MR MCGREGOR got away well and was held up just behind the dueling leaders, kept to the inside path, waited patiently for room on the far turn, slipped through on the rail turning into the stretch, opened up and held clear of any late threats. SABI raced close up under a light hold, tracked two-wide behind the dueling leaders, bid four to five wide at the top of the stretch, could not get to the winner but outfinished the rest for the place. GET THEM JUSTIN was allowed to settle from the break and raced mid-pack, tracked inside down the backstretch, came under a ride with less than three furlongs to run, finished up well, but had some trouble changing leads and came up short. MI SOLUTION hustled away from the gate, got inside position, then dueled with HOUSE BOURBON from the clubhouse turn to the stretch, came under a ride midway through the turn, drifted out a bit leaving the rail open for MR MCGREGOR, finished willingly, but was unable to hold on for a minor award. PUBLIUS slow early to be well off the leaders near the rear of the field, commenced a steady, long drive on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, and finished with a late gain but was never a serious threat. DADDY HEY DADDY broke well and was guided to the front, established command midway through the first turn, rated nicely with only some mild pressure from a couple of rivals a length back, dug in under a threat from DIVA BEACH at the top of the stretch, holding that rival at bay despite racing on the left lead, faced another threat from CC COLA in the final yards, switched over to the correct lead and would not be denied. CC COLA settled well off the pace through the early stages, launched a bid midway through the far turn, was trying to get out in the clear in mid-stretch but found the path blocked, dove to the inside near the chute, surged in the final yards, and just missed. DIVA BEACH stalked the pace set by DADDY HEY DADDY two-wide, moved up to challenge late on the far turn, dueled that rival down the stretch, was unable to get by, and had to settle for the minor award. BASILE away well, tracked close up on the inside just behind the pacesetters, was always close to the far turn, loomed a threat at the top of the stretch, but could not find the winning kick. ARARATTA was one of the last to break, settled inside at the back of the pack through the first turn, tracked three-wide near the rear of the field, tried to rally under a drive from the three furlong pole, and finished with good energy while never a serious threat. AWREE unhurried early, raced in the rear of the pack, then improved position showing mild interest in the stretch. WALKSONWATER raced close up while behind held up three-wide behind the pace, came four-wide into the stretch then flattened out. LIAM'S MIST raced in mid-pack then lacked a bid. SWAMP QUEEN settled near the rear of the field, tried to mount a rally in the stretch, but was outfinished and could not improve.

TIZ MARKS SPIRIT broke sharply, then raced three deep of four horses contesting the early lead, backed off a bit early on the turn, then came back on in the stretch, battled gamely with BUTCHER HOLLER in deep stretch, and got the nose down just in time. BUTCHER HOLLER was not involved in the early pace scramble, moved up into contention on the turn, launched a bid from the five-sixteenths marker, got the inside run into the stretch, hooked into a spirited duel with TIZ MARKS SPIRIT in the final furlong, and came up on the short end of the photo in a game effort. DONEGAL DREAMER stumbled at the start, then was outrun early, got to the rail when clear, took the inside path through the turn, then angled out four-wide at the top of the stretch, finished well under steady handling, was gaining on the leaders but ran out of time. TEXAS ADOPTER was last away and outrun through the early stages, rallied three wide through the turn, then got floated five-wide into the stretch, finished up well but just missed out on a minor award. GONE ELVIS made the front end out of the gate with a trio of rivals stacked up to the outside, shook away on the turn, had a short lead at the top of the stretch, but could not last and weakened. MO SOPO lacked the speed to contest the early pace but tracked in a good spot, not too far back, came four wide into the stretch but lacked the necessary response. COMPETITIVE SHOCK was two-deep contesting the early pace, came under a stiff drive after passing the three-furlong pole, dropped off the pace, and tired in the stretch. HE'S SUPER WICKED contested the early pace four-wide, started to weaken heading into the turn and was done before the stretch.
