AUNT MO sped clear and led three then two wide early, controlled the pace two wide into the far turn, moved over to the rail then showed the way a bit off the rail into the stretch, drew off when asked a few times right handed, flagged with the crop into deep stretch and was in hand the final fifty yards. BOUJEE BEACH stalked three then two wide around the first turn, was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, came under a ride two to three wide on the second bend, could not make any headway on the winner but was clearly second best. WREN tracked four wide into the first turn, moved in a bit around the bend, remained wide through the far turn, could not produce a bid but managed to save third. MIA SORPRESA stumbled leaving the gate, stalked in hand along the fence, lost ground under asking on the far turn, churned on through the lane and missed third. ARANSAS PASS also stumbled at the start, settled inside, moved off the fence on the backstretch, rounded the far turn two then three wide, moved outside rivals in the lane and failed to make an impact.

DYNODAVE unhurried in the opening stages and tucked inside at the back, crept closer up the backstretch, trailed in the two path to the stretch, roused at the top of the lane, bid inside the top trio at the eighth pole, surged clear midstretch and drew away from HARDTOBEBETTERNOW while drifting out. HARDTOBEBETTERNOW off slow in the beginning, settled along the rail, chased two wide then three wide on the far turn, challenged four deep into the final furlong and got outkicked by the winner. UNCLE EVCO stalked the lone leader in the two path, came under a ride on the far turn, challenged between foes with a furlong left to run and flattened out in deep stretch. NAP sped clear and moved inside, set all the pace from the rail to the top of the lane, came off the fence and asked right handed in upper stretch, clung to a short advantage over rivals on both sides at the eighth pole, yielded shortly after and weakened in the final sixteenth. FALCON WINGS hit the rail while stalking along the inside early, asked while saving ground through the second bend but faded down the lane.

DISCREPANCY broke a step slow on the outside, sat off the pace, traveled two wide on the turn, split foes at the quarter pole, closed into the final furlong, drew latched onto the leader from inside approaching the sixteenth pole, dueled late and won the bob at the wire. UR IN TROUBLE broke out then went up to take control, set the pace under pressure from inner rival then between foes past the half-mile pole, held a short lead inside WOODBINE WAY around the turn, drifted out in upper stretch, held a short lead over rivals on both sides into deep stretch, dueled outside DISCREPANCY late and got outnoddod on the line. WOODBINE WAY broke out, stalked the leader early then challenged from outside on the backstretch, kept the pressure on through the turn, got floated out in upper stretch and could not summon the needed late kick in deep stretch. WHY BEHAVE broke a step slow, raced in range up the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, stayed within striking distance down the stretch but finished evenly late. GYPSY LYNN threw her head then dwelt at the start, had one rival beat three wide into the turn, moved out to the four path briefly then angled inward at the quarter pole, kept trying down the lane but failed to threaten in the late stages. DANCE KID threw her head then hopped in the beginning, trailed along the inside into the turn, saved ground to the stretch and failed to menace. SHE'S RESILIENT pressed the pace from inside, chased the top pair along the rail into the turn, drifted out to the four path around the bend and weakened in the lane. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE START OF BOTH DANCE KID AND GYPSY LYNN AND RULED THAT BOTH HORSES CAUSED THEIR OWN PROBLEMS AND ARE CONSIDERED STARTERS.

SOULFIRE broke a step slow on the outside, dropped back off the pace, traveled on the inside or two wide on the turn, offered a mild response in the drive and improved position. INSTINCT D' ORO vied inside a trio of rivals in the early going, dueled with HOT BOX around the turn, fought to midstretch and weakened. INCH got put in tight chasing between rivals early and had to

steady, round the bend two then three wide, angled out in the drive and lacked a rally. PUSHINESS took a bump from SAFA at the start, sped clear and crossed over, showed the way up the backstretch, challenged by BIG SUMMER at the five-sixteenths pole, fought on even terms with a quarter mile remaining, lost command in upper stretch, yielded to the new leader past the eighth pole and churned on to secure the show honors. ROBERTA'S LOVE was prominent early to the inside of PUSHINESS then stalked from outside once that rival crossed over at the five-eighths pole, followed closely to the turn, asked two wide around the bend but failed to respond and weakened down the lane. SAFA broke in and bumped PUSHINESS, chased out of range on the inside into the turn, raced a bit off the rail into the lane and lacked a rally. IRISH WAHINE dropped back early, trailed four wide into the turn, moved into the three path around the bend, tip back to the four path entering the lane and failed to make an impact. BACK ON TRACK settled off the pace, took the turn three wide and was never a factor.

ANDREADYTORUMBLE well placed in the early stages on the inside, stalked behind the speed through the far turn, moved out a bit in upper stretch to take aim at PHOENIX FLYING, drew alongside the runner-up past the sixteenth pole and drove by. PHOENIX FLYING dueled from inside in the chute, cleared outer rival to take control first time through the stretch, pressured again by SIR MAXIMUS on the backstretch, dueled around the far turn, put that rival away for good entering the lane, showed the way clear into deep stretch, then was confronted by ANDREADYTORUMBLE and succumbed to the pressure late. EMPIRE'S CLASSIC bothered by outer rival leaving the gate, raced off the rail then moved inside trailing the field, found traffic behind a pair of rivals at the quarter pole, swung out leaving the far turn, closed widest of all down the lane and gained third. KAWAZAKI (IRE) brushed leaving the gate, settled in the

two path, moved into range between rivals, stalked two wide into the far turn, lacked room when boxed in entering the stretch, moved to a clear path and finished well in the late stages but got outfinished for the show honors. RESEMBLANCE brushed with KAWAZAKI (IRE) at the start, settled between rivals towards the rear, had to steady off heels first time through the stretch, rounded the far turn two to three wide, tipped out into the lane, finished willingly between rivals in the furlong grounds but needed to find more late. SIR MAXIMUS showed early speed dueling from outside in the chute, took a stalking position first time in the stretch, went up to force the issue leaving the clubhouse turn and dueled up the backstretch, fought two wide around the far turn, could not keep up with inner rival entering the lane and weakened. CROWN COUNCIL pulled three deep first time in the stretch, roused four wide on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch run. STORMIN MIDNIGHT broke in a bit to bother EMPIRE'S CLASSIC, stalked in the three path, coaxed along on the far turn still three wide, drifted out a bit to bother QUALITY WINS midstretch and was not persevered with late. QUALITY WINS coaxed from the gate then settled inside, pulled inside a pair of rivals first time in the stretch then early on the clubhouse turn, remained on the fence around the second bend, moved out in upper stretch, bothered by STORMIN MIDNIGHT and checked midstretch, resumed urging briefly but got boxed in near the sixteenth pole and lacked room to the wire.
