## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

MAXI BOOTS pressed the pace while racing well off the rail, rallied on the turn, swung out entering the stretch, closed under steady urging, assumed command near the eighth pole and drew off. SILVER REDESDALE stalked the pace while racing outside, was carried out entering the stretch, was in range and lacked the needed late response. NAME THE TIME set a pressured pace, faltered near the eighth pole and held safely for show. ZIPPY TOGA was crowded at the start, slow early, advanced to the turn, bid along the rail and failed to rally. TAP THE TEQUILA came out at the start, put in a steady effort and improved position. KEE JEE hesitated at the start to be off slowly and was not a factor. ONEPARTICULRHARBOR broke slowly, dropped inside and was outrun. ALL SAINTS advanced to the turn, bid inside and had nothing left for the drive. LITTLE JONY raced mid pack, was through after a half, stopped and was not urged late. WATCH THE COAST showed speed to the second turn, tired, stopped, was eased and walked off.
