BRITISH ISLES prominent early between runners then got crowded by inner foe, angled to the inside approaching the first turn, had to check when running up on heels at the five-sixteenths pole, tipped out and spun three wide into the lane, put in a mild bid in upper stretch and failed to get by HEART HEADED for the place honors. AMERICAN GLORY (GB) taken to the inside racing near the back, raced in the two path on the far turn, moved out in the lane and summoned a mild rally to round out the superfecta. PROMISSIO raced in mid-pack along the rail through the early going, remained on the fence on the far turn, ran into traffic in upper stretch, ridden along when gaining a clear path past the eighth pole, had to pause in traffic at the sixteenth pole and kept on trying to the wire. SIENNOIS (IRE) tucked inside off the pace, raced between rivals on the backstretch, angled out and came four wide into the, moved out further in the drive

and lacked a rally. TAKE ME TO CHURCH (IRE) sped clear and steered over to the rail, set all the pace to the stretch, got brushed by the winner while losing command at the top of the lane and weakened in the final furlong. SINE QUA NON saved ground through both turns, angled out in upper stretch and failed to make an impact. GROGU raced in the two path well off the pace, gained three, four, then five wide on the far turn but flattened out in the lane. SKETCHY stalked in the two path, drew closer on the backstretch, chased in the two path then between rivals late on the far turn and faded in the final furlong.

DEVIL AMONG US showed keen early foot under pressure, cleared approaching the far turn, opened up around the bend, remained clear to midstretch, then got reeled in by the winner at the sixteenth pole and finished a clear second. EREBUS tracked out of range off the rail, took the turn two then three wide and gained the show honors. HONEYMOON SUITE raced up close from inside early, chased two wide into the stretch, moved out and weakened in the final furlong. ROGUE SON lacked early speed, asked three then two wide around the bend, steered out in the lane and was never a factor. LETSHAVEONEMORE fractious in the gate, dropped back off the pace in the early going, raced three deep at the half-mile pole, angled in on the turn and was never a factor. ALWAYS ON CAY pressed from outside up the backstretch, lost contact with the leader at the seven-sixteenths pole, started to weaken in the two path around the bend and tired down the lane. BONUS TORNADO chased off the inside, dropped back three wide on the turn and had little left for the stretch run.
