HOWIE'S LAW sprinted clear from inside, started to open up crossing the quarter pole under light coaxing, set down into the stretch and padded the margin under left handed urging and steady handling. HERE'S SOME MORE tracked the speed outside a pair of rivals, navigated the turn in the three path, kept trying down the lane and got by FUMANO'S MAGIC for second. FUMANO'S MAGIC was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, chased in the two path through the turn, failed to produce a bid in the lane and got edged for second late. LETMEIN trailed under coaxing up the backstretch, went two then three wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. KID CHARLEMAGNE settled off the rail, traveled two wide aro9und the bend and weakened. CRUISIN FOR CALI tracked the lone speed from inside, lost ground around the turn and weakened.

FIRST TIME LISTING stalked the top trio to the turn, crept closer along the rail on the turn, chased determinedly into the final sixteenth, surged late inside CHISELED IN STONE and got up in the final jumps. CHISELED IN STONE set the pace under pressure from pair of outer rivals early, drew clear early on the turn and showed the way freely along the rail to the stretch, continued to hold a clear lead over FIRST TIME LISTING into the last sixteenth, then came under threat from that rival late and got nailed. HALLAGREY pressed between early, failed to keep up with the leader and chased in the two path around the bend, followed within striking distance through the lane, failed to produce a bid and managed to save third. RED RAIDER settled outside a pair of rivals, rounded the turn three then two wide, steered out in upper stretch, finished willingly and almost got by HALLAGREY for third. SMOKE RIDER broke a step slow, followed in range from the two path leaving the backstretch, came under a ride at the quarter pole, found the rail in upper stretch and lacked further response. BEL AIR BLINTZCESS also broke a step slow, sat off the pace on the inside, hugged the rail through the turn, steered out in the lane and failed to rally. BOTTLED IN BOND was off slow to begin, trailed the field from the rail into the turn, went outside a rival midway around the turn, angled out into the final sixteenth and was never a factor. HIGH HULL GILL pressed the pace three deep to the turn, chased after the lead in the three path through the bend and weakened. LIL PRINCE CAIRO coaxed along early near the back of the pack, saved ground through the turn, shifted two wide leaving the bend and was never a factor.

DANZING FLYER pressed the pace from outside, dueled down the stretch and edged clear in the final sixteenth. HARNEY LANE chased after the top pair on the inside, pursued two turning for home, finished willingly in the furlong grounds and got by CHASING KAT for second. CHASING KAT grabbed the early lead and showed the way from inside under pressure from DANZING FLYER, maintained a short lead over that rival through the turn, dueled into the final furlong, lost the lead midstretch, yielded to the winner in the final sixteenth and got nailed for second. MIZ CLUBCALI settled well off the inside, gained five then four wide on the turn and went evenly through the final furlong. GIANT KID broke a step slow and outward, trailed early then passed a rival up the backstretch, tucked inside on the turn and advanced along the rail, kept trying down the lane but needed to find more. RO TOWN stalked the top pair from off the rail, navigated the turn three wide and finished evenly down the lane. SEXY BLUE lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn and passed tired rivals. FUN TO RUN followed in range three deep in the early going, took the turn three to four wide and faded in the lane. LADY GREGORY sat off the pace up the backstretch, went two wide into the turn, angled four wide for the stretch and weakened.

WAITING FOR YOU (GB) got bumped leaving the gate, settled inside, moved into range running up the backstretch, waited along the inside around the far turn, rallied through a tight spot between rivals while bumping with CORTINA D' AMPREZZO (IRE) and finished gamely for second. STRUCK BY HER (IRE) got bumped at the start, followed in range in the two path, picked up stride while angling four wide on the far turn, challenged in upper stretch and got outkicked by the top pair. MIA FAMILIA broke in and bumped, stalked four then three deep on the clubhouse turn, challenged three deep on the second bend, put a head in front with a furlong remaining but flattened late. RUN WITH LIBERTY got bumped into inner rival leaving the gate, raced up close three deep, pressed the leader in the middle stages, dueled into and around the far turn, led into the stretch, lost the lead at the eighth pole and flattened late. BEAUTIFUL DAWN bobbled a bit leaving the gate, raced up close and moved to the inside, put in a rail bid at the five-sixteenths pole, cleared outer pair into the stretch and held safely under right handed urging and steady handling. NOT SO MERRY MARY stalked from inside, came under a ride on the turn, tipped out and moved into second in upper stretch, chased determinedly into deep stretch and had to settle for second best. SAUCED UP chased from off the pace up the backstretch, traveled along the rail then in the two path on the turn, swung out into the stretch and ran on to earn the show honors. PAVULAR settled at the back well off the rail, angled in some near the half-mile pole, steadied behind a rival leaving the backstretch, angled to the inside, angled out to the three path, cut to the two path turning for home and kept on to round out the superfecta. RUNAROUND SUE broke a step slow, trailed on the inside, passed a tired rival on the turn, hugged the rail to the stretch and offered a mild response. I'M SMOKEN HOT coaxed along from off the pace, went three wide into the turn, angled to the two path then steered back out wide, raced in the five path turning coming into the stretch and lacked a rally. HER STRUT sprinted to the front and set the tone early, angled over to the inside, came off the rail a bit and was challenged from rivals on both sides on the turn, lost the lead at the quarter pole and folded in the stretch. REGAL PATRIOT sprinted clear and crossed over to the inside, opened up on the turn, carried a comfortable lead into the final sixteenth, grew weary late but was able to hold. HARCYN traveled in mid-pack on the inside, ran two then three wide on the turn, angled out in the drive, reeled in the leader late but ran out of ground. CODE DUELLO sat off the pace and moved inside, tipped out into the lane, chased between rivals into the final furlong and finished gamely for third. AGENCY raced towards the back on the inside, hugged the rail through the turn and finished well to round out the superfecta.

GREGORY'S PRIDE raced outside rivals then trailed on the inside into the turn, passed a tired rivals around the bend, tipped out into the lane, angled wide in upper stretch and finished well to improve position. DANIEL'S MAGIC got crowded between rivals early, chased three then two wide on the turn, steered out into the lane, got bumped and put in tight between rivals inside the sixteenth pole and churned on to the wire. TYGRA broke slow, lacked room behind a troubled DANIEL'S MAGIC early, ridden along the inside through the turn and improved position. RABEEBA brushed with CHANNEL PLACE at the start, had to take hold when running on heels in the two path between rivals on the first turn, stalked the top pair into the far turn, ridden along three then four wide on the far turn, moved into second in upper stretch, drew alongside SHE'S NO QUANT midstretch, took over into the final sixteenth and drove clear. WOLF HILL stalked four deep in the early going, lost ground up the backstretch and trailed into the far turn, traveled in the two path then angled to the rail and passed a couple rivals, moved out past the eighth pole and earned a minor award. CHANNEL PLACE brushed with the winner at the start, tracked three deep between runners, dropped back under urging three to four wide on the second bend and weakened in the drive. KINZLEE'SCHARISMA vied three deep to the half-mile pole, chased after the top pair leaving the backstretch, dropped back to last on the far turn and passed a tired rival in the lane. MOHAVEN fought for command between rivals, dueled outside RABEEBA past the half-mile pole, battled through the far turn, could not keep up with RABEEBA into the stretch and retreated.

MARLA HOOCH settled inside, coaxed closer on the far turn, steered off the fence in upper stretch, rallied to the front with a sixteenth remaining and held over rivals on both sides late. JANZ JOY got bumped into inner rival leaving the gate, tracked in the two path, saved ground through the second bend, bid between rivals midstretch but got outkicked by the winner. PLATINUM GROOVE got bumped leaving the gate, taken back and moved inside, started to move on the far turn, angled out leaving the bend, had to alter sharply around IMPRESSIONISTIC who shifted out into the stretch, rallied widest and finished a game third. TRIBAL stalked along the rail through both turns, came off the rail in upper stretch, bid between rivals with a furlong remaining, fought three deep into the last sixteenth and edged clear. HOTHEAD was closet in pursuit from the two path early on, challenged between rivals at the five-sixteenths pole, dueled into the final furlong, put a head in front midstretch but got outkicked by the winner in the late stages. CALL ME SIR laid off the pace on the inside, coaxed along on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch, closed in from the rail, tipped out with a sixteenth remaining and got up for third. BURNING RUBBER showed the way early from inside, came under threat from a pair of rivals at the five-sixteenths pole, resisted to the eighth pole, lost command midstretch, fought back to the sixteenth pole and weakened. DYNODAVE dropped off the pace early and steered into the two path, found the rail on the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, asked right handed leaving the bend, angled out at the top of the stretch and finished willingly to the wire. UNPRETENTIOUS got crowded back leaving the gate, tucked inside, trailed with a rival to the outside on the backstretch, continued along the fence around the far turn, had two rivals beat turning for home and produced a mild rally down the stretch. KIMMER trailed in the two path around the clubhouse turn, raced outside UNPRETENTIOUS on the backstretch, entered the far turn in the three path, angled down to the rail around the bend and passed tired rivals in the stretch. MIDWAY LANE settled inside, chased two then three wide on the far turn and never responded when called upon.
