CASE HIT was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, drew alongside the winner on the turn, hounded that rival to midstretch and got turned away in the last sixteenth. POTITO stalked from inside, tipped out at the top of the lane, drifted in then back out and held third. POKERKNIGHTATVEES settled outside a rival, moved inside leaving the backstretch, lacked room around the bend, moved off the fence, lacked room once again at the sixteenth pole and kept on between rivals for a minor placing. TRAVELIN' SHOW tracked two then three wide, angled out in the lane, kept on through the late stages but needed to find more. CULLEN J showed early speed between rivals then got shuffled back, angled to the inside, ridden along the rail into the lane and failed to threaten. ROSELEE MAY unhurried in the early and moved into the two path, drew closer up the backstretch, angled four wide to challenge on the far turn, took over in upper stretch and held safely over the late run from the runner-up. THEBESTISYETTOBE (IRE) traveled along the inside toward the back, ran into traffic on the final turn, tipped out into the clear, angled in and finished well from inside to gain second but ran out of ground to catch the winner. ETERNAL REIGN (IRE) settled in the two path, moved into range on the backstretch, bid three deep on the last turn, led into the lane, lost command in upper stretch and was outfinished for the place honors. DEFIANCE lagged behind in the opening stages on the inside, went outside a rival into the far turn, angled five deep at the quarter pole, closed in but lacked room midstretch and could not regain momentum after. IMA JOKER sat off the pace on the inside, drew closer around the far turn but lacked room to advance behind a pair of rivals from the quarter pole to the top of the lane, angled out into the clear in upper stretch and could not threaten. RUBY CANTU stalked from inside then dropped off the pace, moved into range in the middle stages, bid between rivals with a quarter mile remaining, could not sustain the challenge late on the bend and faded in the drive. NO OTHER LIKE YOU led early under pressure from ATIA to the outside then kicked clear, controlled the up the backstretch, came under a ride on the far turn, collared at the quarter pole, yielded into the lane and tired. NASSAU CIRCLE was forwardly placed on the first turn, vied three deep up the backstretch, dueled from outside past the five-sixteenths pole, held a short lead in upper stretch, lost command at the eighth pole, yielded midstretch and held second. TOPPERS AT SEASIDE raced up close three wide early, challenged between rivals on the backstretch, took a narrow lead at the three-eighths pole, dueled on the inside past the five-sixteenths pole, fought to midstretch and saved third. SUPREME COAST chased six wide into the first turn then moved in a few paths, continued well off the rail to the far turn, exited that bend in the five path and failed to rally. JENNYS TIZ took a bump into the first turn, raced four to five wide around the bend outside rivals, came six wide into the lane and never threatened.
