FAVORITE OUTLAW was bumped at the start, set the pace early, raced in the four path into the lane, was overtaken nearing the eighth pole and held place at the wire. GO WEST trailed the field early on, raced in the six path into the lane, rallied down the lane and just missed place at the wire. PRETTY FAST stalked the pace early three wide, was in the five path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. KNICKS STORY bobbed and was bumped at the start, pressed the pace early from the inside, raced in the two path into the lane and faded down the lane.

DEFENDING ALBERT vied three to two wide approaching the turn, led turning for home, met an outer pair challenges at the quarter pole, yet repelled those bidders entering upper stretch and inched clear. ZECA DIABO bumped with an inner rival and was subtly put to crowded quarters between horses at the start, laid off of the pace in the three path, launched progress between rivals leaving the three furlong pole, loomed a danger ranging up to bid four wide at the quarter pole, but was turned away by the eventual winner in upper stretch and was second best. THREE ECHOES broke a beat slow, stalked along the inside, tipped to take aim outside of the top pair as an outer rival bid alongside at the quarter pole, but got outkicked entering the lane and chased the top pair home. AIR CAV bobbed leaving the gate, bumped with an outer rival and dropped out of tight quarters between horses at the start, settled well back in the four path, advanced between horses entering the lane and moved up. DEVILISH DESIRE chased from midpack along the inside, shifted out to the two to three path at the three furlong pole and failed to menace. SOUTHERN PASS TIME pursued from midpack two wide, then along the inside turning for home and failed to factor. HIGH PROBABILITY vied for the lead inside of a pair early on, then only inside of the eventual winner into and around the turn,

but gave way at the quarter pole and weakened. ENOUGH ALREADY bumped the outer stall door and broke slow, trailed in the five path and made little impact. WAR DEPT CALLING prompted between the top pair through the opening stages, but yielded into the turn, chased from the four to five path shortly after but weakened at the five sixteenths pole.

INNATELY GOOD broke a step slow, lacked speed along the inside, took the far turn in the three path before swinging out to the six path into the lane, rallied widest while changing leads at the furlong grounds, ranged up to bid outside of the new leader in the closing stages and got up at the wire. SHOW OF FORCE pursued from midpack three wide, progressed between horses turning for home, took aim four wide in upper stretch, bid at the furlong grounds, edged an advantage in the final sixteenth as an outer bidder issued a challenge and got nailed at the wire. SING SING stalked two wide, closed in three wide to bid nearing the lane, gained an advantage in upper stretch, resisted an outer challenge passing the furlong grounds, but was bested by that bidder in the final sixteenth and faded yet lasted for show. OH PLEASE had his head turned inwardly when the gates sprung and broke slow, pulled inside of rivals into the first turn before settling well back, took the far turn in the three path, pursued in the four to five path and between horses into the final furlong and

ran on to miss show. JOEJOE GO pursued from midpack along the inside, was held up behind rivals around the far turn, shifted to two to three path in upper stretch, but encountered traffic passing the furlong grounds, tipped out into the final sixteenth and ran on between horses. NUDGE pursued from midpack two wide and between horses, then along the inside around the far turn, shifted three wide into the lane, took aim behind the leader while three wide and between horses into the final furlong, but bumped with an inner foe at the sixteenth pole and lacked a bid. THE HIDDEN CHAMBER bobbled at the start and was slow to recover, trailed along the inside, saved ground, shifted out through the final furlong and moved up. STIGLETS tracked along the inside, surpassed a stopping inner rival before taking aim inside of the new leaders entering upper stretch, but lacked a rail kick, bumped with an outer rival at the sixteenth pole and lacked a bid. MOON SNIPER stalked the run-away leader from the inside into the backstretch, closed in along with an outer rival to bid at the quarter pole, but got outkicked and weakened before being pinched between horses at the sixteenth pole. MY OWN tracked three to four wide, but weakened in the five path and between horses in upper stretch. TREW VIOLENCE lacked speed in the three path and was done early. STONEHENGE sped clear in the three path, ran off to open up a wide advantage down the backstretch, but tired around the far turn, got overhauled at the quarter pole and wilted.

SCATTITUDE brushed with an inner rival into the first turn, settled off of the pace two wide, then four wide around the far turn, ranged up to bid five to four wide along with an inner rival entering the lane, but got outkicked by that one at the furlong grounds and kept on well. AUNT MO pressed three to two wide around the first turn, bid at the quarter pole, but got outkicked by an outer pair at the furlong grounds and kept on. WEDDING MOOD (IRE) broke slowly, trailed in the the three path, swung out to the six path into the lane and rallied willingly. BEMBRIDGE LEDGE stalked along the inside, awaited racing room around the far turn, chased in the two to three path in upper stretch and lacked a bid. ATLANTIC PASSAGE showed the way along the inside, but got headed by an outer trio of rivals coming to the furlong pole and weakened. TIGER DIVISION broke a step slow, got brushed by an outer rival into the first turn, settled well back along the inside and made little impact. LADY OF SILENCE tracked two to three wide, but got outkicked between rivals and faltered entering the lane.
