SWEET THIRTEEN lagged behind the field after being unable to keep up with the rest early, swung five wide into the stretch, and made a late run, but could not make up the needed ground. LASSIE BEE broke best but was soon inside of a five-horse battle for the early lead, backed off to a tracking position before the turn, then patientl waited for room through the turn, tipped out to the three path for the stretch run and produced a bold rally, gained the lead inside the sixteenth pole and won going away. ALYSE PARKER broke well and was two deep in the early pace battle, took command approaching the seven-sixteenths marker and opened up a little over a length through the turn, had a clear lead turning for home and had not been asked yet, finished well but was overtaken late by the winner while clear of the next horse. SPICY MUSTARD ducked in at the start, making light contact with ALYSE PARKER, was being coaxed along in the initial stages but was not involved in the pace battle, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole, bid three-wide into the stretch, and finished with good energy, drifting out in the final yards. KIKI'S SWEET DREAM sent hard from the break, shuffled back near the three-furlong pole and lost some ground, then had little to offer in the stretch. KINSLEY GRACE broke outward at the start, then hustled four wide to vie for the early lead, kept to the inside and was outfinished while going willingly in the later stages. OCEAN VOW got forced out at the start by KINSLEY GRACE, rushed up to join the pace scramble five-wide then bid three-wide late on the turn, but faltered in the stretch.

BELLA CARMELINA slow into stride, had to be coaxed early but still tracked well off the pace through the first half-mile, launched a bid after passing the seven-sixteenths marker, advanced three-wide through the turn, then swung five wide into the stretch and finished best to gain the lead in the final furlong and win clear. TOOTOO TOURIST was away well then ceded the front end, settled into a tracking position down the backstretch never far from the front end, waited for room through the far turn then took advantage of the gap when CRAWFISH BURL drifted out turning for home, opened up a clear lead in the stretch but was not match for the winner in the late stages. WORLD OF HURT void of speed despite some coaxing from the rider, dropped well behind the field through the first turn, then moved up to join BELLA CARMELINA at the back of the pack late on the backstretch run, kept to the inside through the turn, finished with some interest under left-handed urging, and gained the show spot. DYLAN'S DREAM joined CRAWFISH BURL on the lead exiting the first turn, went together with that one on a moderate pace to the half-mile pole, did not go on when that rival opened on the far turn and went flat in upper stretch. SHE BADGER went four wide through the clubhouse turn, tracked two-wide as part of the second pair behind the frontrunning duo, came under a ride to keep up after passing the half-mile pole, but struggled to keep up through the turn, went five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. CRAWFISH BURL made the front going into the first turn, then dueled with DYLAN'S DREAM through the early stages while under a fairly snug rating hold, slipped away near the three-furlong pole with the rider still confident, drifted out to the three path turning for home, leaving the rail open and tired in the stretch.

BEAMER settled two wide in the second flight, drafted behind the leading trio as they cleared the path through a flock of geese on the track near the five-sixteenths marker, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch and went on, battling on GROUD CONTROL through the stretch, and kept that stubborn foe at bay while putting distance on the rest. GROUND CONTROL tracked inside just behind the leaders, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths, while avoiding the stricken fowl, hooked up with BEAMER in a spirited stretch duel but could not get by. SELECTIVELY SWEET got away best but was soon joined by a rival to the inside and outside, vied between those rivals to the turn, was under a stiff drive approaching the three-furlong pole, powered right through the flock of birds at the five-sixteenths, clipping at least one, then weakened in the stretch. CHATTANOGA CREW vied three-wide for the early lead, was put a head in front after passing the three-furlong pole, unaffected by the flock, was three deep as four horses fanned out at the top of the stretch, then tired and was not involved late. DREAMY DEAL was away awkwardly and made contact with BIKINI BOTTOM after the start, raced inside of a trio contesting the lead, steadled approaching the five-sixteenths marker in an unsuccessful attempt to avoid the flock, dropped back, tried to recover but could not make up the lost ground. BIKINI BOTTOM took a light bump from DREAMY DEAL after the break, raced at the back of the field down the backstretch, continued to chase through the turn, and lacked a finish.

JOSIE'S PRIORITY pushed to the front from the start, maintained a short lead into and through the turn, opened up a bit late on the turn while traveling well, responded when rounded in upper stretch, and held clear under left-handed urging. VALHALLA VIKING pressed the pace four wide, kept on well to be second while never a serious threat to the winner. LOUISIANA LUCA allowed to settle from the break and dropped back to be last going into the turn, tipped three wide into the stretch, and produced a late run to gain third while never a threat to the winner. PUCKSTER settled in the middle of the pack under some restraint, chased through the turn, then had some response when set down at the top of the stretch, but was not good enough. LA BOUCANE broke well, pressed the pace three-wide down the backstretch, then chased JOSIE'S PRIORITY through the turn while under a drive, could not go with that one from the top of the stretch and finished evenly. WILDCATS'S MEOW broke well and was up close to the early pace racing on the rail, struggled to keep pace approaching the three-furlong pole and was not involved in the late stages. ONE LINE WHIT held up at the back through the initial stages, was let loose approaching the half-mile pole, advanced under a drive three-wide through the turn, then drifted out very wide into the stretch under left-handed urging and lacked a finishing kick.
