SENDERO rated well off the pace through the early stages, advanced into contention on the far turn then finished up well under steady handling and intermittent urging, dueled through the late stages with RED ROAD and edged clear in the final yards. RED ROAD hustled to the front and opened up a big lead early with TWOFEXUSNEXUS tracking just behind, quickened away from the three furlong pole, and let the field into the turn, dug in despite a host of challengers in upper stretch, dueled gamely through the last furlong with SENDERO but came up short at the wire. POP'S PEPPYSTEPER was not asked for speed from the break and settled at the back early, advanced steadily on the turn, going two to three wide, bid for the lead at the quarter pole and dueled with AVERY'S GEM through the stretch, got a head in front at the furlong pole and edged clear in the final yards. AVERY'S GEM was off a beat slow, was rushed up to join the early pace battle, then pressed through the turn, bid between horses at the top of the stretch, dueled with POP'S PEPPYSTEPER through the stretch, gave way grudingly in the final furlong and was second best. COUNTRY GUY broke well, vied early then backed off the developing pace duel, dropped to the back going into the turn then went into a drive with three furnongs to run, kept to task down the lane and just got up for third while well behind the top pair. GABE'S POSSUM was contesting the pace three wide then got carried out nine or ten wide by ALVARADO CAT, took over the lead at the seven-sixteenths pole, gave way at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. ALVARADO CAT broke well then bore out into the eight or nine-path before going a furlong, remained at least six wide for the rest of the trip and was not persevered with, finished the race with the rider doing his best to steer a straight course while still trying to get out in the stretch. HONOR THAT DUDE was a bit slow into stride and settled at the back of the compact field, came under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker but struggled to keep pace through the turn, was kept to task but had little to offer in the stretch. CORPORAL PAUL was contesting the early pace then got carried out very wide by ALVARADO CAT, altered course to avoid that rival and dueled briefly between horses, weakened before the three furlong pole and was not a factor in the late stages.

EVE OF EVE broke well but backed out of a potential pace battle, angled to the rail then raced close up through the turn, was full of run when forced t wait for room until late on the turn, found a seam in upper stretch, went to the lead but was taken on by GOOD BY FAITH, dueled that rival to the wire, edged ahead late and just held in a game effort. GOOD BY FAITH chased well off the pace down the backstretch then rallied from the seven-sixteenths marker, bid four wide at the top of the stretch and dueled gamely with EVE OF EVE to the finish but could not get by. CLASSY MIMI broke awkwardly, took up then dropped far back early, then rallied five wide into the stretch, was gradually getting to the top pair but came up a head short. ROSALINA got bumped at the start by the inside rival, pressed the pace three wide, then dueled AT FIRST LIGHT through the turn, put a head in front past the five-sixteenths marker, then tried in vain to hold off a trio of challengers in the stretch but was outfinished. LA PALABRA broke out into ROSALINA at the start, briefly vied between horses for the early lead, then pulled back, re-bid for the lead late on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. AT FIRST LIGHT broke well, gained the early advantage, led the way through the turn, gave way at the quarter pole and had nothing left for the stretch run. RED ZONE ducked in after the break, jumped the temporary rail and lost the rider, was corralled by the outride and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS REVIEW OF THE START. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN AS IT WAS DETERMINED THAT #1 RED ZONE CAUSED ITS OWN PROBLEM.
