FROSTY BLUE was never far off the pace, raced outside, went five wide entering the stretch, closed willingly and wore down SEASONAL LOVE to get up at the wire. SEASONAL LOVE pressed the pace two wide, got a head in front on the turn, drew clear and was caught at the wire. KING'S LUTE was void of early speed, bid along the rail on the turn and finished well to get up for show. MAX COLLECTOR set a pressured pace, was headed on the turn, was unable to sustain his bid and was caught for third. STARRY EYED was off a step slowly, moved up to stalk the pace, bid inside on the turn, angled out for the drive, bid and came up empty. SUNNY SASSICAIA was slow early, went six wide at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid. QUINNSALTYOFFICER lagged inside, swung out leaving the turn and gave way.
