JASMINE set the pace along the inside under pressure, moved clear on the far turn, drifted out under left handed urging midstretch, corrected with the right hand at the sixteenth pole and held safely. CAVES stalked the top pair from inside, tipped two wide at the quarter pole, took aim at the winner, lacked the needed late kick but finished willingly to hold second. SILKIE SEVEI (IRE) took a bump at the start, traveled near the back on the inside, two wide at the quarter pole, chased between in upper stretch, finished determinedly through the lane but could not get by CAVES for second. RONILLA settled next to the fence, drew closer on the backstretch, moved into range on the far turn and chased evenly to the wire. MOLLY E broke out and bumped, went up to press the pace from outside, chased after the leader two then three wide on the far turn and weakened. ALYN'S GIRL sat off the pace in the two path, crept closer in the middle stages, traveled two then three wide on the second bend and weakened in the lane. AUTHENTIC GRACE raced outside a rival towards the rear, went three deep on the far turn, four wide leaving that bend and lacked a rally. KIZAZI trailed the field in the opening rounds, rounded the far turn in the two path then found the rail and was never a factor.

LUNAR VELOCITY showed the way in the two path with rivals to the outside, inched clear in the middle stages, roused midway on the far turn while along the inside, kicked away into the stretch, widened under a drive and was ridden out through deep stretch. LUXOR MAGIC stalked along the inside, shifted to the two path on the far turn, watched the winner open up in upper stretch and stayed on for a clear second. SUDDEN IMPACT pressed the pace from outside, lost touch with the leader on the backstretch, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, started to weaken midway around the bend, faded in the lane but was able to safely secure third. DANIELLE raced up close three deep in the four path on the first turn, coaxed along leaving the backstretch, dropped back two wide then along the rail on and came up empty in the lane. MS LIU stalked four deep in the five path on the first turn, remained wide in the middle stages, fell back three then two wide outside DANIELLE on the far turn and had little left for the drive.

REPO MAN coaxed along chasing the top trio from out of range up the backstretch, closed in around the turn, roused at the top of the lane but was boxed in along the rail, shifted out to a clear path midstretch, drew alongside KING ANUNOBY with a sixteenth remaining and surged clear. KING ANUNOBY vied with outer pair up the backstretch, held a short lead dueling through the turn, showed the way into the final furlong, yielded to the winner late and held on for second. HOAXER broke a step slow, trailed the field early, looked to advance but found traffic behind a pair of rivals on the turn, steered out in the lane, unleashed a rally from outside and almost got by KING ANUNOBY for second. SIR ROCKATAN took a bump at the start, settled inside rivals from off the pace, traveled along the rail then in the two path on the turn, angled out in the lane and finished evenly. SAN MORITZ raced between rivals from off the pace, took the turn two wide, drifted out in upper stretch and offered a mild response to whittle the gap on the winner. JACK EM UP away alertly from outside, vied three deep up the backstretch, chased in the three path on the turn and flattened out. YOU WANT SOME broke in and bumped, vied between runners for early command, dueled outside the winner on the turn, fought to the eighth pole and weakened. MOVINGWITHPURPOSE broke in, bumped and lost his path at the start, coaxed along near the back, saved ground through the turn and failed to menace. NICHOLS got bumped by YOU WANT SOME at the dispatch, ridden along outside a pair of rivals from off the pace, continued three wide around the bend and failed to make an impact.

WINIKA stepped to the front from inside, took pressure on the backstretch, cleared at the quarter pole, dug in under right handed urging, came under threat from rivals late and was able to hold on. LANILLA sat off the pace outside a rival, remained two wide to the far turn, swung five wide nearing the stretch, reeled in the leader late and missed. CAT THE CONFIDANTE (IRE) trailed outside a rival or in the two path, angled six wide leaving the far turn, rallied while drifting in through the final furlong and finished a game third. HEAVENLY BELLE stalked the pace from inside, saved ground through the far turn, waited behind the leader leaving the bend, roused at the top of the lane, finished willingly from the fence then came out a bit late, ran into traffic approaching the wire but did not cost her any placings. SPECIALTY settled on the inside, drew closer between rivals leaving the backstretch, tipped three wide into the lane, lacked room midstretch, shifted out into the clear and kept trying to the wire. backstretch, chased four deep at the five-sixteenths pole and weakened. LADY MARYANN raced up close in the two path, pressed from outside then between rivals on the backstretch, could not match strides with the leader on the far turn and tired down the lane.

TEE N OFF tracked from inside then moved into the two path on the clubhouse turn, went between rivals on the backstretch, came under a ride two then three wide on the far turn, could not make any headway on the winner down the lane but stayed on to best

the others. MIO BAMBINO was off slow to begin, traveled in the two path inside a rival at the back into the first turn, moved out and drew closer in the middle stages, advanced four deep around the far turn but flattened out in the furlong grounds. SOUTHERN MELODEE dueled from outside early then pressed the leader up the backstretch, failed to keep up with STAY FOR THE BLOOM midway around the far turn, chased two wide into the lane and weakened. STAGGER LEE bothered leaving the gate, pulled the rider along the in the two path around the first turn then continued to tug on the backstretch, suffered a mild shuffle on the far turn, angled four wide approaching the stretch and weakened down the lane. MILLBO BAGGINS broke well, forwardly placed along the inside early, asked while still next to the fence on the far turn, cut the corner into the lane and faded. BOWTIE BOYS dropped off the pace two then three wide around the clubhouse turn, got shuffled back on the second bend, came four wide into the stretch and faded. RHYTHEM ON STAGE got crowded leaving the gate, trailed three wide on the first turn, saved ground through the second bend and was never a factor. TIGRRRR WHITWORTH stalked in the four path around the first turn, raced three deep leaving the backstretch, faded around the far turn, then tired and was eased in the furlong grounds.
