GRAND EMPRESS bore out at the start, bothering the two adjacent runners, hustled to the front and went a length or two clear down the backstretch, responded when roused at the top of the stretch and held well clear under a late threat despite drifting out. ALLTAIL chased close up throughout, was under a drive on the far turn, finished willingly but unable to reel in the winner while finishing well clear of the next horse. KISSES FOR COOPER lost the path shortly after the start, then settled inside of the trio at the back through the first half-mile, stayed to the inside, came under heavy pressure from the three sixteenths and was kept to task to gain third while drifting out late in the stretch. PROMDATEBONNIE took up after the start, then raced two to three deep through the early stages, launched a bid from the seven-sixteenths marker, came three to four wide into he stretch and finished well enough to improve while never a serious threat. F J'S FLACO made the front on the first turn, opened up a length or two and led the field to the far turn, opened up near three-eighths pole with only CONFUCIOUS taking up the chase initially, held well to mid-stretch, then started drifting out late and was outfinished. TAP TO CONNECT settled in the middle of the pack, was under a stiff drive from the nine-sixteenths marker, kept to the inside and finished up well under a drive. CONFUCIUS was hard to load, then backed in from the front of the gate, was away slowly and broke outward, moved up through the first turn to press the pace two to three wide, chased that rival through the far turn and into the stretch, kept trying but could not find the winning kick while under a steady drive. STONE ALLIANCE settled inside near the rear, rode the inside through the far turn under a ride and finished evenly while never a serious threat. CHIEF KIMOSABI broke out into JAYS HOLIDAY at the start, then was unhurried early, advanced late on the backstretch run, but could not sustain the bid into the stretch and flattened out. AMERICAN CITY broke sharply, was pressed early by SEAHOSS while always traveling well, left that rival behind midway on the far turn, then was taken on by INSIGNIS approaching the quarter pole, pulled clear of the rest with that one and dueled through the stretch, edged clear late under strong handling. INSIGNIS settled two-wide tracking the pair up front, responded when asked to go on from the seven-sixteenths marker, pulled even to challenge AMERICAN CITY for the lead at the top of the stretch, dueled to deep stretch, kept on well but had to settle for second best well clear of the third finisher. NAPOLEONIC CODE lagged well behind for the first half-mile, racing two to three wide, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole and ran on with some energy under steady handling and urging to gain the third spot well back of the top pair. JOEY'S LIGHTENING raced well behind the pace through the early stakes, but kept on one-paced racing long the rail through the later stages and passed several foes in the stretch. SEEHOSS pressed the pace two-wide to the half-mile pole, was overtaken after passing the three-furlong pole and unable to offer much in the late stages. GAME AND GORMLEY went three wide through the first turn, made a mild advance on the backstretch to be with striking distance of the leaders midway on the far turn, loomed three wide passing the quarter pole but stopped in the stretch. BET AGAIN was being pushed for a forward position from the break, was close up midway down the backstretch, then started to backpedal, took a bad step at the top of the stretch, was pulled up, vetted, and transported off the track in the equine ambulance. AFFIRM CHIEF dwelt at the start, and was left behind at the break, jogged to the backstretch chute to clear the course, did not finish. STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START, AFTER A REVIEW IT WAS DETERMINED THAT AFFIRM CHIEF CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS AND NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

STRONG PROMISE pressed three-wide, bid for the lead at the quarter pole under confident handling, edged away under a hand ride, and held clear to the finish. POP'S PEPPYSTEPER was last away but never far behind, raced four wide, loomed boldly in the stretch, finished up weill but could not get to the winner. OUR DETERMINATION broke well and was sent to the front, gained a slight advantage early, held the lead under some pressure from STRONG PROMISE through the turn then weakened in mid-stretch. HI YAH outrun from the break, tracked close up inside, finished with good interest but could not find the winning kick. SOUNDS LIKE POWER raced four wide and near the rear of the compact field to the turn, struggled to keep pace late on the turn, failed to change leads in the stretch, and finished evenly. ORDER UP raced close up through the early stages, then lacked a finish in the stretch. RADIANT REBEL was away well but second last past the half-mile pole, advanced four wide through the turn, then bid five-wide into the stretch, rallied down the middle of the track and was just up in the last jump. TAKEITTOTHEHOUSE hustled up two deep into the early pace mix, bid for the lead near the quarter pole, two deep, took a short lead with a furlong to go but came up on the short end of a very tight photo finish. LA PALABRA pressed four wide into the turn, bid three-wide at the quarter pole, ran on but was outfinished. DEAL WITH IT rushed to the front after a tardy start, dueled with TAKEITTOTHEHOUSE through the turn, weakened at the quarter pole but kept trying to the finish. GOLDEN BARCENTS broke best and led through the initial stages before being overtaken, chased the top pair under a drive through the turn, bid three wide at the top of the stretch, then weakened near the furlong grounds. CLASSY MIMI restless in the gate, was off a step slow, outrun early, under a ride to keep up through the turn but dropped to last and was unable to muster up anything in the stretch. TENSAS CLEAR broke well, was briefly up with the back, then steadily retreated and never threatened.
