FLASHY BOY broke best and opened up a length in the initial stages, took some pressure from a pair of rivals through the turn, fought back when set down at the top of the stretch, and held safe under steady handling and intermittent urging. CHECK ME OUT broke well but lacked the speed to compete for the early lead, settled at the back early, saved ground, then cut the corner while starting a rally into the stretch, finished well and was rapidly closing the margin but ran out of time. CAPTAIN COOL raced between the front and rear packs through the early stages, advanced under a drive on the turn, was kept to task through the stretch, and was gradually gaining well enough to claim the third spot. TWOFEXUSNEXUS got shuffled back at the start, bid three wide through the turn, came five wide into the stretch, and finished well but was too late. CONGRATS CADET away well, ceded the early lead while tracking the lone pacesetter close up, continued to chase through the turn, got stuck behind horses in upper stretch, rallied once clear but was too late. SHE'S A BANDIT bobbled at the start, showed good speed, then tried to duck into the gap, steadied, dropped to mid-pack, crept close approaching the top of the stretch, then had trouble finding a way through traffic until late, then did not go on once clear. COSTA LADY sent quickly to the front, angled over toward the rail when clear, led the field into the turn with a rival in close pursuit, weakened approaching the quarter pole, then was running on fumes through the late stages. DARK SKYER broke well, chased the early pace up close, pulled up to within a lengh of the lead heading into the turn, was overtaken midway through that turn then had little to offer in the stretch. MISSNEVERSATISFIED dropped back to last early, and never menaced.

NOTION was not asked for speed from the break, moved off the rail mid-way through the first turn, and steadily advanced down the backstretch, deftly navigated through horses on the far turn, came into the stretch with a short lead, then powered away as much the best. BIG NICKEL under coaxing from the start but unable to join the early fracas up front, settled well behind, saved ground to the stretch, then tipped out to the four path, finished up well and was just up for third. HOLD MY HAT hustled to the front from the start, vied three wide in the early pace battle, dropped out passing the seven-sixteenths marker and tired in the stretch.

ROSE HILL ROCKET moved up after the start to join EXPLODING CIRCLE heading into the turn, pulled away from the rest through the turn, put that rival away in upper stretch, had a clear lead to mid-stretch but was collared in the last jump. SURPRISE SUNRISE broke well, vied early, was finishing well but having trouble with the lead change, hung in the final furlong and outfinished by the top pair. EXPLODING CIRCLE hustled from the break and gained the early lead, gave way at the top of the stretch, fought on but was unable to hold on for a minor award. SLIM CAUSEWAY pressed the early pace inside of SURPRISE SUNRISE, dropped out before the three-furlong pole, and finished evenly up the rail. KASENS TRIBE was crowded at the start by JENNY'S DAY, moved up after that slow start then lacked a late rally.
