PRACTICAL JACK away quickly, dueled outside SMASHING MACHINE to the eighth pole, put a head in front midstretch and edged clear from the runner-up late. SMASHING MACHINE took a short lead dueling inside PRACTICAL JACK, maintained a slim advantage into the final furlong, lost the lead approaching the sixteenth pole and yielded to the winner late. ON THE BURNER had to take up when SMASHING MACHINE crossed in front early, moved into range quickly, followed behind the top pair along the inside around the turn, tipped out at the top of the stretch, failed to produce a bid but finished a clear third. CHEEVER broke out and brushed STRIKE A MATCH but was quickly corrected, dropped off the pace, took the turn two to three wide and lacked a rally. STRIKE A MATCH got nudged by CHEEVER leaving the gate, stalked the top pair from off the rail then outside a rival, rounded the bend three then two wide and weakened down the lane. CHARISMA trailed the field on the inside into the turn, eased out to the four path around the bend and was never a factor.

BALNIKHOV (IRE) tucked inside at the back, drew closer on the backstretch and had to pause briefly behind PATH TO POWER (GB) at the half-mile pole, continued along the rail into the far turn, eased over to the two path then swung five wide leaving the bend, stormed to the front at the eighth pole, kicked clear from PATH TO POWER (GB) midstretch and remained strong to the wire. PATH TO POWER (GB) settled in the two path then along the rail on the first turn, altered in a bit from behind STAMP MY PASSPORT at the half-mile pole, pursued the top trio in the two path through the far turn, angled out into the lane, challenged in upper stretch, finished gamely in the final furlong but was outkicked by the winner. NONE ABOVE THE LAW settled three then two wide on the first turn, bid three deep at the half-mile pole, grabbed the lead late on the final turn, put inner pair away in upper stretch while confronted by outer rivals, relinquished the lead at the eighth pole, flattened in the late stages but was able to secure third. STAMP MY PASSPORT tracked in the two path, roused three deep on the second bend, took aim in upper stretch and weakened. AMPLITUDE stalked the lone speed along the rail, challenged for the lead inside a pair of rivals at the half-mile pole, fought along the fence through the far turn, then yielded in upper stretch and faded out of contention. BALLADEER jumped out to the front and opened up a comfortable lead in hand early, showed the way along the inside to the backstretch, challenged by rivals on both sides at the half-mile pole, resisted to the quarter pole, gave the lead up shortly after and folded in the stretch.

CONVO raced up close outside the top trio, bid three deep at the five-sixteenths pole, dueled into the final furlong, put a head in front past the sixteenth pole and won the bob over HIGH SOCIETY U on the line. HIGH SOCIETY U scrambled leaving the gate but quickly recovered, stalked the leaders from off the rail, waited two then three wide around the bend, tipped widest at the top of the stretch, bid three deep midstretch and got the worst of the bob to narrowly miss. CHERRY CIDER vied between rivals up the backstretch, dueled inside past the three-eighths marker, fought with outer pair late on the bend, dueled with CONVO into the final furlong still holding a slim advantage, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly late. STREET SWINDLER went up to challenge inside a pair of rivals, failed to keep up with outer trio past the three-eighths pole, saved ground to the stretch, chased within range to the sixteenth pole and flattened late. FIRST OR LAST vied three deep to the turn, dueled outside CHERRY CIDER past the three-eighths pole, fought between rivals late on the turn, yielded in upper stretch and weakened in the furlong grounds. SLICE hopped slightly to come away slow, angled to the inside trailing the field, passed a rival around the bend, chased a bit off the rail into the lane and failed to menace. BANZAI BETTY dropped off the pace early, raced outside SLICE on the turn, trailed into the stretch and was never a factor.

MISS MONICA hit the gate leaving, pressed the top pair from outside up the backstretch, moved up on even terms at the five-sixteenths pole, seized control with a quarter mile remaining, kicked clear from PANDA LISTEN approaching the stretch, drew off under hand urging and flagging from the crop and coasted in hand late. CRAZY HOT MESS broke a step slow, traveled outside rivals near the back early, trailed three deep at the five-sixteenths pole, had a couple rivals beat while entering the lane five deep, finished determinedly down the stretch to gain second but was no match for the winner. HOLMBY followed in range from off the rail, came under a ride in the three path on the turn, was closest in pursuit of the winner with a furlong remaining, flattened late and lost second. FREE CLOSER settled off the rail or outside a rival, navigated the turn three then four wide, failed to summon the needed rally but churned on for a minor award. WELL VERSED stalked the top trio up the backstretch, coaxed along the inside through the turn, cut the corner into the lane and weakened. DEAR DIARY trailed the field in the opening stages, passed a couple rivals while racing two then three wide on the turn but could not threaten at any point. PANDA LISTEN dueled inside FAST AMY to the turn, vied with outer pair at the three-eighths pole, relinquished the lead to the winner at the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch. AVALON ROSE saved ground from off the pace and proved no menace. FAST AMY hit the gate and broke out a bit, went up to duel for the lead outside PANDA LISTEN, fought between rivals with three furlongs remaining, could not keep up with the top pair past the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back to last late on the bend, eased in the final furlong and walked off.

JAGUAR JON brushed with outer rival leaving the gate, followed in range two then three wide to the stretch, drew alongside JETOVATOR at the sixteenth pole, took over late and was able to hold. OWL tracked three deep, fell out of range in the four path entering the turn, angled down to the two path, steered back out into the stretch, unleashed a rally from outside, got by JETOVATOR for second but ran out of ground to nail the winner. JETOVATOR vied three deep up the backstretch and around the turn, put a head in front with a furlong remaining, battled into deep stretch and got outkicked by the top pair. JACK FISH stalked the top trio from inside, bid between rivals at the eighth pole, finished gamely to the wire but came up just short in the end. KING'S RIDE broke in and bumped, laid off the pace on the inside, coaxed along around the turn, came off the fence in upper stretch, rallied between rivals but got put in tight and checked late. COURTSIDE ACTION sat off the pace in the opening stages, exited the backstretch in the three path then quickly moved to the two path, angled widest in the lane, produced a mild rally but needed to find more. PIPER'S CAUSEWAY battled between rivals for command to the eighth pole, chased into the last sixteenth and flattened out. INFINITE SPIRIT got pinballed leaving the gate, raced two wide leaving the backstretch, angled to the rail around the bend and could not produce a bid. BALLYVAUGHAN GIG vied inside a pair of rivals for the early lead, carried a short advantage over outer pair on the turn, lost command dueling into the final furlong and weakened in the last sixteenth. SPEED OF ELON lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn and could not make an impact.
