn, came under a ride in the two path and lacked the needed response. FIX IT QUICK tracked near the inside then in the two path around the first turn, continued two wide into the far turn, came under a ride while angling out around the bend, closed in and headed the leader at the sixteenth pole while drifting in slightly, took over shortly after and held over the KEITHING THUNDER stalked off the rail, outside a rival up the backstretch, traveled three wide around the far turn, rallied between, got floated in slightly at the sixteenth pole and kept on gamely to the wire. NON DOMICILE took control early next to the fence, dueled up the backstretch and far turn, inched ahead in upper stretch, clung to a narrow lead at the sixteenth pole and yielded to the top pair. BAZOOKA CHARLIE raced up close in the two path into the first turn, stalked the top pair from inside leaving the backstretch, moved over to the two path under asking on the second bend, chased within striking distance into the last sixteenth but failed to produce a bid. ZAGREUS raced up close three deep into the clubhouse turn then outside the leader leaving the bend, moved up on even terms in the middle stages, dueled through the far turn, fought to midstretch, got put in tight and checked at the sixteenth pole but was already starting to weaken. BIG JUANITO tracked three then two wide early, advanced inside in the middle stages, continued to gain around the far turn, lacked room behind the leader at the quarter pole, gained an opening late on the bend, surged clear in upper stretch and powered away under steady handling. SILVER N BLACK sat off the pace off the inside, steadied into the backstretch, drew closer in the middle stages, gained four, three, then two wide on the far turn, took over leaving the bend, lost command in upper stretch and stayed on for a clear second. TRUE MANTRA bumped with inner rival on the first turn while showing speed, dropped back to track off the rail, weakened on the far turn, pulled up midstretch and walked off.

THE PADRE (IRE) broke a step slow, pulled a bit running through the stretch for the first time, stalked two wide to the far turn, tipped three wide with quarter mile remaining, challenged outside the top pair entering the final furlong, fought on even terms with ARTISLAS into deep stretch and proved best late. FREEDOM'S NOT FREE broke out a bit, stalked the pacesetter from inside, stayed on the fence through the far turn, moved out in the lane and bid between rivals midstretch, finished gamely from inside late and edged ARTISLAS for the place honors. ARTISLAS was closest in pursuit from the two path in the early going, applied pressure to DAY AND AGE from outside leaving the backstretch, hounded that rival through the far turn, put a head in front in upper stretch, clung to a narrow advantage with a sixteenth remaining and got outkicked by the top pair. MAAZ (FR) settled at the back on the inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch, chased two then three wide on the far turn, got bumped and moved out by GAME WARRIOR in upper stretch, then finished willingly to earn a minor award. GAME WARRIOR tracked the speed from inside, eased over to the two path with a quarter mile remaining, angled out and bumped MAAZ (FR) in upper stretch, finished determinedly in the final furlong but could only whittle the gap late. DAY AND AGE stepped to the front and controlled the pace on the inside, took pressure from ARTISLAS at the seven-sixteenths pole, maintained a short advantage through the far turn, relinquished the lead in upper stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth.

climbed while chasing from off the rail, went seven wide into the lane and failed to menace. EXPRESSIVE LOVE climbed a bit early chased off the inside, spun four wide into the lane and had little left for the drive. DIALING DESTINY broke out then shifted back inward in the beginning, made progress from off the rail up the backstretch, raced four wide turning for home and had little left for the stretch run.

MY LOVE CAROLINE broke out, raced up close off the rail leaving the backstretch, challenged from outside early on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch, dueled inside JASMINA through the final furlong and gamely prevailed. JASMINA broke inward, stalked three deep then outside a rival to the turn, bid three deep entering the lane, fought head to head outside MY LOVE CAROLINE in the furlong grounds and just missed. TAPATIA MIA hustled from the gate, chased between or in the two path into the turn, found the rail around the bend, chased a bit off the fence into the lane, angled out in the drive and rallied to gain the show honors. LIBERATION got squeezed between rivals and clipped heels shortly after the start, trailed up the backstretch, advanced four to five wide on the turn, chased within striking distance into the final furlong and finished evenly late. MUSTANG KNICKY cleared from outside and crossed over, took pressure early on the turn, showed the way with a pair of rivals to the outside entering the lane, lost command in upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. LINO'S ANGEL stalked outside a pair of rivals then ridden along past the half-mile pole, rounded the bend three to four wide, tipped out in the lane and weakened. LADY VICTORIA chased the speed from inside, was getting out into the turn and had to take up near the three-eighths pole, drifted further around the bend and had little left for the stretch. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE MY LOVE CAROLINE, LIBERATION AND JASMINA AT THE START. THE STEWARDS, IN A MAJORITY DECISION, DISQUALIFIED MY LOVE CAROLINE FROM FIRST TO FOURTH FOR BREAKING OUT AND CAUSING LIBERATION TO CLIP HEELS, COSTING HER A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.

LOVE THE PRESSURE sprinted clear and took control of the rail, opened up a comfortable lead, continued untested through the far turn, roused at the top of the lane and remained clear under some right handed urging and steady handling. ORACLE OF PARADISE broke a bit slow, settled inside off the pace, crept closer in the middle stages, chased two then three wide around the far turn, bumped in upper and finished well but had to settle for second best. DOING TIME tracked out of range on the inside, moved into range leaving the backstretch, cut the corner into the lane but could not summon the needed late kick. MO HOLLAND DRIVE was off slow to begin, settled in the two path, angled in then back out on the far turn, spun three wide into the lane and failed to rally. BANDOLERO was off slow from the far outside, steered to the fence racing off the pace, angled three wide into the lane and failed to threaten. SAGUNTO away quickly then ceded command and tracked a bit off the rail, drew closer two wide in the middle stages, continued two wide on the far turn, and weakened in the drive. BENNY AND THE JET was off slow in the beginning, raced along the inside near the back, went outside a rival on the far turn, cut back inside at the quarter pole and could not make an impact. UNION SECRETS broke slow, trailed along the inside and never got involved. SMOKEM AND LOVE tracked in the two path around the first turn, lost ground two to three wide on the second bend and faded in the drive. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
