SIR LUCAS was unhurried early, came three-wide into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. DON'T HAVE ANOTHER settled in the middle of the field while racing four-wide, came five-wide into the stretch but lacked a rally. FAST CHAZ broke out to bump RIGHT HAND RYDER then saved ground setting the early pace, drifted out nearing the quarter pole, responded when challenged by SENOR DEL CAMPO entering the stretch and then was fully extended to hold off MONGOLIAN SPRING despite drifting out during the drive. MONGOLIAN SPRING saved ground while being unhurried, slipped through during the drive and finished fast to just miss. SENOR DEL CAMPO hopped a the start then saved ground while being allowed to settle, moved up strongly along the inside nearing the quarter pole, offered a bold bid entering the stretch but wasn't quite good enough. RIGHT HAND RYDER was bumped from both sides at the start then saved ground tracking the pace, angled out to come four-wide into the stretch and finished well in a steady effort. BLUES RAPPER was reserved off the early pace, came three-wide into the stretch and rallied late. ICE TOWER broke in to bump with RIGHT HAND RYDER then was forwardly placed while racing two-wide, came three-wide into the stretch and weakened. DANGEROUS GAME raced in the back for the field, came four-wide into the stretch and failed to seriously threaten. BEER BEGONE was prominently placed early racing along the inside and tired. RIMROCK LAKE was allowed to settle while racing four-wide and gave way early.

PRINCESS FAVE saved ground while being allowed to settle, angled out to come two-wide into the stretch and wore down ABOVE THE ORDINARY in the final seventy yards. ABOVE THE ORDINARY saved ground setting the pace but was unable to resist the winner late while proving to be clearly second best in a game effort. MISS PERU was five-wide on the first turn then reserved off the pace, rallied four-wide into the stretch and was along for third without threatening the top two. PEG'S CHOICE was allowed to settle while racing two-wide, angled out to be three-wide nearing the quarter pole but lacked a rally. DREAM PAYNTER was four-wide on the first turn then raced in the ack of the field, came three-wide into the stretch and improved her position. SWEETLING saved ground early, came five-wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MISTICAL CANDY saved ground chasing ABOVE THE ORDINARY early and weakened. TRICKLE settled in the middle of the field while racing two-wide and failed to menace. SECRET WILLOW was prominently placed early while racing three-wide, gave way after five furlongs and was eased up on in the late stages.
