CRAWFISH BURL had good speed from the break and opened up a clear lead heading down the backstretch while under restraint, was always traveling well, maintained the margin in to the far turn the was let loose with about three furlongs to run, had plenty in reserve and quickened away from the quarter pole and went on to an easy win under a hand ride. GIGI'S LUV vied for the lead inside through the first turn, settled in a tracking position, could not go on with the winner in the late stages but kept to task and chased that rival gallantly to finish far in front of the next finisher. MY IDEA went four wide on the first turn then was coaxed along to press the pace two to three deep down the backstretch, could not threaten the winner but kept to task and finished evenly to hold the third position. SPECIAL FEATURE was almost caught six wide into the first turn then dove to the inside when clear behind the rest, tracked near the back of the pack then started to advance late on the backstretch run, started to run on from the seven-sixteenths marker, went three wide on the far turn, then went flat in upper stretch and could not improve late. BEAT THE DOUBLE became rank leaving the gate and was far back early on, started to run on from the back approaching the three furlong pole, came four wide into the stretch and flattened out. MISSNEVERSATISFIED settled well off the pace behind the main pack, did not appear to be handling the surface and was done by the far turn. GRACE AND MERCY was allowed to settle into stride from the break and got a good inside position while behind held up behind the pace, tracked inside through the far turn then tired in the stretch. COSTA LADY got caught five wide going into the first turn then was able to angle inside midway on that turn, tracked close up two to three deep to the half-mile pole, was put into a drive from that point but struggled to keep pace late on the far turn and had little to offer in the stretch.

CRAZY RED broke in sharply after the break making hard contact with MORE THAN CUTE, then hustled away, gained a clear lead and finished strong under steady handling to win well. SUPPER CLUB hustled forward from the break, chased the two leaders through the turn while under a drive, kept on under strong handling and urging to get up for the place. WOODALL PASS broke well but was unable to contest the pace, took a lot of kickback through the turn then tipped out to the three path started to rally from the five-sixteenths marker and finished willingly, was making up ground once clear in deep stretch. NATE'S FOCUS was hard to load, outrun early, settled mid-pack, kept to the inside through the turn and finished with some run. MORE THAN CUTE was bumped off stride by CRAZY RED at the start, steadied then chased from the back, came five wide into the stretch then dove to the three path and finished with some interest. EL AVION broke best but raced a bit greenly, dueled briefly with CRAZY RED through the turn but proved no match, was clear second in upper stretch but could not sustain and weakened in the late stages. EL GANSITO responded to early coaxing from the start, raced close up in the second flight through the turn then floated out to the five path in the stretch, loomed a threat to the sixteenth then tired. EXAGGERIFIC broke well then raced mid-pack three to four wide through the turn, came about six wide into the late and lacked a finish. VELOCITY STORM was reluctant to load, hopped in the air at the start, spotted the field a head start and chased throughout.

TRABR'S CREED lacked early speed and raced at the back of the field in the early stages, advanced inside through the turn, came out to the three path with a furlong to run then lost the path, ducked to the inside and finished up well to just get up in the final jump. ONE LAST THING dueled inside of CATALINA DAY through the turn, shook off a horde of challengers in upper stretch had the lead in the shadow of the wire but was tagged in the final jump. CATALINA DAY dueled outside of ONE LAST THING through the turn, fought back gamely to challenges in upper stretch and finished well under handling. APRIORITY ROCKET was slow into stride and settled behind, launched a bid approaching the three-furlong pole, loomed four wide at the top of the stretch and finished up well in a scrambling finish but came up short. TAP ON BY tracked four wide early, bid five wide for the lead at the top of the stretch, finished up well under strong handling and urging, but was outkicked in the final furlong. ALINES VALENTINE broke well, hustled into the early pace mix, took up approaching the seven-sixteenths marker, lost some ground the struggled to recover the momentum in the late stages. FREEWAY had good speed from the gate and briefly vied three deep for the early lead, then backed out early on the turn and trailed the rest to the finish. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

PLATINUMUS MAXIMUS lunged at the start but still got away well, chased IMPERIAL ASSAULT through the turn then responded to left handed urging in the stretch to outfinish the rest of the field for the second spot. WINGS OF A SPARROW away well then unable to keep pace, settled mid-pack through the turn, angled out to the three path in upper stretch and finished up strong to gain third. GEM SAUCE outpaced early, swung five wide into the stretch and produced a late rally to improve while never a serious threat. TARKINGTON SUNRISE broke out and bothered SPICY ALEXANDER after the break, rushed forward into second position after the initial furlong, chased IMPERIAL ASSAULT through the turn and into the stretch but could not sustain the bid. WICKED SAILOR broke well and vied inside of a five-horse early speed battle, emerged from the fray with a slight lead, then responded when set down in upper stretch, fended off a challenge by CAJUN CATTITUDE in upper stretch, and GETOUTOFDAWAY in the final sixteenths to prevail in a solid effort. GETOUTOFDAWAY started off well behind the early pace battle, then made an aggressive move through the turn to gain contention, checked briefly off heels turning into the stretch, tipped to the outside, and finished up well under steady urging but could not get past the winner. CAJUN CATTITUDE tracked just behind the pace battle but stayed wide through the turn, made a strong move on the turn to bid for the lead five wide at the quarter pole, came into the stretch in a duel with WICKED SAILOR, could not get past that one and was outfinished in the final yards. GOLDEN BARCENTS was hustled from the break and was up with the pace battle before pulling pack near the half-mile pole, remained close up through the turn, then started to rally but was indecisive whether to go inside or outside, lost some momentum and lacked a rally once clear. GOLDZONE disputed the early pace five wide, bid for the lead under a drive passing the quarter pole then flattened out in mid-stretch. SIMONEAUX STORM raced four deep in the early pace battle, weakened approaching the quarter pole, tried to re-rally four wide in the stretch but could not produce the needed response. DOUBLE GEM broke with the early leaders, then dropped back, struggled to keep pace on the turn, then chased the field to the finish. GORMLEY'S QUEEN contested the early pace three deep, dropped out passing the five-sixteenths marker, then had nothing left for the stretch run. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was

re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

CRAFTY PRINCE got away well, dueled inside of HE'S A REAL OUTFIT, then joined by SWEET CANDY BOY through the turn, edged ahead at the top of the stretch, then responded to strong handling and urging, and drew clear in deep stretch. WEDDING GIFT was hustled from the break to get forward position, tracked mid-pack down the backstretch, went into a stiff drive with about three furlongs to run, tipped five wide into the stretch, and finished up well still under strong handling and urging to gain the place. STANLEY LITTLE BOY lost footing at the break then ducked out sharply into BITSY'S STAR, gathered up to race mid-pack down the backstretch, was being coaxed at the half but did not respond, was steered out about eight wide into the stretch and found a second wind, rallied to gain third. HARD KINGS broke well but lacked the speed to keep up early, dropped to the back before the turn, started to run on midway through the turn, then came seven wide into the stretch and finished up well under steady handling. MO CAN DO settled near the back early, kept to the inside through the turn while maintaining a steady gait, kept on through the stretch on an even pace. SWEET CANDY BOY raced close up to the

pace down the backstretch, then drew even with the leaders at the half, vied three wide through the turn, was unable to go with CRAFTY PRINCE from the quarter pole, then weakened in the stretch. PRINCE LIAM raced inside in the middle of the main pack, was under a drive from the three furlong pole but did not respond to the urgings of the rider and finished evenly in the stretch. WHATDIDWEDO was climbing while trailing the field in the early stages, circled the field four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and went one-paced in the late stages. LUCKY BOURBON was slow into stride from the break, advanced up the rail to gain contention by the turn, launched a bid from the three furlong pole, loomed a threat in mid-stretch, then tired late.
