SENSATIONAL DREAM hopped at the start to spotting the field a few lengths, moved into range from inside, waited along the rail on the turn, challenged outer trio late on the bend, seized control turning for home, kicked clear when roused in upper stretch, drew away under hand urging and remained well clear to the wire. ICONS ONLY set the pace under pressure from a pair of rivals, maintained a short lead while moving into the two path on the turn, overtaken by SENSATIONAL DREAM late on the bend, kept on down the lane and secure second. DEBBY'S GAL pressed ICONS ONLY from outside, fought between rivals on the turn, went three wide into the lane and flattened out in the final furlong. SUGAR LOVIN raced up close three deep, fought in the three then four path on the turn and weakened in the drive.

TAM'S LITTLE ANGEL stalked the leader outside a rival, challenged from outside at the three-eighths pole, dueled around the bend and put a head in front at the quarter pole, drew clear midstretch and held safely. FALABELLA got pinballed leaving the gate and had to take up, chased from off the pace on the inside, got put in a bit tight and checked early on the turn, eased off the rail late on the bend, finished full of run to get up for second but could not reach the winner. EMPRESS MATILDA (GB) broke out and bumped FALABELLA, settled inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, angled out and finished well but got outkicked for second. ELITE HEAT (GB) sat off the pace in the early going, traveled two wide on the turn, swung out for the stretch and offered a mild response to round out the superfecta. MY KAT sped clear and set the tone early, challenged by the winner at the three-eighths pole, dueled around the turn, failed to keep up with a furlong remaining and weakened. OVETA'S HOBBY broke in and bumped hard at the start causing the rider to lose his balance momentarily, trailed two then three wide on the turn, angled out in the drive and never threatened. LITTLE TINKER ELLE got bumped hard between rivals leaving the gate, took a stalking position on the inside, steadied a bit behind the leader into the turn, saved ground to the stretch, moved out in the lane and weakened. INVINCIBLE MOLLY (GB) tracked the speed from the two path on the turn and weakened. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING EMPRESS MATILDA (GB), FALABELLA, LITTLE TINKER ELLE AND OVETA'S HOBBY AT THE START. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THAT OVETA'S HOBBY CONTRIBUTED TO HER OWN PROBLEMS AT THE START AND THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

BLAME ASHLEY absorbed a bump from ASWOME AMY at the start, set a pressured pace from inside, shook free at the three-sixteenths pole and drew away. JUST LIBERTY pressed the pace from outside up the backstretch and around the turn, failed to keep up with BLAME ASHELY into the stretch and stayed on to hold second. GOLDEN CHISPA tracked along the inside from out of range, hugged the rail to the stretch, showed a mild rally and got by AWSOME AMY for third. AWSOME AMY broke in and bumped, settled off the pace outside a rival, took the turn three wide, under a drive turning for home and got edged for third. PRO PAYNE showed brief speed between rivals then took a stalking position, came under a ride in the two path on the turn and weakened down the lane. FAST AFFAIR dropped back early, went three wide into the turn, moved into the two path and failed to menace. I KNOW NOTHING broke in a bit to lose a step, went two wide into the turn, angled out to the four path around the bend and failed to rally.

SAND BAGGER settled along the rail, moved off the fence on the backstretch, angled back to the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, tipped three wide approaching the stretch, seized control outside the eighth pole, kicked clear under right handed urging in midstretch and was ridden out the last sixteenth. NON DOMICILE set the pace with LOVE THE PRESSURE alongside, overtaken by that rival past the half-mile pole, regained the lead into the far turn, inched ahead around the bend, cleared briefly at the three-sixteenths pole, quickly confronted by SAND BAGGER, relinquished the lead into the final furlong and stayed on to secure second. KNOWHERE took a stalking position along the rail, came under a ride following the leader around the far turn, moved off the rail in upper stretch and kept trying to earn the show honors. REDIAL dropped off the pace in the three then two path on the first turn, remained two wide through the second bend and passed tired rivals. GLORY'Z CLUBHOUSE chased between rivals up the backstretch, took the turn two then three wide, angled widest at the top of the stretch, closed in steadily and got up in the shadow of the wire. MUSTANG KNICKY dueled for the lead from inside, put outer rival away midway around the bend, led clear into the final sixteenth and got run down in the closing moments. LOW LA BUNNY stalked the top pair up the backstretch, saved ground through the turn then came off the rail a bit approaching the stretch, finished willingly through the final furlong but lacked the needed late kick. BIG BLAST settled inside, moved into striking distance in the middle stages, saved ground through the far turn, came out and bumped NYCE SHOT in upper stretch, dug in late and got up. MISS MO BROWN forwardly placed on the inside, moved to the two path drew alongside the leader on the backstretch, kept the pressure on through the far turn, put a head in front at the eighth pole, led into deep stretch and got nailed by the winner. JUST WORK IT OUT stepped to the front and moved to the rail, took pressure on the backstretch, maintained a short lead to the stretch, relinquished the lead with a furlong left to run, flattened late but was able to hold on for third. NYCE SHOT followed in range three deep in the opening stages, chased in the two path between runners on the far turn, got bumped by BIG BLAST twice in upper stretch, kept trying through the final furlong and almost got by JUST WORK IT

OUT for the show. MS GRAINGER DANGER raced up close outside a rival, three deep on the backstretch, failed to keep up with the top pair and gave chase still three deep around the far turn, then weakened in the drive. LIHUE PRINCESS settled in the three path, traveled outside a rival on the backstretch, rounded the far turn three then two wide and proved no menace. STAY MY GIRL traveled three wide into the first turn then quickly moved to the two path while racing near the back, rounded the far turn two then three wide, drifted into the lane and was never a factor. ESTRELLA ESMERAL was antsy in the gate, pulled in the two path early, tracked between rivals on the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn and tired in the lane. KOOL IT was rank along the inside early, settled along the rail in hand, angled three wide approaching the stretch and was never a factor. DIVINE KISMET unhurried and steered to the inside, coaxed along on the far turn, asked left handed at the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING BIG BLAST AND NYCE SHOT IN UPPER STRETCH. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THAT ALTHOUGH BIG BLAST DID COME OUT AND MAKE CONTACT WITH NYCE SHOT, THE INCIDENT DID NOT WARRANT A DISQUALIFICATION.
