CHASIN A DOLLAR was reserved off the pace while saving ground and finished in a mild rally. DORADUS was unhurried early, came two-wide into the stretch and rallied late. R D STIMULUS broke out to bump DADDY’S QUEST then was forwardly placed while racing two-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and weakened. PRANCIN LADY broke out to bump SWIFT CARO, then prompted MISTY MALIBU from along the outside, took the lead nearing the quarter pole, responded during the drive and held on gamely when headed late. MISTY MALIBU saved ground setting the pace under pressure from PRANCIN LADY and held on fairly well for third when headed. I'LLTAKEITFROMHERE was forwardly placed while racing three-wide but lacked a rally. VALID GOLD was unhurried early, came five-wide into the stretch and failed to seriously threaten. DANZING ZELLA was off a step slow then dropped back and failed to menace.

CLUB MESQUITE saved ground vying for the lead by THIRTY FOUR COUPE, drifted out slightly nearing the three-sixteenths pole, respond during the drive and held on gamely to the wire. SUPERMAZEL was unhurried early, came five-wide into the stretch and failed to be a factor. THIRTY FOUR COUPE vied for the lead with CLUB MESQUITE to the stretch and tired.
