BENSTER was off a bit slow to begin, tucked inside at the back, eased over to the two path then found the rail again on the clubhouse turn, drew closer in the middle stages, continued on the inside through the far turn, steered out a bit into the lane, moved inside the leader in the final sixteenth and finished willingly to edge GORO for second. FOWLER BLUE broke cleanly but lacked early speed and dropped back on the inside despite being coaxed along, continued under hand urging at the back to the far turn, steered out and came five wide into the lane, rallied five deep across the track into deep stretch and nailed TIASHAN in the closing moments. TAISHAN broke in the air to spot the field a few lengths, raced outside a rival at the back early, went two wide into the far turn, ridden along while angling out to the four path around the bend, challenged four deep into the final sixteenth, put a head in front while drifting inward late and got nailed by the winner. IT'S MY HOUSE grabbed the lead and showed the way three then two wide early, moved to the inside on the backstretch and took pressure from LEYAS CANDY, maintained a short advantage through the far turn, resisted to the sixteenth pole and yielded grudgingly to the top pair. JOINT VENTURE away quickly then took a stalking position on the rail, coaxed along into the far turn, shifted over to the two path around that bend, rallied between rivals in the final furlong but got crowded by TAISHAN late and bumped with LEYAS CANDY late, halting all momentum. IGNATOWSKI chased four wide into the turn, moved into the three path then tipped back out approaching the stretch and bested the rest. NAUKANAUKA veered in and bumped at the start, dropped back off the pace then chased off the rail under coaxing, took the turn three then tow wide and was along for the show honors. ROYAL CURLIN hustled from the gate and was coaxed along while dropping off the pace, tipped two wide a quarter mile out, moved back inside in the lane and improved position. HE'SQUITE MISCHIEF got pinballed leaving the gate, ridden along trailing the field up the backstretch, trailed two then three wide to the stretch and passed tired rivals. SUPERMAX lagged behind early, angled five wide around the far turn, passed tired rivals but failed to threaten. DO IT FOR DAVE traveled five wide near the back into the first turn, angled in around the bend, drew closer while moving back out on the backstretch, rounded the far turn four, five, then six wide and weakened in the lane. POP D'ORO vied three deep then dueled outside around the clubhouse turn, inched ahead at he five-eighths pole, fought between rivals into the far turn, lost command with three furlongs remaining and had little left for the stretch run. RHINO vied inside a trio of rivals into the first turn, pressed up the backstretch before moving up on even terms again, fought with outer rival to the five-sixteenths pole, failed to keep up with a quarter mile left to run and tired in the lane.



BIG CITY LIGHTS stalked off the rail, had to pause momentarily when running up behind the leader early, angled to the inside, put in a rail bid at the three-eighths pole, put a head in front at the five-sixteenths marker, spurted away under hand urging with a quarter mile remaining, drew off under left handed urging in upper stretch and widened under a strong drive to the wire. MAN O ROSE stumbled a bit leaving the gate, went up to press the pace leaving the chute then fought on even terms from inside up the backstretch, inched ahead from CURLIN'S KAOS at the three-eighths pole but left rail open for BIG CITY LIGHTS to offer a bid at the same time, could meet the challenge from the winner and relinquished the lead at the five-sixteenths pole, chased two to three wide to the stretch and churned on to best the rest. MOOSE MITCHELL chased the speed three deep then outside BIG CITY LIGHTS, raced three to four wide on the turn, spun five wide into the lane and gained third. CURLIN'S KAOS broke well to clear the field from outside, took pressure from MAN O ROSE to the inside then dueled with that rival up the backstretch, lost command early on the turn while three deep, failed to keep up with the new leader midway around the bend and weakened down the lane. NONE ABOVE THE LAW raced in range while widest up the backstretch, entered the bend four wide, spun six wide off the turn and lacked a response when called upon.
