BET ON BOBBY vied early, drew clear entering the turn and held off SOPHIE'S PAINTER to just last. SOPHIE'S PAINTER was in close, in tight entering the turn, angled out, bid five wide entering the stretch, closed willingly and was gaining fast late. CAJUN CYCLONE broke through the gate, stalked the pace while racing towards the outside, was in range, hung late and held for show. LOVELY SASSICAIA was checked hard entering the turn, closed steadily and was gaining for show. TOP PRIORITY raced close to the pace along the inside, failed to rally despite strong handling and went evenly late. BABY'S LAST DANCE was crowded at the start, steadied along the backstretch, impeded into the turn and failed to menace. FATHER MARK pulled up and was transported off the track via an equine ambulance. The stewards' posted a general inquiry concerning possible interference near the three eighths pole. No change was made.
