PRIDE OF QUEENS broke out and bumped, brushed with outer rival early and shifted in, began to climb and dropped further back, went four wide into the turn, six wide into the stretch, closed fast from outside and overhauled FIRE LLE in deep stretch. FIRE ILE broke in and bumped, tracked out of range off the rail, ridden along two then three wide on the turn, drew alongside the leader inside the eighth pole and quickly took over, challenged by PRIDE OF QUEENS in the last sixteenth and offered no resistance to that rival. ALLURING VALENTINE chased three deep between rivals then two wide into the turn, moved into the three path briefly then came back to the two path, chased within striking distance entering the final furlong but could not summon the needed late kick. CHEEKWOOD got pinballed leaving the gate, crowded between rivals early, chased from off the pace, spun three wide into the lane and kept trying for a minor award. DRAGON KAT brushed the outer side of the gate, sprinted clear and moved to the inside, led a bit off the rail into the drive, challenged past the eighth pole, yielded shortly after and weakened in the final sixteenth. DEVIL'S BELLA chased between rivals in the early going, started to climb past the half-mile pole and lost ground, traveled next to the fence on the turn and could not rally. CALL ME SUSIE veered out leaving the gate, chased four then three deep up the backstretch, asked three to four wide on the turn and tired. LITTLE TINKER ELLE stumbled for a few strides out of the gate and got bumped on both sides, chased inside rivals to the turn, saved ground through the bend, drifted in a bit and almost hit the rail in upper stretch and tired in the final furlong.

TOO SASSY away quickly to take the lead then dueled from outside up the backstretch, inched ahead around the turn, shook free at the top of the lane and held safely under a drive. DANZING DAISY chased from inside to the turn, tipped out in upper stretch and finished willingly to gain second but could not reach the winner. SHADY STRIPES tracked in the two path, asked left handed in upper stretch, failed to produce a bid but was able to secure the show honors. MIDNIGHT COWGIRL broke a step slow, settled outside a rival, went two wide around the bend, tipped out into the stretch and failed to respond when needed. KEEP THE PAVELS broke a step slow, sat off the pace in the early going, exited the backstretch in the three path, angled to the rail then came back out to the three path leaving the bend and lacked a rally. TRAIN STATION coaxed from the gate but had to pause when put in a bit tight between rivals early, traveled near the fence into the turn, swung four wide into the lane and failed to menace. TWILIGHT EMPIRE stumbled, broke out and bumped, pulled forward along the inside on the clubhouse turn, tracked in range up the backstretch, launched a rail bid late on the far turn, put a head in front at the eighth pole and drove clear late. SWEET HELLO broke super when timing the start perfectly, took control from the two path then moved inside, dictated terms up the backstretch, came under fire from TWILIGHT EMPIRE late on the far turn, lost command at the eighth pole, yielded to the winner at the sixteenth pole but was clearly second best. ONE ARROW stalked from the two path, outside a rival in the middle stages, asked two then three wide on the second bend, weakened in the drive but was able to save third. VIOLET STORM settled four then three wide on the first turn, angled to the inside on the backstretch, made some progress around the far turn, tipped off the fence and could not threaten. IVORY MOON bobbled then got bumped on both sides and shut off at the start, had to take hold a bit running on heels in the two path on the first turn, raced between into the second bend at the back of the field, continued two wide to the stretch and failed to menace. RHONDA'S COOKIN bumped with inner rival in the beginning, chased three wide into the first turn, drifted to the four path early on the bend then came back in a bit, dropped off the pace on the backstretch, raced three deep into the far turn and tired in the lane. TARIFF showed early speed three deep then took a stalking position in the two path, moved inside on the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, tipped out and bumped in upper stretch, bid through a tight spot between foes shortly after, dueled inside EARNED NOT GIVEN in the final furlong and dug in to prevail. EARNED NOT GIVEN sat well off the pace on the inside early, asked to pick in up on the backstretch while moving off the fence, followed in range on the far turn two, three, then four wide, drifted in while taking over in upper stretch, shifted back out at the eighth pole, dueled outside TARIFF in the furlong grounds and just missed. MALA trailed in the two path on the first turn, raced outside a rival into the far turn, steered to the four path around the bend, angled out further in the drive and passed tired rivals. BROTHER TONY stalked between runners then started to pull the rider along on the clubhouse turn, went up to challenge for the lead on the backstretch, fought head to head around the far turn, carried a short lead into the lane, lost command in upper stretch and weakened. TYPHOON TOMMY vied inside a pair of rivals then took control on the first turn, headed on the backstretch, dueled around the far turn, relinquished the lead entering the lane and folded.
