UNCLE HAPPY brushed leaving the gate, tracked from the two path, crept closer in the middle stages, bid three deep turning for home, dueled outside JIMMY BLUE JEANS in the final furlong and dug in to edge that rival and held TRUSTY RUSTY at bay. TRUSTY RUSTY unhurried from the far outside, settled outside rivals before moving into the two path, picked up stride on the far turn while easing over to the three path at the quarter pole, moved out further in the lane, finished gamely from outside and earned second while gaining on the winner to the wire. JIMMY BLUE JEANS was closest in pursuit in the two path, drew alongside the leader with three furlongs to go, fought head to head through the far turn, took over exiting that bend, put away inner rival but had to contend with UNCLE HAPPY to the outside, fought with that rival into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. KERRY GOLD tracked from the rail, followed behind the top pair while moved into the two path on the far turn, had to wait when boxed in entering the stretch, gained a clear path and angled to the inside, then finished willingly to round out the superfecta. DANIEL'S MAGIC steered to the rail racing off the pace, was patiently handled through the far turn still next to the fence, angled out in upper stretch and was finally given her cue, kept trying to the wire but lacked the needed late punch. SBAGLIATO brushed with the winner leaving the gate, traveled towards the rear two wide, moved out a bit on the backstretch, came back to the two path for the far turn, spun three wide into the lane, moved out and churned on through the final fulong but needed to find more. ROYAL 'N RANDO trailed on the inside, ridden along into the far turn, moved off the fence in upper stretch and could not make an impact. SYDNEY STREET (GB) raced outside a rival at the rear, stayed two wide to the stretch, then angled out but proved no menace. LOW EXPECTATIONS hustled to the front and set the tone on the inside, came under threat at the three-eighths pole, dueled around the far turn, lost command exiting the bend and gave way in the stretch run.

TENNESSEEHONEYBEE showed the way up the backstretch, took mild pressure from ROUSING JEWEL on the turn, put that rival away when asked in upper stretch and was kept busy to the wire. OUTRAGEOUS stalked the pacesetter from outside, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, drew alongside the leader midway around the bend, turned away at the top of the stretch and stayed on to secure second. HARNEY LANE followed in range from off the rail, chased between rivals on the turn in the two path and finished evenly late. ROSE OF JERICHO away quickly from outside then tracked outside rivals, spun four wide into the lane and flattened. MADIHA trailed two wide into the turn, tipped three wide at the quarter pole, steered out in the lane and failed to threaten. ROUSING JEWEL stalked the speed up close on the inside, lost ground under asking on the turn and tired in the lane.

JUST A KISS reserved off the rail then angled in for the first turn, had to steady slightly off heels early on the bend, picked up stride on the backstretch, drew closer when roused on the far turn, split the leaders at the quarter pole, took over late on the bend, shook free in upper stretch and drew off under urging. WE THE HOBBY showed early speed then stalked from inside, moved off the fence then got floated out a bit by PURE CHAOS on the backstretch, pressed three deep approaching the far turn, could not touch but remained close past the five-sixteenths pole, chased four deep at the quarter pole, angled into the three path entering the lane, kept trying down the lane and gained second while no match for the winner. GOATSKI brushed with outer rival at the start, followed in range on the inside, challenged from inside leaving the backstretch, took a narrow lead battling with outer rivals on the far turn, lost command nearing the stretch, yielded to the winner in upper stretch and flattened to third. PURE CHAOS stepped to the front and led early in the two path, took pressure from both sides late on the backstretch, fought two then three wide on the far turn and weakened down the lane. WARM RECEPTION moved into the two path traveling in mid-pack, angled inside on the far turn, moved back out in upper stretch and failed to rally. MPERFECTION settled near the back on the inside, between rivals late on the first turn, chased two then three wide on the second bend, moved out in the lane and proved no menace. DIAMOND DAZE saved ground through both turns and never got involved. TURKEY BIRD got bumped back at the start, trailed two then three wide on the first turn, moved inside on the backstretch, saved ground around the far turn and was never a factor. SALLY'S WISH was prominent early from the far outside then tucked to the two path giving chase, lost ground around the far turn and faded in the lane.

GLASS OF JAMESON traveled on the inside at the rear into the turn, shifted to the two path late on the bend, angled out and went between runners in upper stretch, bumped with DON'T FLY STAND BY at the eighth pole, battled into deep stretch and dug in to edge the runner-up. TARGARYIS broke in a bit, pursued in range from inside, crept closer under asking on the turn, cut the corner into the lane, tipped out in upper stretch, bid between rivals entering the last sixteenth and got edged by the winner. DON'T FLY STAND BY chased well off the rail, four deep then fouru wide on the turn, drew closer while bumping with GLASS OF JAMESON with a furlong left to run and got outkicked by the top pair in deep stretch. MR. MACHUPICCHU established the front quickly and set the tone early under pressure, dueled from inside around the turn, kicked clear into the stretch, collared by a rivals at the sixteenth pole and could not hold on. WINDS OF FREEDOM bobbed leaving the gate, raced outside a rival at the back early on, got shuffled to last at the five-sixteenths pole, tipped five wide into the clear and churned on to improve position. TOUGHNESS pressed the pace from outside, moved up on even terms on the turn, could not sustain the challenge entering the lane, stayed within range to the sixteenth pole and weakened late. PANUCO broke in and bumped HEBER, raced up close between, took the turn three then four wide and weakened. HEBER got bumped by PANUCO leaving the gate, chased under coaxing from off the rail, lost ground two to three wide on the turn and faded.

OM TIME GAL was off slow to begin, trailed two wide into the turn, angled out and came six wide into the lane, drifted in while rallying, gained with every stride to the wire but ran out of time. CLAM BEACH floated out a bit early then raced near the back, entered the turn in the two path, tipped out four wide before getting floated out past the quarter pole, came back in upper stretch, lost the crop midstretch and finished willingly to earn the show honors. ALPHA BELLA cleared quickly and crossed over, led with SUNSET GLORY (IRE) to the outside around the first turn, inched ahead first time through the stretch, controlled the pace up the backstretch in-hand, confronted by SUNSET GLORY (IRE) nearing the final bend, disposed of that rival for good past the five-sixteenths pole, asked right-handed at the top of the lane and drew away in deep stretch. STARRY HEAVENS (IRE) broke a bit slow, moved inside racing keenly in hand, continued on the fence near the back to the final turn, hugged the rail to the stretch, tipped out in upper stretch, finished well and got up for second. MRS. ASTOR stalkd the speed from inside, roused with a quarter mile left to run, was closest in pursuit leaving the final turn, tipped outside the leader at the top of the lane, failed to produce a bid and lost second. NADETTE (FR) unhurried in the beginning, trailed on the inside, moved out four deep on the backstretch, chased three deep around the far turn, angled out in the lane and summoned a mild rally to complete the superfecta. KENTUCKY GAL (IRE) was forwardly placed outside a pair of rivals on the first turn, moved into the two path first time through the stretch, ridden along three deep once

again on the far turn, got floated out past the eighth pole and flattened in the last sixteenth. SAKURA BLOSSOM tracked four, three, then two wide early, continued two wide on the clubhouse turn, chased between rivals into the final turn and could not rally in the stretch. KHINJANI (GB) settled next to the fence, saved ground to the stretch and failed to respond. VENGANZA broke a step slow on the far outside, pulled three deep on the first turn, traveled two wide around the clubhouse turn, chased outside a pair of rivals around the final turn, tipped out in the lane and flattened. SUNSET GLORY (IRE) raced outside the leader early then stalked in the two path, challenged leaving the backstretch, could kick on with the winner past the five-sixteenths pole and weakened in the lane. SUN OF HILL (BRZ) pulled between rivals early, moved inside for the second turn, trailed up the backstretch, raced a bit off the rail into the lane and had little left for the drive.

LAST CALL PAUL stalked seven deep to the turn, took aim from the four path leaving the bend, dueled into the final furlong, took over midstretch, kicked clear in the final sixteenth to win going away. SEATTLE SURF sprinted clear and crossed over, took pressure past the half-mile pole, moved clear once again with a quarter mile remaining, challenged by LAST CALL PAUL in upper stretch, fought to the sixteenth pole and yielded late. NOBEL GARY chased between rivals from the two path to the turn, angled out and came four wide into the lane, finished determinedly in the drive and outdueled DIRTY WORDS for the show honors. DIRTY WORDS chased the top pair inside several rivals, saved ground to the stretch, moved off the fence and got outkicked for third.

NESSO'S LASTHARRAH grabbed the early lead and set the pace from inside, challenged from outside at the three-eighths pole, disposed of outer rival in upper stretch and held well in the final strides. CITY EXILE (GB) tracked in range from the rail position, crept closer in the middle stages, continued to save ground through the far turn, angled out in the last sixteenth, finished gamely but could not get by the winner. TWIRLING POINT sat in mid-pack on the inside, was coaxed along on the far turn before finding some traffic late on the bend, cut the corner into the stretch, moved out shortly after and finished well

to gain third. SIENNOIS (IRE) laid off the pace two wide then found the rail, shifted to the two path again on the far turn, angled out a bit with a furlong remaining and put in a late run to earn a minor award. CHARGE FOR GOLD turned his head right before the gate opened and broke just a hair slow, chased in the two path early on, challenged from outside at the three-eighths pole, hounded the winner to the top of the lane, then got turned away in upper stretch, drifted out a bit midstretch and flattened. EYE ON RY broke a step slow, settled inside then started to pull late on the clubhouse turn, tugged again midway on the backstretch, tipped three wide around the far turn and finished with a belated rally. REIQUIST settled in mid-pack outside a rival, rounded the far turn two then three wide and failed to respond in the drive. RED CROSS KNIGHT tracked in the two path, went three deep into the far turn, asked around the bend, got floated out a bit midstretch, steadied late but was already starting to weaken. DONCIC reserved in the beginning on the inside, had one rival beat into the far turn, angled out and came five wide into the stretch, moved out further in the drive and failed to threaten. MANIATIC (IRE) broke a step slow, raced outside a rival near the back, traveled three then four wide on the far turn and weakened.
