HANDSOME HAROLD pressed the pace two across, bid willingly, got a head in front past the eighth pole and drew clear late. GLOBAL STAGE set a pressured pace, fought back when headed, yielded near the sixteenth pole and just lasted for place. CRIME SPREE raced close to the pace along the inside, shifted out when clear, closed steadily and just missed second. SEVEN SCENTS raced in close, went six wide leaving the turn, was in range and lacked the needed late response. SLITHER trailed the field in an outside trip and failed to threaten.
