Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

RIVETAGE pursued from midpack in the two path, moved out to the four path with eleven sixteenths to go, chased around the far turn, tipped out to bid in the five to six path entering the lane, gained an advantage at the furlong grounds and inched clear. ODORICO brushed with an inner foe leaving the gate, stalked from the three path, bid along with an outer rival turning for home, led nearing the lane, but got outkicked by an outer bidder at the furlong grounds and held place. SHORTSTOP brushed with an outer foe at the start, tracked from the four path, bid turning for home, vied with an inner rival into the lane, but got outkicked by an outer bidder in midstretch and was denied place. ANDY'S CANDY broke inwardly and was off slow, raced off of the pace near the inside, then two wide at the five furlong pole, chased in the three path and between horses nearing the lane then lacked a bid. BAOBAB leaned outwardly while breaking slow, raced at the rear in the four path and moved up. PURSE THIEF tracked along the inside, paused while encountering traffic nearing the lane and gave way. REWIRE set a clear pace in the two path, got headed by an outer pair at the five sixteenths pole and weakened between horses. CHARBON lacked speed while tucking to the inside into the backstretch, then made little impact.
