CONFUCIUS was reluctant to load, then backed into the gate from the front before the start, then allowed to settle into stride after the break, raced between horses in the tracking group through the early stages, moved up late on the backstretch run to be within striking distance leaving the three-furlong pole, was in a box late on the turn but got clear in upper stretch finished well under steady handling and out-gamed a couple of rivals to prevail. TITANIUM DEAL was the outside horse of three contesting the early pace well clear of the rest, went on with SEITAN into the turn, put a head in front near the guarter pole under confident handling, responded when set down in upper stretch, but was outfinished in the final yards by the winner. TONI'S INFERNO was the inside horse of the three tracking the early leaders, advanced closer heading into the turn, then went out a path and continued to advance through the far turn, had trouble keeping to a straight path in the stretch, and came up short. JACKSON D was shuffled back shortly after the start and last into the clubhouse turn, bided time at the back to the half-way point, then advanced into contention late on the far turn, tipped out to the four path and rallied, but came up short of the minor award. THUNDERING DESIRE got away well, floated a bit wide through the clubhouse turn, settled in a stalking position behind the leader down the backstretch, rolled right past that one near the quarter pole, then finished up well under intermittent urging, holding a rival at bay to the wire. BACK STREET BABY tracked from well behind the pace through the early stages, moved up down the backstretch run, made a good middle move on the far turn to gain contention, chased the winner gamely to the finish, but could not get past. CLASSIC EMBRACE tracked four wide in the middle of the tracking pack, was kept to task down the stretch and was just up to gain the third prize. BROADWAY STAR unhurried from the start, settled near the rear of the field, then advanced steadily down the backstretch, then responded with some late interest when set down in the stretch. GRAND EMPRESS vied three-wide through the first turn, then settled a couple of lengths back, moved up approaching the quarter pole, loomed in upper stretch but finished evenly, lacking a late kick. SASSI SKY lagged at the rear early, started a sustained rally from the seven-sixteenths marker, tipped out to the four-path at the head of the stretch, altered course to the inside in mid-stretch, but was unable to improve much. SHOW RESPECT settled inside in the middle of the pack, finished with some good energy, but had trouble changing leads and flattened out late. STAR OF ASTROLOGY made the early running with THUNDERING DESIRE a constant shadow to the outside, gave way near the quarter pole and tired in the stretch. MY ROYAL PRINCESS saved ground, tracked in the back half of the field to the far turn, and lacked a late bid.

COSMIC TRAIN tracked four-wide in the tracking group, rallied three-wide into the stretch, and just got up for second in the last jump. MANGUM hustled away from the gate to get to the front end, gained the rail and the lead, was able to slow down the early pace with HIGHLAND CREEK keeping company to the outside, tried to quicken away through the far turn but surrendered the lead to that rival near the top of the stretch, had something left for the stretch run but was unable to last in the final furlong. TDZSHININLUCKYSTAR settled mid-pack three-wide, made a mild bid from the quarter pole, loomed a threat in upper stretch but was outkicked in the final furlong. SONYA KNOWS BETTER settled inside with the second flight, just behind the pacesetters, came under pressure from the five-sixteenths marker but lacked the needed late response. UP N GONE raced three wide at the rear and went one-paced through the stretch. CAJUN AMI held up near the back, never threatened. JEFFROW saved ground near the back and lacked a rally. CAJUN MITOLE raced in the middle of the pack two wide and faded late. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
