COMPORT pressed the leader from the three path, vied reaching the three furlong pole, led passing the five sixteenths marker and drove clear of his stubborn inner rival. SPICE RUNNER set the pace in the two path as the eventual winner applied outer pressure into the turn, got headed by that one with five sixteenths to go, yet kept on well through the final furlong but was second best. PAPA KEN tracked along the inside, but proved no match for the top pair and held show. SHAKE AND RATTLE bobbled sharply at the start, trailed the short field along the inside, moved out of last two wide into the turn but failed to menace thereafter. LONGSTRIDER chased two wide, faded three wide into the turn and was done early.
