DATS MS. BLAME stumbled leaving the gate, traveled between rivals near the back, dropped back to last on the backstretch, had one beat into the far turn, gained along the rail then in the two path on the far turn, angled out and rallied outside the top pair and drove clear late. GOOD GOLLY DOLLY stalked the top trio from inside, angled three wide on the second turn, bid from outside in upper stretch, put a head in front midstretch and got outkicked by the winner late. BUSY MAKING MUNNY bumped with outer rival at the start, vied between rivals, dueled from outside around the far turn, kicked clear past the quarter pole, challenged from outside in upper stretch, lost the lead past the eighth pole and weakened in deep stretch. UNION HEIRESS settled along the rail, shifted to the two path then came back to the fence on the far turn, tipped out into the lane and improved position. SUGAR REIGN bumped with BUSY MAKIN MUNNY at the start, tracked three wide around the clubhouse turn, stayed off the rail up the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. BITTER TRUTH pressed three deep around the first turn then moved up on even terms in the middle stages, lost contact with the top pair at the three-eighths pole, chased three wide to the lane and tired. RICH OF JOY trailed two to three wide early, passed a couple rivals on the backstretch, steered five wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. SUGAREE broke through the gate but never left the stall, sat off the pace three deep on the clubhouse turn, trailed four wide leaving the backstretch, continued to lose ground on the far turn while angling in and was never a factor. VICTORIA'S JEWEL went up to fight for the lead inside a pair of rivals, dueled around the far turn, failed to kick on with the leader past the quarter pole and retreated through the drive.

FARMER TOM raced up close on the inside, applied pressure to the leader from the rail at the halfway mark, took over on the far turn and cleared past the five-sixteenths marker, showed the way into the final furlong, felt pressure from the runner-up with a sixteenth remaining and turned that foe away. HALNINETHOUSAND sat off the pace on the inside, advanced from the fence through the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, challenged from outside into the final sixteenth but got turned away by the winner. ITS THE BANDIT fought inside several rivals around the first turn, moved off the rail on the backstretch, led between rivals past the half-mile pole, dueled into the far turn, yielded to the winner past the five-sixteenths pole and held third. MAJOR MO traveled four then three wide on the clubhouse turn, rounded the far turn two wide then along the rail, picked up a minor award in the lane but failed to threaten the top trio. TIGER TO YOU forwardly placed behind the speed battled outside a rival on the first turn, chased three to four wide on the second bend and flattened out in the late stages. FIRE CHIEF tucked inside at the back, passed rivals on the far turn but failed to menace. DAZZLE COMM vied three deep to the backstretch, failed to keep up and gave chase in the middle stages, dropped back on the far turn and tired. STAGE RUN vied four deep early, lost contact with the leaders on the backstretch, chased four wide into the far turn, dropped back around that bend and had little left for the drive. WASTING ACES vied between rivals then outside on the backstretch, chased inner pair approaching the far turn, lost ground through the second bend and

came up empty in the lane. ZENJIN vied five deep to the backstretch, dropped back in the middle stages, tired on the far turn, eased in the lane and walked off.

UNBINDING (GB) set the pace under pressure up the backstretch, dueled around the turn, shook free in upper stretch, drew off into the final sixteenth and held safely over the late run from the runner-up. HEY LIL LADY unhurried in the going and moved inside, had to wait behind a pair of rivals from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, tipped out into the stretch, finished well through the final furlong to gain second but could not reach the winner. NIKOLINA bumped with inner rival early, tracked from inside, moved out in upper stretch, altered out a bit midstretch and got up for third. HIGH KING followed in range on the inside, put in a rail bid leaving the backstretch, failed to keep up with the leader early on the turn, followed along the rail to the stretch, drew alongside ROWDYBARFIGHT once more at the eighth pole, took over midstretch and drove clear. HEROIC DOSE lost his path and took up early, trailed two wide around the clubhouse turn, had one beat into the second bend, traveled along the rail or in the two path on the far turn, steered out into the clear in the lane, came with a late run and gained second. CHAOTIC NEUTRAL broke a step slow, moved inside, crept closer around the far turn, cut the corner into the lane, finished willingly down the lane and earned the show honors. SHAPOVAL tracked a bit off the rail then along the fence, drew closer leaving the backstretch, shifted three wide on the far turn, bid from outside in the lane but lacked the needed late kick.
