STAY FOR THE BOOM tracked in the four path, bid outside of the top pair at the quarter pole, leaned in and brushed a counterpart at the furlong grounds, dueled with a game COMPRESSED through the final sixteenth and edged past. COMPRESSED showed the way two wide early on, led inside of an outer prompter while remaining in the two path around the turn, clung to an advantage as a wider STAY FOR THE BOOM ranged up nearing the lane, maintained a margin into the final furlong, gamely battled with his aforementioned challenger through the late stages but was bested. DR FENN stalked in the three path, crept closer to press outside of the leader around the turn, bid turning for home, vied between horses as an outer foe challenged at the quarter pole, but was brushed by that one while failing to maintain even terms in midstretch and yielded. BAGG O TIME was off slow, lacked speed in the two path, swung out to the five path into upper stretch and improved position to reach fourth at the wire. RED SPEEDO bobbed at the start, raced forwardly in the three to two path and between horses into the turn, chased while yielding position around the bid, sustained pursuit to edge fourth leaving the sixteenth pole but was caught by an outer foe at the wire. ALL HONORS laid close up inside of the leader early on, stalked into the turn, chased turning for home and faded. MONTALBANO was off slow, lagged behind along the inside and made little impact. ABDICATE saved ground off of the pace and tired.

COLORMECAIRO pursued from midpack in the three path, closed in on the main group turning for home, swung out to the five to six path into the lane, sustained gradual progress to bid outside of the new leader at the sixteenth pole and edged past. BROOKLYNN DREW leaned outwardly leaving the gate, tracked in the three path, bid outside of the top pair at the quarter pole, vied while being floated to the four path in upper stretch, forged an advantage at the furlong grounds, dug in to resist an outer challenge shortly after but got bested. MOMBAYLA lacked speed in the three path, shifted out to the five path while progressing in midstretch and rallied willingly to reach show at the wire. HELEN'S LITTLE SIS tracked along the inside, encountered traffic behind the top pair leaving the three furlong pole, remained in hand while continuing to await racing room behind foes entering the lane, took aim inside of the top pair at the furlong grounds, but flopped back to her left lead leaving that marker and only manage to pursue evenly through the final sixteenth before losing show at the wire. READYTORISKITALL prompted two wide, vied around the turn, led as an outer foe issued a challenge turning for home, shifted out to the three path while sparring in upper stretch, but got headed at the furlong grounds and faded between horses. SPOTAWAY set the pace inside of a prompting rival, vied with that one around the turn, got headed as an outer foe ranged up turning for home, yielded in upper stretch before steadying when put in tight rail quarters by an outer foe at the furlong grounds and weakened. SWEET STAR laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted out to the four path into the lane and failed to factor. I'M A COOKIE LOVER trailed in the two path, floated to the five path into the lane and got outrun.

CLOCKER SPECIAL stalked three wide, bid outside of the top pair at the five sixteenths pole, gained an advantage entering the lane, inched clear in the final furlong and held sway from an outer pursuer. LA NORME DE JOUR bumped an outer rival at the start, tracked two wide and between horses, shifted out four wide entering the lane, rallied to take aim outside of the leader leaving the sixteenth pole but was kept at bay. THE STANDARD prompted two wide, vied around the turn, led briefly as an outer rival offered a bid turning for home, but got headed by that one entering the lane and yielded. LAND OF THE FREE broke inwardly, set the pace inside of a prompting rival, vied with that one into the turn, got headed as wider rival offered a bid turning for home, faded through the lane yet lasted for fourth. FREE CHOICE tracked along the inside, chased turning for home, moved off of the rail nearing the final furlong and lacked progress before failing to reel in a tiring foe for fourth. FEDERAL AGENT broke slowly but avoided crowded quarters between horses by doing so, raced off of the pace three wide and between horses, brushed with an inner rival reaching the nine sixteenths pole and failed to factor. ROGUISSHNESS broke a step slow, got bumped by an inner rival, pinched between horses and steadied back at the start, raced well back two wide and between horses, bumped with foes on both sides at the nine sixteenths pole, saved ground around the bend and failed to menace. WICKED GUN leaned outwardly leaving the gate, lacked speed in the four to five path and made little impact. RIP CORD broke inwardly, raced near the rear along the inside, bumped with an outer foe at the nine sixteenths pole, trailed in the three path around the turn and got outrun.

ST. ALBANS RAID was bumped by an outer rival leaving the gate, tracked the leaders from the two path, gained between horses in the three path nearing the quarter pole, offered a bold challenge outside of the leader leaving that station, assumed command entering the lane and drew off handily. MISS MAKENNA vied for the lead with an outer rival, sustained pressure while headed around the turn, yielded as an outer foe issued a challenge at the quarter pole, shifted out while sustaining stride entering the lane, ran on to reclaim place nearing the furlong grounds and held that position. DARING HOPE bumped with an inner foe leaving the gate, raced off of the pace in the two path and between horses into the turn, advanced turning for home, spun into the lane in the four path and ran on willingly. DINAHS GIRL raced off of the pace in the four path, tucked to the two path into the lane and failed to menace. ECHO VISION bumped an inner foe at the start, vied two wide, led around the turn, but offered little resistance to an outer challenger entering the lane and faded. SUMMER ADI pressed three wide, but weakened once floated to the four path at the quarter pole. MILVEN bumped with an outer rival at the start, trailed along the inside, spun into the lane in the four path and made little impact.
