PROMISSIONE tracked four wide, gained three deep around the far turn to bid outside of the leader at the quarter pole, led into the lane and drove clear. STRATEGIST tugged forward two wide and between horses to reach the front entering the backstretch, led as an outer rival applied pressure leaving the five furlong pole, disposed of that one as a wider rival challenged at teh quarter pole, but offered little resistance that one nearing the lane and proved second best. GROUND SHAKER brushed with an inner foe at the start, tracked while tucking to the two path into the backstretch, chased along the inside around the far turn, moved out to the four path turning for home and stayed on to hold show from an outer foe. FALCON QUEST pursued from midpack five to four wide, chased while getting floated to the five path turning for home and stayed on. CLOCKING led along the inside early on before ceding the front to an outer puller entering the backstretch, switched outside before moving to press passing the five furlong pole, sustained pressure around the far turn, but yielded as an outer rival bid at the quarter pole and caved through the lane. MR. CHUCK brushed with an outer foe at the start, raced off of the pace along the inside and tired. OLD TRACE broke a step slow, trailed in the three path into the backstretch, advanced between horses at the five furlong pole, but flattened out without reaching contention turning for home and tired. BEECHMONT was fractious in the starting gate necessitating reloading, stalked three deep, but gave way at the seven sixteenths pole and weakened between horses around the far turn. KEVIN'S STRIKE brushed with rivals on both sides at the start, lacked speed in the four path, retreated to trail at the five furlong pole and was outrun thereafter.

COLLECTING brushed an outer rival at the start, tracked two wide, rallied to bid inside of the leader at the sixteenth pole and edged past. MO BEACH TIME showed the way along the inside, dueled with an outer presser around the far turn, shook free after moving to the three path in upper stretch, dug in to resist an inner challenge at the sixteenth pole but got bested late. AMERICAN BEAR stalked close up along the inside, moved off of the rail turning for home, took aim from the four to five path in upper stretch, but lacked progress and flattened out. GRAY IS OKAY was brushed by an inner rival and steadied back from between horses at the start, laid off of the pace in the two path, but came under strong restraint and steadied entering the backstretch, advanced three wide around the far turn, but failed to reach contention. TINGUS PINGUS broke slowly and was floated in by an outer rival at the start, raced at the rear along the inside and made little impact. GRIND leaned inwardly while off slow, lacked speed in the three path and got outrun. CONSEQUENTIAL pursued from midpack two wide, got outmoved by an outer rival around the far turn and weakened.

AHAMO tracked five deep, bid at the three furlong pole, drew clear leaving the five sixteenths marker, held sway under a drive into midstretch but was caught by an outer on-charging bidder at the sixteenth pole then held place. HARD TO GET prompted two wide and between horses, vied among foes reaching the three furlong pole, but brushed with an outer rival while failing to keep pace with a wider counterpart passing the five sixteenths pole, moved out to the four path while running on into upper stretch, but got outkicked for place at the furlong grounds then was denied re-gaining that position late. OPERATION SUNRISE led narrowly inside of a trio of rivals early on, then inside of only a single rival around the turn, drew off passing the quarter pole, widened under light hand urging into the final furlong, but lugged inwardly while shying from a right handed crop in the final sixteenth, had the rider take a quick hold to avoid brushing the inner rail yet still won as much the best. GOOD MOJO bumped with an outer rival leaving the gate, prompted two wide and between horse early on, then only outside of the eventual winner around the turn, proved no match for that one leaving the quarter pole and held place. POST GAME bumped with an inner rival at the start, pressed three wide and between horses, failed to sustain pressure and chased two wide and between rivals at the three furlong pole, exchanged bumps with those foes at the quarter pole, yet ran on to duel for show with his inner counterpart through the lane and narrowly prevailed between horses at the wire. KY DO DECLARE broke slowly, tracked while tucking to the inside into the turn, moved inside of rivals around the bend, exchanged bumps with an outer foe at the quarter pole, ran on to duel for show with that one through the final furlong but missed. NASH POTATOES laid off of the pace along the inside, shifted four wide into the lane and offered a mild kick to miss show. EMPIRE RANCH raced off of the pace in the four to three path and failed to factor. DISCERNING SPIRIT broke slowly and shied from an inner rival at the start, trailed along the inside, swung out five wide into the lane, floated wider into midstretch and failed to factor. MR ENTERTAINER leaned outwardly leaving the gate, stalked four to three wide, traded bumps with an inner foe at the quarter pole and weakened between horses.

DUKE OF DUVAL tracked from midpack three to two wide and between horses, pursued from the three path around the far turn, paused briefly behind the leaders upon reaching the lane, brushed an outer foe while tipping out to the four path to take aim from between horses at the furlong grounds, gradually progressed to bid outside of the leader at the sixteenth pole and edged past. SIPPIN ON GIN prompted outside of the leader and from the three path, vied between horses around teh far turn, led narrowly into the lane, but met an outer challenge in the final furlong and got bested late. RUN QUIET RUN FAST brushed with an inner rival at the start, dropped back and trailed early on, progressed in the three path around the far turn, swung out to the five to six path turning for home, got floated out to the nine path at the furlong grounds, yet sustained his rally outside of foes to reach show late. BERMUDA BLITZ brushed with an outer rival at the start, pursued from midpack along the inside before coming under a hard hold while moving between rivals entering the backstretch, settled back off of the pace near the inside leaving the five furlong pole, drifted out to the eight path while carrying outer rivals in upper stretch, rallied between horses to offer a late bid for show but missed that position. SOLID LEFT tracked four to three wide, prompted outside of the top pair from the four path around the far turn, bid turning for home, but was turned away in upper stretch, brushed to the five path while yielding into the final furlong and gave way between horses. LAUGHNOWCRYLATER was bumped by an inner rival leaving the gate, set the pace near the inside as an outer rival prompted, vied with that one and a wider prompter around the far turn, got headed entering the lane, fought on through midstretch but faded in the final furlong. TIGER MOON laid off of the pace hung five wide, tugged closer outside of rivals with five furlongs to go, tracked around the far turn, chased while moving to the four path turning for home, but got floated out to the seven path while between horses in upper stretch and lacked a rally. SWEET KAUFY broke a bit slow before rushing between horses shortly after, prompted outside of the leader before vying in the three path around the turn, sustained her bid while moving out to the four path in upper stretch and edged past in the final sixteenth. PARTY PAULINE set the pace inside of the eventual winner while remaining a path off of the inner rail, vied with that one around the turn, clung to an advantage in the two to three path leaving the furlong grounds but was bested late. ROSATO broke a beat slow before checking back when an outer rival put her to tight quarters early on, laid off of teh pace two wide, picked up stride shifting out to the six path into the lane and rallied to reach show late. SHE'Z THE LAW stalked along the inside, chased into the lane, lacked a bid and lost show late. CAVATELLI shifted in early on, raced well back along the inside into the turn, shifted out to the five path and between horses reaching the furlong grounds and ran on willingly. TEMPERS FLY raced off of the pace moving to the inside into the turn and failed to menace. ROYALEWITHCHEESE tracked two wide and between horses, then gave way, RIGHTINTHATWRONG broke a half step slow, checked slightly as an outer rival shifted into her path earl on, trailed in the four path, fanned out to the seven path into the lane and made little impact.
