DROBNY got away well, tracked close up while racing comfortabley in-hand, launched a bid near the quarter pole and put in a strong finish to win going away. FINAL HALF was away quickly and made the front on the first turn, rated down the backstretch a length or two clear of the rest, took the lead in to upper stretch, responded when roused in upper stretch and finished up well but could not hold off the winner in the final yards. ASAASY raced in mid-pack to the inside and was mildly gaining on the leaders in the stretch, was never a threat, but gained third in the late stages. HWY TWENTY RIDE tracked two-deep in mid-pack through the early running, maintained position through th the turn and into the stretch and finished evenly. MAYBE EYE'LL CALL was in a bit tight at the start but otherwise got a good start, was always close up, moved up 3-wide approaching the quarter pole to bid for the lead, then flattened out in mid-stretch. F J'S FLACO was under a hard ride from the start, then settled in close up on the rail going into the turn, angled out five-wide for the stretch run and finished up well under steady handling and intermittent urging to be along in time. MAGIA NERA was a little slow to get going, then moved up late on the backstretch run under some coaxing, loomed four wide at the quarter pole, gained the advantage in upper stretch, battled gamely to the wire but was outfinished in the final yards by the winner. MIDNIGHT HUMOR outrun early, advanced through the turn on the inside, slipped through and around horse late on the turn to emerge three wide at the top of the stretch, finished well under strong handling, but it was not enough to threaten. MIDNIGHT AVENGER got pinched at the start, then was outpaced early, made a strong middle move to be within striking distance of the top of the stretch, finished with interest but flattened out a bit and was unable to threaten for the win. MUD ON MY BOOTS was three-wide in the early pace battle, poked a head in front, then came under heavy pressure after passing the quarter pole and weakened in the final furlong. MR RAMIREZ raced four-wide mid-pack, made a brief advance on the far turn but could not sustain the bid. YEAGER got off to an awkward starthen rushed up to be the inside horse in the early pace scramble, then weakened in the stretch. TAP ON BY unable to join the early pace, settled in the middle of the pack, did not respond when asked to go on from the three-furlong pole, and was outrun in the stretch. GANGSTER FLASH was reluctant to load, broke a step slow then hustled to the lead, was joined by a pair of rivals to the outside, then dueled through the turn with FLY STRONG clear of the rest, had EL SUNSHINE make it three across the track at the top of the stretch, had the inside position and finished up well under steady handling, drifted out just before the wire, bumping EL SUNSHINE. EL SUNSHINE broke well but ceded the front end, launched a bid from before the three-furlong pole, loomed three-wide at the top of the stretch, lugged in through the stretch despite left-handed urging, then took a bump just before the finish and just missed. LITEUPTHENITE chased three to four wide, started to run on after passing the half-mile pole, sustained the run into the stretch, and kept on to gain third while marginally closing the distance to the top two. FLY STRONG broke well and vied between horses for the early lead, battled on gamely to the stretch, then gave way with just over a furlong to run. GOLDEN KEEN was outpaced from the start and settled inside near the rear of the field, rallied through the turn up the rail, but was not quite doing enough in the final furlong. VARINISI broke well but retreated quickly to race at the back and never threatened. SHE'S A LIVE WIRE took a bump from VARINISI at the start, then was under a ride to catch up, dropped far off the pace before the turn, saved ground, then was uninvolved in the late stages. WINGS OF A SPARROW got away well, tracked close up along the rail, then chased BOBBY'S GIRL into the stretch, responded to steady handling and intermittent urging, edged clear in the final yards in a driving finish. BOBBY'S GIRL was quickest from the gate, cleared off to a two-length advantage, widened the margin on the turn, dug in under a threat from WINGS OF A SPARROW in upper stretch, kept on gamely under steady handling and urging, but had to settle for second best. TARKINGTON SUNRISE came together with SHE'S A TARGET as the start but was otherwise away well, stalked the early pace, lost a position late on the turn, kept on to hold third well clear of the next finisher.
