RISING INFLATION settled behind horses through the first turn then seized the lead turning down the backstretch, opened up a clear lead heading into the far turn, widened the margin through that turn and ran away in the stretch under a hand ride. PRODUCTION MEETING gained the lead into the first turn, then was overtaken by the eventual winner near the six-furlong pole, chased that one the rest of the way and saved the place. JOJO BEAN pressed four wide through the first turn, appeared resigned to third, then perked up when SWAMP QUEEN bid late on the far turn, held that rival at bay through the stretch under steady handling and urging. SWAMP QUEEN broke outward at the start, then settled behind into the first turn, got over to the rail, lost ground on the backstretch and trailed far back, advanced closer going into the far turn, but was outfinished by JOJO BEAN in the battle for the third spot. JUS EVELYN pressed the pace into the clubhouse turn, then settled well off the pace down the backstretch, struggled to maintain the pace on the far turn, dropped far behind, and was eased across the finish line when hopelessly out of contention.

MAJESTIC RAGS settled inside in the second flight, tracked the speed duel through the turn, then tipped out four wide for the stretch run, got a head in front with a furlong to go and finished best to prevail. POT'S PAYCHECK broke well but opted to sit off the early pace, bid five wide into the stretch, and finished up well but was unable to get to the winner. LADY CHERYL'S SONG away well, was three wide in the early pace battle, then was the middle horse of five across the track at the three-sixteenths, had every chance but was outkicked late while able to save third. F J'S CHAOS was last early, chased the field to the far turn, launched a bid approaching the three-furlong pole, was willing but had trouble finding a way through a wall of horses in the stretch. SWEET MORGAN LEIGH broke well, was sent to the front, contested the pace from between horses through the turn, was still in contention to mid-stretch then outfinished in an otherwise solid effort. TAKEITTOTHEHOUSE was off slowly then under coaxing to keep pace, tracked in the middle of the pack three wide then dropped to last going into the stretch and chased in the four path to the wire. SECRET ROCKET hustled to the front from the break, dueled with SWEET MORNING LEIGH through the turn, was the inside horse as five fanned out across the track at the top of the stretch then was the first to give way in mid-stretch and faded late.

CHIEF EXPRESS came away well, then seized the front end from BLUSHING KAM, opened up a length or two clear on the turn, and dug in under a threat from that rival at the top of the stretch, finished determinedly under steady handling and urging, while holding clear of that foe to the finish line. BLUSHING KAM settled into a stalking position just behind CHIEF EXPRESS, was content to let that rival carve out the early fractions, then moved to challenge approaching the quarter pole, found that rival resilient, chased under pressure the length of the stretch but could not get by. LAST PENALTY settled inside well off the early pace, advanced on the turn under a drive then sustained the run into the stretch and finished well but was unable to catch the top pair. EASTON'S MOON raced mid-pack to the inside, launched a bid midway on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished evenly and was unable the pose a threat in the late stages. MISS DAAHEN tracked in mid-pack five wide down the backstretch, made a forward move on the turn to reach contention by the quarter pole, came five wide into the stretch and faltered. TIZ A BREAKUP raced far back early, kept to the inside and improved some in the late stages. SPLOTCH was off slowly, took up when RANOLOGY came over after the break, was slow to get back into stride and spotted the field a big

head start, advanced closer down the backstretch under a ride, then went one-paced in the stretch. REINE LE FER was the distant trailer early, was never a factor and passed a couple of tired ones in the stretch. CACTUS CAT bobbled at the break then raced mid-pack three wide to the turn and was eased in the stretch when hopelessly out of contention. RANOLOGY raced close up in the early stages, then stopped before the three-furlong pole, retreated steadily, and was eased up to the wire.
