ROCKYSCENTS saved ground setting the pace under pressure from MISTICAL CANDY and PARLAY BAY, responded when headed and held on well for second. PARLAY BAY was forwardly placed while racing three-wide and finished well in a steady effort. TRICKLE settled in the middle of the pace racing two-wide and went evenly. BETTY RYANO saved ground while being allowed to settle, angled out to come two-wide into the stretch but lacked a rally. EYELIGHT hopped slightly at the start then came out to bump OUR LYLA GRACE, rushed up to vie with CAN'THELPPFALLIN for the lead, shook that one off leaving the three-eighths pole to open a clear lead and maintained a safe advantage. LA POPIS was reserved off the pace racing two-wide, angled out to come four-wide into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. OUR LYLA GRACE was bumped at the start by EYELIGHT then saved ground while being allowed to settle, move forward on the turn, then lacked room from the five-sixteenths pole to near the three-sixteenths pole, slipped through entering the stretch and closed strongly. ROSES R BLUE was unhurried early, came six-wide into the stretch and rallied late. LIBBY'S GAMBIT was forwardly placed early racing two-wide and weakened. ACCLAIMED PREACHER settled in the middle of the field racing three-wide and failed to seriously threaten. BETHEL RIDGE chased the early pace racing two-wide and tired. PURRFECT MOON was unhurried, swung out to be three-wide entering the stretch and was not a factor. CAN'THELPPFALLIN (IRE) vied for the early lead from along the inside, steadied in tight nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way.

LOCALLYWORLD FAMOUS vied with WEST IS WEST for the lead from along the inside, drifted out leaving the quarter pole to be four-wide entering the stretch and held on well for third. FLEXIBLE TERMS settled in the middle of the field, came three-wide into the stretch and went evenly late. JUST GOTTA SHINE saved ground racing in the back of the field and improved his position during the drive. WEST IS WEST vied for the lead from along the outside, was five-wide entering the stretch and weakened. ARNIE BOY was unhurried early, rallied five-wide into the stretch then angled in nearing the eighth pole but was unable to seriously threaten. R BARRACUDA was forwardly placed early racing two-wide and tired. CAMPARE was allowed to settle while racing long the inside, drifted out nearing the

three-eighths pole and gave way.
