EMANCIPATE fought with outer pair up the backstretch, cleared at the five-sixteenths pole, bumped with a riderless ALA SAWAB and steadied in tight at the quarter pole, continued with the lead from the two path to the stretch and stayed clear under right handed urging and steady handling. RICCELLI vied between rivals to the turn, dueled with EMANCIPATE early on the bend, got put in tight quarters by a riderless ALA SAWAB and steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved inside then eased back off the rail, spun three wide into the lane and finished willingly for a clear second. BID fought for the lead three deep, steadied when crowded by a riderless ALA SAWAB at the three-eighths pole, lost ground through the turn, trailed four wide into the lane and tired. ALA SAWAB threw his head then stumbled badly a few strides out of the gate and unseated the rider in the process, ran loose on the outside up the backstretch, bothered all three rivals while easing down to the rail through the turn, caught by the rider on the clubhouse turn and walked off. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY CONCERNING THE START OF ALA SAWAB AND THE STEWARDS RULED THAT HE CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS LEAVING THE GATE AND WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

CAROLINA LEGACY grabbed the lead quickly, met the bid from RIDE THE TIGER at the five-sixteenths pole, turned that rival away turning for home and powered away under strong handling and left handed encouragement. RIDE THE TIGER stalked the speed outside rivals, challenged CAROLINA LEGACY at the five-sixteenths pole, got turned away by the winner coming into the stretch and stayed on for a clear second. YAUTOWN dropped back early, angled out at the half-mile pole, went four deep into the turn, moved down to the three path then tipped back four wide late on the bend, showed a mild response down the stretch and picked up the show honors. SIGMA BOY sat off the pace, chased three deep leaving the backstretch, angled to the two path then came three wide into the lane and improved position. MARION MAGIC raced in mid-pack staying off the rail, traveled in the three path on the turn and weakened. MY MAN HUEY was prominent early to the inside of the pacesetter, started to weaken along the rail on the turn and tired down the lane. RED HOT LEAD broke a step slow, traveled near the back inside rivals, got put in tight and took up at the three-eighths pole, trailed a bit off the rail into the lane and passed tired rivals. ROSTRON pursued from off the pace up the backstretch, went two wide into the turn, angled to the rail and saved ground to the stretch, then failed to menace in the lane. GATO VOLADOR followed in range early, fell out of range in the two path on the turn and faded.

COZY CURLIN KITTEN tracked in the two path around the first turn, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, failed to keep up with NO CAP at the five-sixteenths pole and chased after that rival three then two wide around the bend, watched the leader kick away in upper stretch, came back on in midstretch, drew alongside NO CAP inside the sixteenth pole and drove clear. NO CAP stalked up close along the rail, bid between runners at the sevens-sixteenths pole, took over with three furlongs remaining, moved clear at the five-sixteenths marker, drew away in upper stretch, carried a diminishing lead into the final sixteenth and yielded late. SHARED FUTURE forwardly placed early in the two path, rounded the far turn two then three wide and gained ground late on the top pair. HIMARI stepped to the front along the inside, led a bit off the rail around the first turn, confronted by a pair of rivals leaving the backstretch, lost command early on the far turn, failed to keep up with the new leader at the five-sixteenths pole, started to waken under right handed urging and tired down the lane. MEDJUGORJE was off slow from the outside, steered over to the rail trailing early, moved to the two path still at the back late on the far turn and was never a factor.

TEST SCORE tracked just out of range along the inside, dropped off the pace running through the stretch for the time, was on the move between rivals on the final turn, chased three wide into the lane, drew alongside the leader midstretch, put a head in front past the sixteenth pole and gamely prevailed. ATITLAN angled over to the inside trailing the field in the opening stages, went between runners leaving the backstretch, found the rail again on the final turn, swung out into the stretch, rallied between rivals, challenged in the last sixteenth, fought outside TEST SCORE late and could not get by. ATOMIC AGE settled in mid-pack in the two path then along the rail on the first turn, continued on the inside through the clubhouse turn, drew closer while angling out on the final turn, came five wide into the stretch, bid in upper stretch, put a head in front briefly at the sixteenth pole but got outkicked by the top pair. GOLD

PHOENIX (IRE) unhurried in the early going and steered to the rail, picked up stride while moving to the two path on the final turn, steadied when lacking room behind a rival turning for home, cut to the inside, rallied along the fence but lacked the needed late punch. MONDEGO (GB) settled outside a rival, remained two wide to the final turn, moved into range while angling four wide, seized control in upper stretch but got outkicked in the last sixteenth. NITTI (IRE) reserved on the inside, went two wide around the clubhouse turn, asked while angling widest around the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, challenged from the middle portion of the track but flattened out in the late stages. MAAZ (FR) traveled outside a rival near the back, continued in the two path on the clubhouse turn, asked three then two wide on the final bend, got carried out into the stretch and could not rally. FLASHIEST stalked three then two wide around the first turn, taken off the pace running through the stretch first time around, drew closer on the backstretch, took aim in the three path turning for home but tired down the lane. SANTA BARBARIAN away quickly from inside, showed early foot inside a pair of rivals then took hold and dropped back to a stalking position, tracked from the rail out of range, coaxed along on the final turn, got put in tight and checked entering the lane, then weakened in the drive. PACKS A WAHLOP dueled outside OLD PAL for early command, cleared that rival and moved to the inside for the clubhouse turn, controlled the pace to the three-sixteenths pole, confronted in upper stretch and folded once overtaken. OLD PAL went up to duel for the lead from inside then allowed PACKS A WAHLOP to take control, stalked that rival along the rail, came under a ride on the final turn, chased two wide into the stretch and tired.
