MS GRAINGER DANGER dueled from inside, failed to keep up with outer rival leaving the backstretch, shifted to the two path and re-bid past the five-sixteenths pole, put a head in front at the top of the lane, put ROSA'S MIRACLE away at the eighth pole and drew away. ENDLESS SMOKE settled in the two path, roused leaving the far turn, rallied into second but could not threaten the winner. ROSA'S MIRACLE got bumped by MAIN IMPACT at the start, dueled from outside through the early stages, cleared at the seven-sixteenths pole, crossed to the inside, confronted by MS GRAINGER DANGER again past the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, could not stay with the winner entering the furlong grounds, flattened late but was able to save third. MAIN IMPACT broke in and bumped ROSA'S MIRACLE, followed in range from the two path then moved over to the rail on the clubhouse turn, stayed on the fence to the far turn, tipped out into the lane, took aim at the winner with a furlong remaining but flattened out in the late stages. TIGER LUCK sat off the pace on the inside, saved ground through the far turn as well, steered out at the three-sixteenths pole, kept trying through the lane but needed to find more. PAVULAR got bumped hard at the start, settled between rivals at the back then raced outside a runner, left backstretch between runners again, moved out in the lane and never threatened. REJOICEFUL settled inside, steadied briefly off heels at the five-eighths pole, hugged the rail to the stretch and weakened. ICECREAM ONTHESIDE traveled three deep at the rear into the first turn, dropped back a bit to rail and tucked inside, traveled a bit off the rail around the far turn, steered out into the lane and was never a factor. VAHEVALA broke in and bumped PAVULAR, tracked along the rail then moved to the two path, raced outside a rival up the backstretch, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. DIVINE KISMET reserved along the inside, moved out on the backstretch, went three deep into the far turn, stayed off the rail to the stretch and had little left for the drive.

MARVELOUSMISSMABEL sprinted clear and crossed over, led a bit off the rail into the lane, continued clear into the final furlong and drew away under right handed encouragement. SHE SPENDSALOT raced up close on the inside, was closest in pursuit of the winner into the final furlong, could not make

any headway late but was clearly second best. DARLIN' DUCHESS raced in mid-pack between rivals, took the turn two wide and got up for third. LIST MY BIZ stalked the lone speed outside a rival, asked right handed at the quarter pole, weakened in the lane but managed to hold on for a minor award. FORGOTTEN MEMORIES came away cleanly but lacked early quickness, trailed on the inside, angled five wide on the turn, summoned a mild rally and improved position down the lane. STORMY GAL followed in range outside rivals, navigated the turn three then four wide and weakened in the drive. CHERRY CANDY bumped with outer rival at the start then steadied behind that foe shortly after, raced near the back in the early going, moved to the two path, steered four wide around the bend, angled out in upper stretch and could not rally. I'M LOVESTRUCK got crowded by inner rival coming out in the beginning, coaxed along from off the pace, traveled on the inside then in the two path around the bend, shifted out at the top of the lane and lacked a rally. STYLISHLY BIG sat off the outside a pair of rivals, remained three wide to the stretch and weakened. SURPRISE D' ORO chased from off the pace on the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch and weakened. JOY THE IMAGE traveled five then four deep up the backstretch racing towards the rear, rounded the turn in the four path and failed to menace. DEL MARGARITA bumped with inner rival at the start, steadied behind another runner early, chased three deep out of range into the turn, dropped back to last and angled to the inside, then came up empty in the stretch run.

LADY MENDELSSOHN pressed four deep up the backstretch, vied three deep on the turn, dueled past the five-sixteenths pole, took over with a quarter mile remaining put STAY IN LINE away turning for home and moved in a bit, challenged by DOTTIE HINSON immediately after, lost command at the eighth pole, fought back through the final furlong and finished gamely to the wire but came up just short. EARLY ENCORE vied three deep to the turn up the backstretch, cleared inner pair and crossed over with three furlongs remaining, challenged by FUMANO'S FIRE at the five-sixteenths pole, turned that rivals away with a quarter mile left to run, drew off into the stretch and widened under right handed encouragement. FANCY FACTS away quickly to clear and crossed over, dueled from inside, maintained command through the turn, battled while drifting out in the late stages and gamely prevailed. CLUBHOUSE BRIDE went up to fight for the lead from outside, dueled around the bend, battled down the lane, got carried out

by FANCY FACTS and lacked the needed late kick to get by. THE LOAN EXCHANGE got bumped and checked early, steadied off heels leaving the backstretch, angled out into the stretch, steered out further while closing late and finished a game third. DONTTELLMEWHATTODO chased two wide then had to pause when FANCY FACTS crossed in front early, followed between rivals through the turn, tipped out in the stretch, pursued determinedly in the final furlong but lacked the needed late punch and got edged for third. MEDORO prominent early four deep leaving the chute, took a stalking position in the two path, bid three deep midway around the far turn, dueled outside THOUGHT PROCESS into the stretch, gained a slim advantage with furlong remaining, dug in the last sixteenth and bested the runner-up. THOUGHT PROCESS pressed the pace from outside in hand, lost touch with the leader at the nine-sixteenths pole, confronted PURA VIDA PRINCESA at the five-sixteenths pole then vied between runners, put a head in front with a quarter mile remaining, dueled inside MEDORO entering the lane, lost command at the eighth pole, fought back gamely into the last sixteenth but had to settle for second best. BOJACA BLESSING stalked the speed from inside, followed behind PURA VIA PRINCESA into the far turn, shifted to the two path late on the bend, chased in range into deep stretch, lacked the needed late kick but was able to hold off BALTIC FIRE to earn the show honors. BALTIC FIRE made light contact with inner rival at the start, laid off the pace on the inside, moved into range leaving the backstretch, rounded the far turn two then three wide, kept on down the lane but could not get by BOJACA BLESSING for third. WHISKEY DECISION unhurried in the opening stages, drew closer from inside on the far turn, moved off the fence at the top of the lane and lacked a rally. CANTO DELLA TERRA (IRE) bumped lightly with BALTIC FIRE leaving the gate, became rank in the chute and finally settled between rivals nearing

the finish line for the first time, traveled a bit off the rail into the clubhouse turn, traveled outside a rival on the backstretch, angled four wide around the far turn and weakened. TAIF raced up close four deep leaving the chute then took a stalking position in the two path, came under a ride on the far turn, rallied between rivals in upper stretch, battled with outer rivals into the last sixteenth, dueled with YEP (GB) in the final strides and won the bob on the line. YEP (GB) got bumped back in the chute, reserved in the opening stages and taken to the inside, drew closer between rivals into the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied six deep midstretch, fought outside TAIF late and got the worst of the bob. TIMAYYYY unhurried three deep in the early going, moved forward in the middle stages, driven four wide into the lane, challenged in upper stretch, grabbed the lead outside the sixteenth pole but got outkicked by the top pair. HAZAKA (FR) tracked five deep leaving the chute, went three wide around the clubhouse turn, between rivals on the backstretch, traveled two then three wide on the far turn, challenged between foes with a furlong remaining, got bumped by TAIF in the final sixteenth and got outkicked. CONSTITUTION ANDI pursued keenly in hand along the inside, two wide between on the backstretch, went three deep into the far turn, spun five wide into the lane, chased between rivals at the top of the stretch and got outkicked in the late stages. GO RALPH traveled along the rail near the back early, traveled two then three wide around the clubhouse turn while pulling a bit, drew closer three then four deep in the middle stages, came six wide into the stretch, rallied eight deep and lacked the needed late punch. FAUSTO trailed on the inside, passed a rival into the far turn, remained inside to the stretch, shifted off the rail with a furlong remaining and produced a mild rally to pass rivals but failed to threaten for the major award. KHONSU tracked from inside, fell out of range into the backstretch, drew closer approaching the far turn, continued on the rail around the bend, tipped out into the lane and could not answer the call. PARKER'S CANDY away quickest from the gate, vied three deep leaving the chute, ceded the lead running through the stretch for the first time, stalked three deep around the clubhouse turn, bid three deep at the half-mile pole, fought head to head through the far turn, carried a short lead into the stretch, resisted into the final furlong, lost the lead midstretch and weakened in the last sixteenth. POSTMODERN showed early foot between rivals, pulled running through the stretch first time around, took a stalking position in the two path, challenged for the lead between rivals at the half-mile pole, took a narrow lead on the far turn, relinquished the lead to PARKER'S CANDY, fought back into the final furlong, then weakened in the late stages. SCORPY bumped a rival in the chute, pulled early in the two path approaching the first turn then was hard to handle around the bend while moving to the three path, raced outside a rival at the back into the far turn, trailed into the stretch and passed a tired rival. AMERICAN KING vied for the lead from inside leaving the chute, took control running through the stretch for the first time, cleared outer rival around the clubhouse turn, challenged by outer pair at the half-mile pole, lost command on the far turn but continued to fight back, finally yielded in upper stretch, faded in the furlong grounds, pulled up on the clubhouse turn and was transported off the track via equine ambulance.
