VANNA G set the pace, responded when challenged to duel through the stretch, was in tight late and proved best. PERFECT DEAL pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled through the stretch, bore out, was in tight late and was outfinished in a game effort. MO VISTA bumped at the start, went five wide on the first turn, was never far off the pace, lacked the needed late response and settled for show. TAKE IT TO COURT bumped at the start, was void of early speed and trailed the field, bid along the rail leaving the turn and finished well. THIS GRAY MISCHIEV pressed the pace, dropped back into the turn, stayed within range and came up empty late. CUPIE CUTIE was slow early, angled out at the top of the stretch to be widest in the drive and offered a mild bid only. EVE EVE was never far back, raced inside, was through after a half and faded. ACADIANA was crowded into the first turn, raced outside in an even effort and was outrun. KISSES FOR COOPER pulled early, raced wide, was through early and not urged late. HONEST DEAL was eased and walked off.
