SAUCY ARGUMENT settled in the second flight along the inside, saved all the ground to the stretch then finished up best of all and won going away. MUNCLE made the lead while getting light pressure from ASTROLOGY WOMAN, shook that one off going into the far turn the opened up on the turn, led into the stretch two or three off the rail was unable to hold off the winner. WATCH THE COAST tracked behind the leaders to the outside of MOON TRIP to far turn, produced a grinding finish in the stretch under strong handling and urging, but was not good enough to threaten the winner. MOON TRIP tracked behind the leaders through the early stages, then moved closer going into the far turn, made a four-wide bid at the quarter pole went flat in the stretch and lacked a winning kick. TAP THE TEQUILA settled inside near the back then made a mild rally three wide in the stretch to improve. KEE JEE took up after the break, settled near the back inside and lacked a rally. RAZZ settled near the back from the break, raced two to three wide down the backstretch, got a good trip through the far turn but was unable to find much in the late stages. WICKED PUNCHES raced mid-pack three wide through the early stages, launched a mild bid on the far turn but flattened out in the stretch. ASTROLOGY WONOWON broke awkwardly to the outside and bobbled a step from the gate, recovered, then pressed the pace to the far turn, came under a drive and faded.

OCEAN JACKPOT got sandwiched at the start but got away well, dueled to the outside of QUICK ZONG always traveling well, put that one away past the quarter pole then responded when set down at the top of the stretch and won clear. THE MONOPOLY MAN hopped at the start and was away behind the rest, put in a good late run to gain the place but could not get to the winner. DONEGAL FREEDOM was reluctant to load, tracked three-wide in the second flight, started to run on under handling from the three-furlong pole, swung four wide into the stretch, and finished with good energy. GONE ELVIS was under a ride from the start but could not contest the early pace, tracked a few lengths back through the turn, was unable to threaten but was kept to task and finished evenly. QUICK ZONG broke well, went to the front along the rail, dueled with OCEAN JACKPOT to stretch and weakened. SIR LIAM pressed the leaders three wide, had trouble changing leads in the stretch and faltered.

BIKINI BOTTOM steadied in the initial stages then was always close up inside behind the leaders, took advantage of an opening along the rail at the quarter pole, surged to the lead and won well clear under steady handling and intermittent urging. BEAUTIFUL JANET settled mid-pack three-wide, then launched a bid before the three furlong pole, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly but was not match for the winner. FRET NO MORE vied/dued for the lead on the inside, took the lead going into the turn but left the rail open for BIKINI BOTTOM to slip through, chased that rival into the stretch but was outfinished. DOUBLE CUTE was not asked for early speed and settled near the rear of the field, got over to the rail before the turn, got an inside run to the stretch, finished evenly under strong handling and urging, but was unable to crack the top three. SHEER LUCK was mid-pack three wide, advanced into contention on the turn, then flattened out in the stretch. LITTLE BIT O STORM contested the early pace from between horses, weakened at the quarter pole, and had little left for the stretch run. MERRILY RUSH was off slowly, raced near the back and never threatened. MALLORY'S OCEAN pressed the pace three wide down the backstretch, was still with a chance turning for home but tired. MOR MOR MUSIC stumbled at the break and raced near the back throughout. SHESASMALLTOWNGIRL got pinballed at the start, dropped far behind and lost interest.

GEM BUOY got away well and prompted the pace from the outset, took command 1/4, and widened under steady handling. BONS TEMPS ROULE settled two to three wide in the front of the second flight, moved closer on the far turn, and finished up well to claim the second prize. PESO PESADO raced mid-pack three to four wide down the backstretch, responded with a mild rally went set down with three furlongs to run and produced a mild rally to get third in the final yards. CYPRESS GOLD broke sharply and seized the lead from the break, was taken on by a pair of rivals late on the first turn then duelled with GEM BUOY down the backstretch with PLAY MO in close attendance, tried to dig in passing the quarter pole but would not keep pace with the latter, kept on well in the stretch but was outfinished for a minor award. CITY PARK raced near the back through the first half, started a steady advance from the half-mile pole, and continued to gain mildly in the stretch. THROWIN' SHADE settled well off the early pace, saved ground, launced a three to four wide bid on the far turn and finished with some interest but was never a serious threat. PLAY MO had good speed from the break and vied three wide into the first turn, settled in a stalking position down the backstretch, tried to go on with the leading pair from the three-furlong pole, loomed at the top of the stretch and tired. FLASH N CLASS was forwardly placed through the first turn, then steadily dropped back through the middle stages and did not have a late response.

HEZA PICKLE raced near the back of the field throughout and never threatened.

TWENTY FOUR GRAND broke well, dueled with SURPRISE SUNRISE through the early stages, put a head in front passing the three furlong pole, and drew off in the stretch to go unchallenged to the wire. PROMDATEBONNIE tracked mid-pack along the rail, angled to the outside heading into the turn, rallied five-wide under a drive, produced a grinding finish and was able to grab the second prize in the final jump. ROSE HILL ROCKET broke inward at the start and took the path from KASENS TRIBE, tracked mid-pack early, then went after the leaders leaving the seven-sixteenths marker, rallied into second place in upper stretch, then got short in the final furlong and was passed for the place. CLEARLY GORGEOUS stumbled after the break, then chased pace under a drive from a few lengths behind, swung four wide into the stretch, then flattened out. KASENS TRIBE bumped then steadied at the start when ROSE HILL ROCKET came over into the path after the break, then lacked early speed and trailed well behind in the early stages, was kept to task late and outfinished a couple tired rivals. SURPRISE SUNRISE dueled outside of TWENTY FOUR GRAND to the turn, weakened passing the three-furlong pole, then had little to offer in the stretch. SO WHATRO broke in a tangle, then chased from last, went wide on the turn and was put in a protective hold in the stretch.
