FLAMBOYANT bumped inner rival leaving the gate, settled in the two path, crept closer while moving out wide on the backstretch, bid four deep on the far turn, battled into the final furlong, duelled outside MIGHTY TORO in deep stretch and dug in for the score. MIGHTY TORO followed in range from the two path, three then two deep in the middle stages, launched a bid three deep on the far turn, led between foes in upper stretch, fought inside FLAMBOYANT late and yielded grudgingly. FINIBALL steered to the two path racing in the middle of the pack, moved into range two, three, then four wide on the far turn, finished willingly down the lane and earned third. RAGING INFERNO pressed the pace from outside, led between rivals at the quarter pole, lost command in upper stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. BORN TO ROCK rated along the inside in the early going, traveled between foes then a bit off the rail on the backstretch, asked in the two path between runners on the far turn, pursued within striking distance to the sixteenth pole, then weakened late.

PYROKINETIC sat off the pace on the inside, shifted to the two path around the far turn, moved out further in the lane and could not rally. PLETTENBERG BAY tracked the pace from the rail position, moved up inside the top pair but got put in tight and steadied leaving the backstretch, gave chased still on the rail then two wide into the stretch and weakened. HEAVENLY MATCH got bumped by the winner leaving the gate, reserved two then three wide near the back, tipped to the four path on the far turn and failed to menace. BOGARTS BUCCHERO trailed from inside early, went outside a rival on the backstretch, had one beat into the far turn, remained two wide to the stretch and was never a factor. BLACK PEARL saved ground towards the rear, trailed around the far turn and never got involved. ELUSIVE CON set the pace under pressure from RAGING INFERNO, vied with outer rivals on the far turn, lost the lead approaching the quarter pole, stayed on to upper stretch, then gave way past the eighth pole.

MY GIRL MIA led early inside a trio of rivals, cleared at the three-eighths pole and drew away on the turn, continued to open up at the top of the lane and widened under a drive to the wire. SUGAREE traveled in mid-pack on the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, rallied from the fence and gained second. CELESTIAL SKIES pressed the leader from between rivals, could not keep up with MY GIRL MIA early on the turn, chased two then three wide to the

stretch and churned on to earn third. RICH OF JOY broke through the gate, brought back around and reloaded, got bumped and crowded at the dispatch, chased from off the pace staying off the rail, split foes into the turn, gained in the two path then along the rail around the bend but flattened out in the furlong grounds. OM TIME GAL bumped leaving the gate, had one beat then trailed up the backstretch, tipped to the three path around the bend and improved position. SEXY BLUE got knocked into RICH OF JOY at the start, raced well off the rail from off the pace, came six wide into the stretch and summoned a mild rally. SUSIE'S LOADED followed in range staying away from the rail, lost ground three then two wide on the turn and weakened in the drive. CHURCH LADY (IRE) broke in and bumped, lacked early speed, exited the bend in the five path and passed tired rivals. DANZIG TIL DAWN hustled from the gate, chased from off the rail near mid-pack in the early going, went three deep into the turn, chased two wide turning for home and failed to respond. VRONAWAY chased two, three then four wide to the stretch and weakened down the lane. LOVE LOCK broke in and bumped, attended the pace four deep, lost ground on the turn, entered the lane in the five path and tired. SHADY STRIPES brushed leaving the gate, pressed three deep to the turn, failed to kick on with the winner with three furlongs remaining, chased three then four wide to the stretch and weakened.

KING OF DRAGONS reserved at the back in the early going, taken to the inside, split foes at the quarter pole, steered out at the top of the lane, surged late from the middle portion of the track and drove past the runner-up approaching the wire. FEELING LUCKY was closest in pursuit from the two path, moved up on even terms at the half-mile pole, took over in upper stretch, cleared midstretch, drifted out and got run down by the winner. CARDIFF CRACK settled outside a rival, in hand on the backstretch, asked three then four wide on the far turn, tipped out for a clear run in the drive, rallied in deep stretch but got put in tight and steadied between foes late. VENTRY STRAND unhurried and taken to the inside, went between foes on the backstretch, asked two to three

wide on the far turn, bumped between rivals in upper stretch, closed well in the final furlong and missed the show honors. STYLISHLYACCLAIMED followed in range in the two path, crept closer on the backstretch, came under a ride on the far turn, went three wide into the lane, chased within striking distance into the final furlong but went evenly late. TRUMP ERA grabbed the early lead and set the tone on the inside, headed at the half-mile pole, dueled around the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. MOMENT OF VALOR settled off the rail then angled in for the clubhouse turn, closed in late on the second bend but could not summon the needed late kick. ALLEQUIN SUMMER traveled six wide leaving the chute, angled to the three path, fell out of range on the first turn, gained ground in the middle stages, angled to the four path around the far turn, bumped in upper stretch, checked between at the sixteenth pole and could not recover. SOGNO DI VINO took a stalking position on the inside, given his cue at the quarter pole, came a bit off the rail into the lane and weakened in the furlong grounds. NAFTIS pulled early first time through the stretch, tracked along the rail into the far turn, followed into the range while moving to the two path around the far turn and faded down the lane. CHROMEFLASH broke a step slow and lost a clear path at the start, traveled along the rail then in the two path racing near the back, traveled three deep on the backstretch, remained three wide to the stretch, angled out at the top of the lane and failed to menace. ORACLE OF PARADISE raced near the back on the inside, got put in a bit tight past the five-sixteenths pole, stayed on the inside and came up empty in the lane. THERE WAS A RIDER'S OBJECTION PLACED BY THE RIDER ABOARD CARIFF CRACK AGAINST FEELING LUCKY. AFTER A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED THAT ALTHOUGH FEELING LUCKY DID DRIFT OUT AND BOTHER CARDIFF CRACK LATE, IT DID NOT WARRANT A DISQUALIFICATION.

TAM TAM was closest in pursuit of the leader from inside in the early going, crept closer on the backstretch, flanked the leader into the far turn, followed in the two path to the stretch, challenged at the top of the lane, seized control midstretch and drove clear in the last sixteenth. LOOKIN AT DIAMOND settled on the inside, stayed on the fence through the far turn, tipped out into the lane, closed well to gain second but could not reach the winner. KENSINGTON LANE (IRE) stepped to the front and crossed over, controlled the pace up the backstretch and far turn, challenged by TAM TAM at the top of the lane, clung to narrow advantage at the eighth pole, relinquished the lead shortly, weakened in the final sixteenth but was able to save third. KING OF GOSFORD (GB) stalked in the two path, picked up stride around the far turn, bid between rivals at the eighth pole, dug in to put a head in front late and held over DETAIN (IRE) in the closing moments. DETAIN (IRE) settled in mid-pack along the inside then moved to the two path, asked two then three wide on the far turn, moved out in the lane, closed in under left handed urging, rallied outside the top trio in deep stretch while drifting and just missed. EL POTENTE showed early speed then ceded command to CABO SPIRIT, stalked in hand up the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, given his cue at the top of the lane, challenged inside a pair of rivals at the eighth pole, put a head in front with a sixteenth remaining but got outkicked by the top pair late. CABO SPIRIT fought briefly with EL POTENTE for the early lead then took control, controlled the pace to the far turn, remained clear around the bend, drifted into the lane, headed at the eighth pole, dug in while drifting out a bit more and yielded grudgingly. ASTRONOMER reserved along the inside, asked two wide on the far turn, chased within range down the stretch but failed to summon the needed response. ARTISLAS angled to the inside racing towards the rear, navigated the far turn two then three wide, angled out in the stretch and showed a mild response to improve position. FREEDOM'S NOT FREE took a stalking position on the inside, lost a bit of ground on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch and failed to answer the call. TWIRLING POINT unhurried in the opening stages and moved to the rail, drew closer on the backstretch, coaxed along on the far turn, tipped out and asked for more at the top of the lane but could not rally. ALMENDARES (GB) broke a step slow, tucked inside at the back of the pack, went outside a rival at the quarter pole, steered out in the lane and was never a factor. SINSEL (BRZ) broke a step slow and lost his path at the start, pulled and became rank in the early stages, rounded the far turn in the two path and failed to menace. SEAL TEAM (GB) reserved in the early going next to the rail near the back, ran up on heels and took up past the five-sixteenths pole, continued along the rail to the stretch and could not make an impact.
