GABBYS BLING allowed to settle from the break, dropped down to the rail before the turn, saved ground through that turn, then tipped out to the three path in upper stretch and finished up well to gain second. GIRLIE'S MAX chased close up four to five wide down the backstretch, bid from the three-furlong pole under a drive, was six wide into the stretch, put in a good finish, and won the race for the third prize. CUSTOM CADILLAC was last away then bid seven-wide into the stretch and finished up with some energy to improve. EL DINERO broke well but ceded the front end, tracked behind the early pace, then moved up to challenge for the lead approaching the three-furlong pole, bid four-wide into the stretch, and finished up well under strong handling to edge clear in the final yards. SAINT GABRIEL stumbled exiting the gate, leaned out and bothered STOVALL, gathered up and was allowed to settle into stride at the rear of the field, moved out to the two path, advanced through the turn, angled out to the five-path mid-stretch and finished well to gain second. LAURI'S WISH sent hard from the start, contested the early pace three wide then dueled MARKS PROMISE through the turn, put a head in front at the five-sixteenths marker, hooked up with EL DINERO at the top of the stretch, could not go with that one, kept on trying but was outfinished late for the place. STOVALL was forced out by SAINT GABRIEL at the start, bothering MYGLORYBEE, was outpaced early and dropped to last before the turn, was kept to task in the stretch, and managed to outfinish a couple of stragglers before the wire. MYGLORYBEE lost the path early when STOVALL came over after the break, took up and was last into stride, advanced three to four wide down the backstretch to be up close to the leaders at the three-furlong pole, loomed a threat at the quarter pole while under a drive, then flattened out in mid-stretch. GIFT GIVER hustled from the break and vied between horses early, then backed off near the half-mile pole and steadily faded through the turn. MARKS PROMISE hustled up to contest the early pace from the inside, gave way to approaching the quarter pole, and tired in the stretch.

QUIK PUNCH away well, vied six-wide early, pulled heading into the turn with RUNNER RUNNER the only rival in close pursuit, was going well approaching the top of the stretch, held clear under steady handling, and was increasing the winning margin a bit in the final yards. CADILLAC BO broke well, was four wide in the early pace battle, took up the chase when QUIK PUNCH and RUNNER RUNNER pulled away mid-turn, kept on well with a lot of ground to make up, and was just up in time to take the second spot in the last jump. RUNNER RUNNER showed the best early speed from the break, made the front before the turn only to be overtaken by QUIK PUNCH, battled back to chase that rival gamely into the stretch, and was nipped at the wire for the place. THEBOYZ WARNING stumbled leaving the gate, then was not quick enough to join the early pace battle, settled near the back, bid three wide from the middle of the turn, finished up well under handling, but flattened out in the final furlong. MIDDLEOFTHEFAIRWAY broke well and was three deep contesting the early pace, lost ground early on the turn, then came back on under steady handling, finished with some interest, but was not good enough. MR. BRAD'S COWBOY pressed the early pace five-deep, did not go on with the rest from the three-furlong pole, then finished evenly. ISLE CALL U LATER broke well, briefly vied between horses for the early lead, backed out after passing the half-mile pole and was uninvolved in the later stages. LUCKY BOURBON lunged

at the break and slow to begin, was under pressure to keep up on the turn, but lacked a rally. DEPUTY DEAL was slow into stride and chased from last to the turn, swung three-wide into the stretch, but was unable to generate a late bid. EL LAGARTO veered in after the start, then steadily dropped back and was never a factor.
