THEATRIX set the pace early from the inside, raced in the two path into the lane, drew clear down the lane and held off rival in the final stages. TEMPTING EVE pressed the pace early on two wide, was in the three path into the lane, made a late bid down the lane but did not have enough in the final stages. TEXAS QUEEN lost action along the turn from the rail and steadied, raced in the two path into the lane, rallied down the lane and prevailed for show at the

wire. BOIS BLANC chased the pace early on, raced in the three path entering the lane, was slightly blocked from between horses near the three sixteenths pole, rallied down the lane and missed show in the late stages. SENORA D'ORO was steadied along the turn, raced in the five path into the lane, rallied down the lane and miss show in the final stages. BEE CAT tracked the pace early on, raced in the three path into the lane and leveled off late in the stretch run. SEVENON tracked the pace early on, was in the four path into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch drive. ENTICING BEAUTY trailed the field early on and rallied down the stretch with a belated gain. WELLA raced in the four path into the lane with some late gain in the stretch run. STORMY PARADISE chased the pace early on, raced in the five path into the lane and evened out late. TICKIN TIME BLONDE was never a threat. VOLATILE NITE broke slowly and was done early.
