JUST ASAP took light contact from an inner foe leaving the gate, dictated terms while showing the way along the inside, remained in hand as a trio of outer rivals pressed at the five sixteenths pole, drew off when let out reaching the lane and was kept to task through the final furlong. AVERY PLACE trailed while moving out to the four to five path around the turn, then rallied belatedly outside of rivals in the final furlong to reach place latee. HONEY DUTCH fidgeted about before hopping when the gates sprung and stopping the field multiple lengths at the start, shifted out early on, tracked four deep into the turn, ranged up to bid offer a wide challenge at the five sixteenths pole, but was turned away by the leader reaching the lane, weakened yet saved show at the wire. PROPS leaned outwardly and brushed a foe at the start, pressed two wide and between horses, required urging to sustain position around the bend, but proved no match for the leader leaving the quarter pole, lugged out from a left handed crop entering the lane, yielded thereafter, got outkicked late and missed reclaiming show. CHUCK'S LAW bobbled at the start, raced off of the pace in the two path, retreated to trail at the quarter pole then surpassed tiring rivals. EL CHAVO tracked along the inside, chased turning for home then weakened while hanging on his left lead. SPARKLING SPEED stalked three wide, pressed between horses around the bend but faded at the quarter pole and weakened.

AIR OF DEFIANCE pressed two wide, bid along with an outer counterpart turning for home, wrestled a narrow advantage at the quarter pole then held sway from his aforementioned foe through the final furlong. KING PEANUT stalked outside of the top pair, bid three deep at the five sixteenths pole, vied into the lane but was fended off by an inner counterpart through the final furlong. INTERLOCK EMPIRE showed the way as the eventual winner pressed down the backstretch, got headed by that one and a wider bidder reaching the quarter pole, fought on through upper stretch, but faded through the final furlong yet lasted for show. SOUND OF VICTORY raced at the rea in the four to three path into the turn, shifted back out to the four path while improving into the lane and claimed fourth late. OUR DREAM RYE'D laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted to the three path around the far turn, edged fourth from an inner foe entering the lane but was caught by his outer stablemate in the late stages. CASCADE CRUISER tracked near the inside, chased in the two path around the far turn and tired. GIFT CERTIFICATE raced off of the pace four wide, came under urging in the five path around the far turn, but lacked a response and weakened before being eased through the lane. INFINITE LUCK was briefly antsy in the starting gate, raced near the rear two wide and between horses, weakened turning for home, was pulled up leaving the furlong grounds and walked off.

INDY CHARGES ON led from a pair of outer pressers into the backstretch, vied with a single foe approaching the far turn, edged an advantage once more around the far turn before meeting a challenge from a wider bidder at the quarter pole, dug in and battled neck and neck with that one through the final furlong then narrowly prevailed. GUARDIAN pressed three deep, backed off to stalk approaching the nine sixteenths pole, ranged up to bid nearing the lane, vied while moving out into upper stretch, sparred while failing to edge an advantage in the final furlong, hung and missed at the wire. BRAVE BLEND laid off of the pace in the four path, inched closer spinning into the lane in the five path, gained show at the furlong grounds, but was no match for the top pair and proved best of the rest. OLIVERIO broke slowly, pulled forward inside of rivals before prompting between the top pair into the backstretch, vied with an inner rival approaching the far turn, but gave way at the five sixteenths pole and weakened. PIERCE ELEVATED pursued two wide and between horses but was done early. GREATDAYFORHOCKEY tracked along the inside and weakened. GOOD POINT lagged behind down the backstretch and got outrun.

MEGA MIL sparred for the lead with an inner rival while remaining multiple paths outside of that one, led in the three path around the turn, built a clear advantage while well in hand at the quarter pole, met a mild outer challenge in upper stretch, held sway from that one before shifting across her path in the final furlong and widened late. FOIE GRAS leaned inwardly and jostled an inner foe at the start, stalked in the three path, took aim outside of the leader and from the four path entering the lane, but was turned away in the final furlong and proved second best. MOON OVER CHOCTAW was bumped and forced outwardly by an inner pair of rivals at the start, pursued from midpack in the three to four path, swung out to the six path into the lane and ran on to reach show at the wire. VELVET DEVIL broke outwardly and firmly bumped a rival at the start, tracked along the inside, advanced in the three path and between horses into the lane, claimed show in upper stretch, but only managed to chase thereafter and got nailed at the wire. ABITIBI was jostled between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the two path, swung out to the seven path into the lane and moved up before leveling off.
