INNOVATIVE rated on the inside early, drafted behind the leader through the far turn, moved out a bit in the lane, bid between rivals in deep stretch and dug in for the win. EIFFEL was off slow to begin, rushed up between rivals and had to steady off heels, tracked from the two path, took aim three wide coming into the stretch, fought three deep into the final sixteenth and got outkicked by the winner while gaining second. RIBBONS showed the way early on the inside, came under pressure from SEA RUNNER leaving the backstretch, put that rival away leaving the far turn, came under threat from a pair of rivals at the sixteenth pole and could not hold on. HEY JESSIE unhurried in the beginning, had to alter out from behind a trouble rival nearing the first turn, settled between runners in the two path, tipped out in upper stretch and came with a late but ran out of ground. SEA RUNNER stalked three deep then was closet in pursuit in the two path, drew alongside the leader at the seven-sixteenths pole, got turned away approaching the stretch and flattened out. HEY LIL LADY sat off the pace outside a pair of rivals around both turns, moved out in the drive and lacked further response. MAGALE settled inside then shied from the rail prior to the first turn, drew closer around the far turn while continuing to save ground but weakened in the stretch. ARIRI (GB) was off slow spotting the field a couple lengths, trailed next to the fence on both turns and could not make an impact.
