BEST FRIEND stalked two wide and between horses, shifted outside of foes and to the four path turning for home then rallied to bid outside of the leader in the final sixteenth and drove past. KENZ set a pressured pace while remaining a path off of the inside, met an outer challenge turning for home, was set down entering the lane, inched free passing the furlong grounds but was bested by a an outer bidder late. LATE NIGHT TEXT tracked from the four path, ranged up to bid outside of top pair turning for home, moved down to the three path while vying with only the leader leaving the quarter pole, but was turned away at the furlong grounds, got outkicked for place shortly after and was best of the rest. TACTICAL COMMAND pressed the leader from the three path but faded between horses at the quarter pole. BACKGAMMON stalked along the inside, chased into the lane and tired. SHOT AT PERFECTION broke a step slow, raced off of the pace in the five path and failed to factor. FLOWER STONE broke slowly, raced off of the pace in the three path and got outrun. BLACKWING trailed along the inside and showed little.

MISTER MMMMM led two wide early on, drew clear into the turn and held sway under a drive. DARK VINTAGE (IRE) pursued from midpack in the five path, tucked behind the main group and to the inside at the five sixteenths pole, awaited racing room while encountering traffic entering the lane, slipped through to offer a rail rally entering the final furlong and was second best. BUSHIDO prompted inside of the eventual winner early on, failed to sustain pressure and chased around the turn, pursued in the two path into the final furlong, got outkicked for place by an inner rival at the sixteenth pole and held show. PRINCETOWN laid off of the pace in the two path, shifted out to the five path in upper stretch, moved up and missed show. BAD BEAT BRIAN tracked in the four to three path, chased floating back to the four path in upper stretch, but lacked a bid and missed show between horses. SUNCROFT moved off of the inside to stalk from the three path into the turn, pursued the clearing leader from the three to two path around the bend, chased three wide and between horses into the final furlong but gave way. MIDNIGHT PRANKS trailed along the inside, swung out to the six path in upper stretch and got outrun.

ZEUS'S ECHO showed the way along the inside, felt pressure from an outer bidder around the turn, shook free of that one in upper stretch and was driven home. SHE'S ON A ROLL brushed an inner rival leaving the gate, stalked outside of the leader and eventual winner, moved to press that one from the three path into the turn, but was turned away in upper stretch and proved second best. SOULMAN tracked from midpack along the inside, saved ground, ran on to bid for show at the furlong grounds, dueled with an outer rival for that position and prevailed. JIRAH jostled with an outer rival then an inner foe and steadied back at the start, trailed along the inside, swung out to the six path into upper stretch and moved up to reach fourth at the wire. MR. VAGGIO pursued from midpack three to two wide and between horses, tipped outwardly while staying on into the final sixteenth, but lacked progress and missed fourth between rivals while dead-heating for fifth. SEEN YOU LATER took simultaneous contact from rivals on both sides at the start, stalked along the inside, chased while moving out to the four path in upper stretch, lacked progress before dueling with an inner bidder for show leaving the furlong grounds, but was bested by that one, missed fourth to an outer pair at the wire and shared fifth. PRINCE OF LIGHT leaned outwardly and bumped with an outer rival at the start, pursued from midpack in the four to five path into the lane and yielded. WOLFCAMP broke a step slow, lacked speed two wide and failed to factor. TIMS

was brushed by an outer foe and bumped an inner rival at the start, tracked from the three path then weakened between horses. FREE CHOICE saved ground off of the pace but to no avail.

STURGEON MOON tracked along the inside, shifted out four wide at the quarter pole, rallied to reel in the leader at the sixteenth pole and drew clear. PRINCESS PROUD pressed two wide and between horses, bid to vie between rivals into the far turn, led at the quarter pole, kicked clear in upper stretch, but was caught by an outer bidder at the sixteenth pole, tired yet lasted for place. TRUSTY TROUTMAN broke a step slow before clipping a rival's hind heels soon after the start, trailed in the aftermath, launched progress in the three path turning for home, rallied between horses into the final sixteenth and missed reaching place. VIRAL PLANE LADY had her hind heel clipped after crossing over an inner rival's path at the start, set the pace along the inside, vied with a pair of outer bidders into the turn, got headed nearing the five sixteenths pole, steadied back at the quarter pole, yet recovered to keep on in upper stretch, rebid for show in the final furlong but got outkicked. HOLLYGROVE stalked four to three wide, bid into the far turn, vied turning for home, but gave way in upper stretch and faded between horses. RUN CAMILA RUN chased three wide, floated five wide at the quarter pole and tired. RUBY'S GHOST raced off of the pace in the two path and got outrun. THE RIDER OF VIRAL PLACE LADY CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST PRINCESS PROUD ALLEGING INTERFERENCE AT THE QUARTER POLE, BUT THE OBJECTION WAS DISALLOWED BY THE STEWARDS.
