VIDEO EVIDENCE was away alertly, had a slim lead on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. HEARD A GHOST was hustled early, dueled on the turn and had the lead from the three path in upper stretch but was outgunned. SPEEDY BULLEIT was in touch, had a good position on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was up for show. HAPPY QUAD was off the pace and saved ground on the turn but had no late kick. SCREEN LEGEND was in range and raced evenly on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch was no real threat. STAR SCHOLAR was off slow, showed little and was not a factor.
