ANACREON hustled, made the front and settled a little more than a length ahead of the rest, was allowed to dictate the early fractions, then had plentty in reserve to fend off a mild challenge in the stretch. ATLANTIC STORM hustled but was unable to push the early pace, settled a few lengths behind the lead while saving ground all the way, tipped out a path in the stretch, and finished up well but was unable to get to the winner, finishing well clear of the next horse. SHOHEI took a light bump from JAYDE'S BANDIT a few strides into the contest, was always prominent, drifted out about two paths turning for home, finished up well despite having some trouble changing leads. LIGHTNING TWIRL race four-wide and made a moderate late bid for third but came up short. RUNNINGINTHEMONEY broke well but ceded the front end, moved up midway on the turn to challenge for the lead, put a head in front turning for home, battled gamely but came up short in the last jumps. WILLIAM'S LEGACY broke outward at the start, bothering BYZANTINE in the process, was then quick to get to the lead, proceeded to dictate very slow fractions, getting no pressure from the closest pursuers, was able to turn the race into a sprint to the finish, got first run and held sway under strong handling to prevail. SMALL TOWN HEROINE stalked the leader from a couple of lengths back, never putting any pressure on that one despite the slow pace, moved to challenge leaving the quarter pole, and finished up well, was narrowing the margin nearing the wire but ran out of time. MISS LOUISE lagged at the back for the first half-mile, advanced steadily down the backstretch, moved up to the leaders on the far turn, kicked on with the others in the sprint to the wire, could not get to the top pair but won a tight battle for third. CHARLUCHE settled inside close up under some restraint, waited for room approaching the stretch, ran on when set down at the top of the stretch, finished well but came up short in the end. PASILA raced well off the pace through the early stages, moved up late on the backstretch, then waited for some room on the far turn but could not quicken with the others when it came time to sprint to the finish. CLASSY MIMI raced in mid-pack, always three to four wide then lacked a late kick in the stretch. BYZANTINE was bumped and steadied at the start, raced far back, tried to rally, but was outkicked in the late stages. MISS EMILY was bumped at the start, then not asked for speed, settled near the rear, was never able to overcome the slow pace, then faltered in the stretch.

TWOFEXUSNEXUS tracked three wide, always travling well, launched a bid for the lead approaching the three-furlong pole, dueled briefly with BILLY BOWLEGS, then pulled clear and won going away. BILLY BOWLEGS hustled to the front and opened up by a length or two early, did not get much pressure early on, tried to fight back when TWOFEXUSNEXUS bid near the quarter pole but found that rival too much, kept on and held second despite getting tired in the late stages. FREDDIE BY A NOSE settled off pace three to four wide, launched a mild bid from the three furlong pole, produced a grinding finish, but was good enough to gain the third spot. GORDITO HERMOSO ceded the lead but was always close up inside, bid three-wide into the stretch but was outfinished. GATSBY'S FORTUNE raced close up behind the lone pacesetter, started to lose ground mid-way on the turn, and went evenly hrough the stretch. RAYDEN AND REMI chased, came under a ride on the turn, then lacked a finish. JOSEPH H moved up after a slow start four to five wide to press the pace into the turn, came under heavy pressure near the quarter pole, then faltered in the stretch. SUMMERTIME PEPPERS away well, settled inside mid-pack, then tired in the stretch. APRIORITY AVENGER outrun despite being under a ride from the start, never factored. THE RIDER OF #2 SUMMERTIME PEPPERS LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST #1 BILLY BOWLEGS ALLEGING INTERFERENCE ON THE FIRST TURN. AFTER A REWIEW THE OBJECTION WAS DISALLOWED AND THE ORIGINAL FINISH WAS MADE OFFICIAL.

GROUND CONTROL was coaxed a bit from the break but not asked to go for the lead, settled mid-pack under a hold, pulled closer to the front down the backstretch, then was boxed in on the far turn while full of run, found a seam four wide turning into the stretch then produced a powerful late burst under steady handling to win well. TALKSALOT allowed to settle from the break, jumped some tracks turning onto the backstretch, bided time near the rear, moved up heading into the turn, launched a bid midway through the turn, tipped out to the five path for the stretch run, and rallied past all but the winner. CAPELLA RED got an awkward start, then settled at the back early, made a bold, three-wide middle move from last to share the lead on the backstretch, bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, had a little trouble keeping a straight course late, and was outfinished by the top pair. HAUNTRESS angled to the rail before the first turn, tracked close up and launched a bid midway on the turn, encountered a little traffic at the top of the stretch, but lacked a winning

kick when clear. SALOMEINTHEHOOP had good speed from the break but was taken back under stout restraint, dropped back in the pack to the half, then tried to rally with three furlongs to run, finished with some interest but could not make up the needed ground. NAPOLEONIC CODE was pushed from the start to get forward position, made the lead on the first turn, then was taken under a strong hold, settled inside through slow fractions with a pair of rivals keeping company to the outside, quickened away midway on the turn, opened up in the stretch, and easily held safe from a late closing challenger. NORTHERNREFLECTION was always close up for the first half-mile, lost some ground when the trio up front quickened the pace, came under a ride from the three-furlong pole, found a good stride in the stretch, was closing the margin on the leader as the wire loomed, but ran out of time. BARBACOA broke awkwardly to the outside at the start, then was caught three to four wide through the first turn, moved up to press the pace down the backstretch, then was put into a drive approaching the three-furlong pole, could not get to the winner in the stretch, and was passed late for the place. CITY PARK tracked behind the pace, riding the rail to the far turn, was kept to task in the stretch and improved while no threat to the winner. HOOSIER was not asked for speed and settled at the back for the early running, raced three-wide then five-wide into the stretch, and passed a few tired ones in the stretch. TAPPIN FORA DANCE tracked mid-pack to the inside, came under a ride from the three-furlong pole but lacked a rally. DRIED PEPPER pulled to the front and went head-to-head through slow fractions with NAPOLEONIC CODE, then later joined by BARBACOA, could not keep up after passing the three-furlong pole and had little left in the stretch. UNITED PATRIOT became a bit rank on the first turn and pulled the rider down the backstretch, made a mild forward move on the turn when asked, but flattened out early in the stretch and was unable to threaten. DEANOS CAPE settled

near the back of the pack, started to lose ground on the field before the far turn, and had little to offer late. GOTTA DEAL got caught five-wide going into the clubhouse turn, moved up to mid-pack but still wide down the backstretch, then started to lose contact with the field after passing the half-mile pole and was not involved in the late stages.

LADY DREAMER was held up through the first turn and lacked a rally. MS. CAJUN QUEEN raced close up to the far turn and weakened.

MOR FORCE broke well, took the lead briefly then backed off, came under a drive from the three-furlong pole, was under strong handling in the stretch, split horses late and surged in the final yards, and was up in the last jump. MR MO MONEY pressed the pace from between horses, then was left to duel GOLDEN MANE through the turn, had a narrow advantage at the top of the stretch, and finished determinedly in a three-way battle down the stretch and just missed. SEIZETHEDAYDUDE got impeded by GOLDEN MANE at the start, then was outpaced early, moved up four wide into the turn, pulled even with the leaders at the quarter pole, battled gamely down the stretch but could not finish the job and was passed in the shadow of the wire. TWO GOOD OLD GUYS missed the break, chased down the backstretch, angled out to the three path to make a three to four wide bid on the turn, came into the stretch still with a lot to do, raced greenly but managed to improve. GOLDEN MANE broke inward at the start and completely wiped out SEIZETHEDAYDUDE, vied three-wide early, put a head in front going into the turn, battled gamely between a pair of rivals before giving way in upper stretch. UNLAWFUL was under a drive after an awkward start and outfinished. REAUX BAN DA MAN away in good order, advanced from mid-pack to be in contention approaching the three-furlong pole, then retreated and struggled to keep up late. PAROLE DRAMA showed good speed from he inside, then became boxed in and dropped to last on the turn, tried to rally up the rail but was outrun in the late stages.

A THOUSAND ARROWS sent hard from the start and made the lead, pressed on the inside by ABOUT THE BUSINESS, came into the stretch on the left lead, gave up the lead, then straightened out and came back on under steady handling and urging to prevail. HES THE BOMB TOO took a bump from the inside at the start, then conceded the front, tracked close up through the turn, had to wait for room late on the turn, then bid three wide into the stretch, could never get past the winner but was able to gain the second prize. ABOUT THE BUSINESS broke out and made contact with HES THE BOMB TOO, dueled inside of A THOUSAND ARROWS to the turn, kept the pressure on that rival through the turn and into the stretch, was in-tight in upper stretch, but soldiered on and outfinished in the final yards. STEVE'S TROUBLE chased from well back after a tardy start, came five-wide into the stretch, kept on, and was making up some ground in the late stages. NOT FREE vied four-wide early, dropped back but was always close up, moved up to challenge for the lead midway on the turn, loomed four wide at the top of the stretch, and faltered late. RIGHTHOOFLEFTRIGHT lacked any speed from the break, dropped far behind and never menaced.
