ACTIVATED (IRE) broke a step slow, settled outside a rival at the back, moved inside on the turn, tipped out in the lane, surged late three deep and got up near the wire. LONG MAYSHE REIGN took control quickly, pressured briefly at the seven-sixteenths pole before clearing into the turn, showed the way along the inside then a bit off the rail into the lane, crossed in front of AVOIR past the eighth pole, led clear into the final sixteenth but got nailed in the closing moments. AVOIR stalked from inside, took aim at the leader in upper stretch, had to alter out from behind LONG MAYSHE REIGN past the eighth pole, finished gamely between but was not enough. GEM MINE stalked the pace between rivals, steadied behind JAI HO at the five-sixteenths pole, remained boxed in to the stretch, then kept trying while finishing evenly through the final furlong. JAI HO pressed briefly at the seven-sixteenths pole from outside, chased three then two wide around the bend and weakened in the lane. SMOOTH AS BUTTER sat off the pace on the inside, trailed through the turn and proved no menace. TOULOUSE DETRAC stalked the speed three deep, rounded the bend four then three wide and faded down the lane. THE TRAINER OF AVOIR LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST LONG MAYSHE REIGN FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THAT ALTHOUGH LONG MAYSHE REIGN CROSSED IN FRONT OF AVOIR, LONG MAYSHE REIGN WAS CLEAR OF THAT RIVAL AND THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

SPLENDORA made slight contact with DON'T BRING CRAZY leaving the gate, went up to set the pace inside DON'T JU FORGET and UFFDA up the backstretch, cleared at the five-sixteenths pole, drew away under hand urging to the lane, flagged with the crop at the eighth pole, continued under steady handling into the final sixteenth and coasted the final fifty yards. RANK stalked two wide, pressed three deep at the half-mile pole, vied three deep into the far turn, dueled from outside around the bend, took over at the quarter pole, cleared in upper stretch, run down by the winner midstretch and stayed on for a clear second. BROTHER TONY unhurried from inside the shifted over to the two path, moved further out on the backstretch, went our wide into the far turn, angled into the two path then steered back out while gaining through the far turn, spun five wide into the lane and summoned a mild rally for third. MELLENCAMP forwardly placed along the inside, checked behind the leader on the first turn, made an early move past the five-eighths pole, vied inside a pair of rivals into the second bend holding slim lead, dueled around the far turn, relinquished the lead at the quarter pole, fought to upper stretch and weakened in the furlong grounds. CURVINO coaxed from the gate, raced on the inside at the back, passed a rival at the three-eighths pole, ran into traffic at the five-sixteenths marker, tipped three wide into the clear, altered out from behind a rival in upper stretch and kept on to improve. DAY AND AGE sat off the pace two wide then moved inside, ridden along in the two path on the far turn and failed to threaten. GRINNELL hopped at bit to lose a step at the start, tracked early outside a rival, angled out to the four path around the far turn and came up empty in the lane. SPUN NOT STIRRED settled three then two wide early, raced well off the pace in the middle stages, trailed with three furlongs

remaining and was done early. ZABO chased four then three wide early, stayed off the rail and came five wide into the lane and tired in the stretch run. TOPPERS AT SEASIDE sped to the front and moved into the two path, pressure from inside early on the backstretch, headed at the half-mile pole, vied between rivals into the far turn, gave way around the bend and was not persevered with late.

MADAKET ROAD raced in range from outside in the early going, advanced four then three wide on the turn, was closest in pursuit of the leader leaving the bend, moved inward in upper stretch, finished willingly in the final furlong but was no match for the winner. RASHMI took control and moved inside, showed the way under pressure around the first turn, headed at the midway point, inched ahead leaving the backstretch, disposed of outer rival early on the far turn, set down in upper stretch and drew away under right handed urging. ANNIE'S JOY stalked along the inside, tipped out at the quarter pole and took aim two wide entering the lane, chase determinedly through the drive but was no match for the winner. KATERINI broke inward and was quickly corrected, stalked between rivals or in the two path, chased out of range on the backstretch and moved inside, cut

the corner into the stretch, could not find the needed late punch in the furlong but kept on to hold third. CAMERON SLOUGH laid off the pace on the inside, angled four wide around the far turn, kept on through the lane but could not get by KATERINI for third. KETONIA (FR) bumped with outer rival at the start, reserved four then five deep on the first turn, moved into the two path on the backstretch, chased three deep at the five-sixteenths pole, asked left handed entering the lane and weakened. PRINCESS MIDNIGHT off slow and lost her path at the start, stalked three then four wide on the clubhouse turn, made an early move to challenge at the halfway point, kept the pressure on the winner to the far turn, lost touch quickly on the bend, chased two wide to the stretch and faded. SOLID TUNE tossed her head at the start but did not lose much ground, tucked inside at the back, passed a pair of rivals on the far turn while continuing to save ground, tipped out in upper stretch and failed to be a factor. SUPER ENTICING traveled two wide near the back, chased three deep on the far turn then two wide leaving that bend, moved out in upper stretch and never got involved. SEPTEMBER MAGIC pressed the pace from outside, stalked past the half-mile pole, weakened on the far turn and tired down the lane. RUN FOR MY HONEY bumped with inner rival in the beginning, forwardly placed three deep, lost ground leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn, trailed into the stretch and was eased to the wire.
